NCAA PLATFORM DIVING CHAMPION

MIAMI'S BRITTANY VIOLA

- One of three divers to share 2008 NCAA Diver of the Year honors
- First student-athlete in ACC history to be crowned national diving champion and the third women's diver in the program's history
- Also picked up All-America honors in the 1-meter diving event at the 2008 NCAA



NCAA THREE-METER DIVING CHAMPION

MIAMI'S REUBEN ROSS

- Only the second diver in ACC history to capture a national championship
- Earned All-America distinction in two other events at the 2008 NCAA, finishing fourth in the platform and sixth in the one-meter
- Became Miami's 22nd men's diving champion all-time and the first since 2002
