## SPECTATOR PARKING AND FACILITY INFORMATION

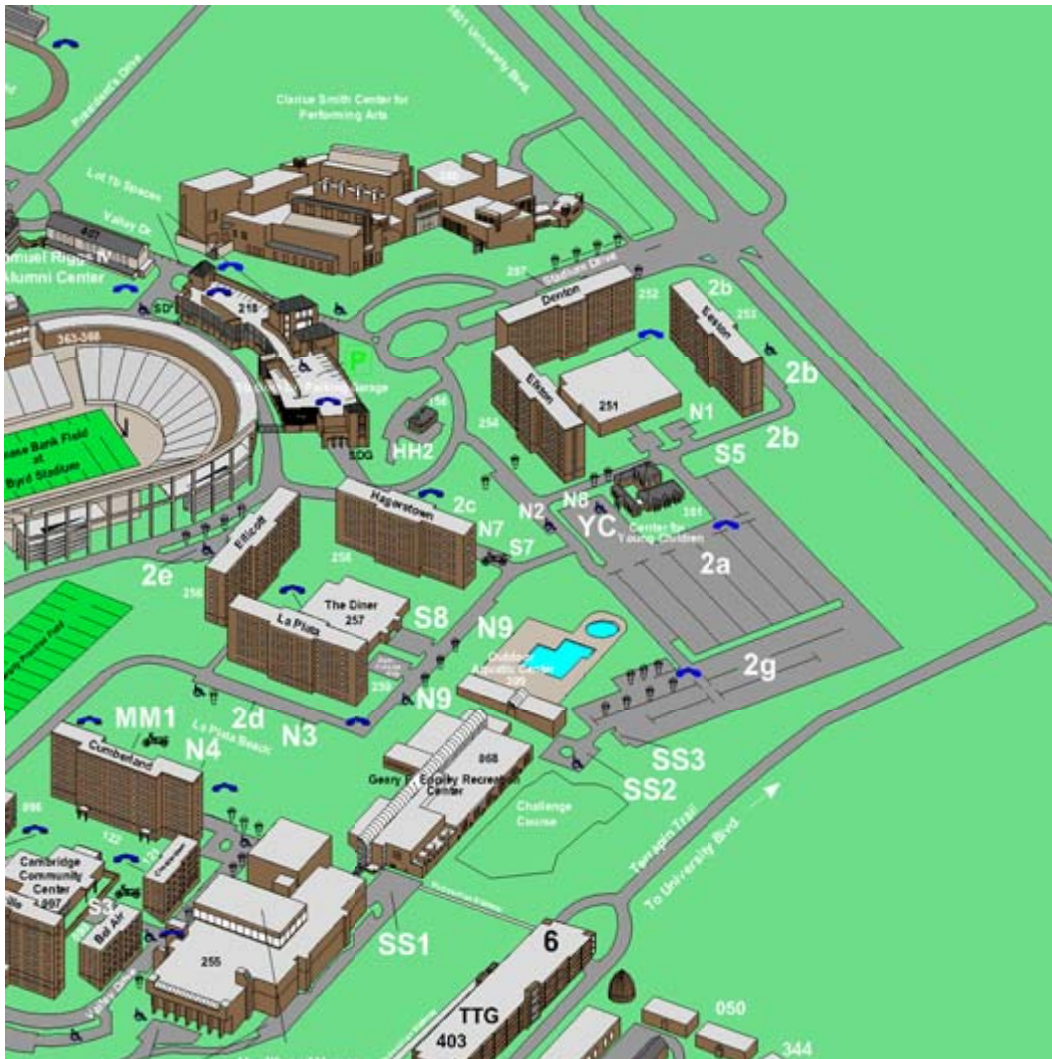

Doors will open 1 hour prior to start of session.

Concessions and restrooms are available in the spectator seating area.

**Competition Venue:** Located in the Eppley Recreation Center (Bottom center of diagram shown below).



## **Parking:**

**Parking will be available in the Stadium Drive Garage for \$5/day and includes in and out privileges. Stadium Drive Garage is located next to the Byrd Football Stadium.**

## **Handicapped Parking:**

**Handicap spaces are available in front of the Eppley Recreation Center. Please go to Stadium Drive Garage to purchase a University permit. Vehicles with handicap placards must also have a University permit.**

## **From Baltimore and Points North to Stadium Drive Garage**

- Take I-95 South to Washington, D.C.'s Capital Beltway (I-495).
- Take Exit 27 and then follow signs to Exit 25 (U.S. 1 South toward College Park).
- Proceed approximately one and a half miles south on U.S. Route 1.
- Follow signs for University Blvd. (MD-193) West.
- At second stoplight (Stadium Drive), turn left into campus.
- Follow traffic circle three-quarters of the way around and veer right.
- Make next immediate right and park in Stadium Drive Garage.
- Exit Garage and walk towards the Hagerstown/Ellicott high-rise residence halls.
- Eppley Recreation Center is the glass building beyond the residence halls.

## **From Virginia and Points South**

- Take I-95 North to Washington, D.C.'s Capital Beltway (I-495).
- Continue North on I-95/I-495 toward Baltimore.
- Take Exit 25 (U.S. 1 South toward College Park).
- Proceed approximately one and a half miles south on U.S. Route 1.
- Follow signs for University Blvd. (MD-193) West.
- At second stoplight (Stadium Drive), turn left onto campus.
- Follow traffic circle three-quarters of the way around and veer right.
- Make next immediate right and park in Stadium Drive Garage.
- Exit garage and walk towards the Hagerstown/Ellicott high-rise residence halls.
- Eppley Recreation Center is the glass building beyond the residence halls.
