The 2006 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championship concluded Saturday, March 11, 2006 with the Atlantic Coast Conference tying a league-high five event individual national champions, a mark matched in 2003. Three teams finished in the top five including Florida State with a third place finish on the men's side and North Carolina and Miami finishing fourth and fifth, respectively on the women's side.

The Florida State Seminoles compiled 41 points, the most scored in school history, to finish in third place. It was the best finish by the Seminoles at the NCAA Championship. The Virginia Tech men posted their best finish in school history placing 14th with 15 points. The North Carolina women equaled its best finish at the championship placing fourth with 29 points, while Miami collected its second consecutive top five finish placing fifth with 27 points. An ACC record nine schools on the women's side recorded points. Maryland's finish of 22nd with 11 points was the best finish in school history since 1984 when the Terrapins placed in a tie for seventh with 12 points. The Hokies also posted a team-best finish in 25th place with nine points.



North Carolina's Sheena Gordon claimed the women's high jump after clearing 6' 1.25" (1.86m) on her first attempt in a jump off with Georgia's Lavern Spencer. Both Gordon and Spencer passed on the first height of the championship before clearing the next four on their first attempt to force a jump off at 1.86m. It is the third straight high jump national championship for the ACC and fourth overall. Gordon captured the ACC high jump title earlier in the season clearing an indoor best 6' 2".

The Tar Heels concluded the first day of competition at the Indoor National Championships winning the women's distance medley relay. The team of Megan Kaltenbach, Danielle Rodgers, Georgia Kloss and Brianna Felnagle registered the league's fastest time of 2006 in a time of 11:01.97. It was the second national title in the DMR for UNC in the last four years.



Virginia Tech's Spyridon Jullien successfully defended his national title in the men's weight throw establishing the winning mark at 77' 10.25" (23.73m). The mark was a school record, personal best and the fourth best throw all-time in NCAA history. Last year, Jullien won his first national championship in the weight throw throwing 76' 0.75". The senior from Athens, Greece holds the ACC Indoor Meet Record in the weight throw with a mark of 75' 9.50".

The Seminoles' Walter Dix captured the men's 200m dash crossing the finish line in a time of 20.27, the fastest time record in the conference this season. It was the first indoor title for Dix and the third overall 200m dash title claimed by the ACC. The sophomore All-American also competed in the 60m dash placing second in a time of 6.62.



Garrett Johnson of Florida State established a winning mark of 67' 2.25" (20.48m) to register his first indoor national title in the men's shot put. Johnson becomes the first student-athlete to win an indoor shot put title in league history. Back in February of this year, the junior from Tampa, Fla., won his second ACC shot put title en route to setting a new meet record with his throw of 66' 2.75".
