Florida State, Virginia Tech Lead ACC Schools at 2008 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships

Led by some outstanding individual performances on both the men's and women's side, the Florida State Seminoles paced all ACC schools in the 2008 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships, finishing second and sixth, respectively. The Virginia Tech women, who claimed their second-straight ACC Indoor Championships last month in Chapel Hill, N.C., also had a strong showing, finishing in 10th-place.

The Seminole men were led by senior Drew Brunson and freshman Gonzalo Barroilhet, who earned the individual titles in the 60-meter hurdles and heptathlon events, respectively. Barroilhet, who set an ACC record en route to earning his first league title last month, reset his own school record with 5,951 points in the heptathlon, while Brunson blazed an ACC-record time of 7.53 seconds to take first-place in the 60-meter hurdles. On the women's side, the 'Noles were led by runners Susan Kuijken and Hannah England. Kuijken took first-place in the 3,000-meter run, while England earned top honors in the mile.

The Hokie women earned their highest-ever finish in the national meet behind the strong performances of hurdlers Kristi Castlin and Queen Harrison. Castlin and Harrison finished second and third-respectively, in the 60-meter hurdles. Also competing well for the Hokies were Brittany Pryor and Kristen Callan, who scored seventh-place finishes in the shot put and weight-throw, respectively.

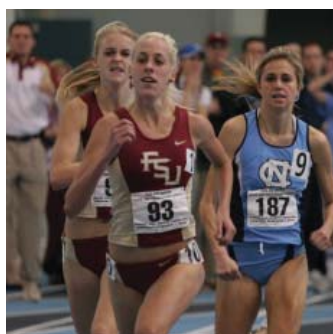
2008 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships Fayetteville, Ark. - The University of Arkansas March 14 & 15, 2008

One of two ACC men to earn an individual national title at this year's 2008 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships, Florida State's **Gonzalo Barroilhet** became the first league representative to win the heptathlon championship with 5,951 points this past weekend. Barroilhet, a freshman from Santiago, Chile, finished among the top five in five of the heptathlon's seven events, and set a personal best in five of the seven events. With a final score of 5,951, the Seminole rookie broke his own school and ACC record in the event, set just weeks ago at the league championship meet in Chapel Hill, N.C.



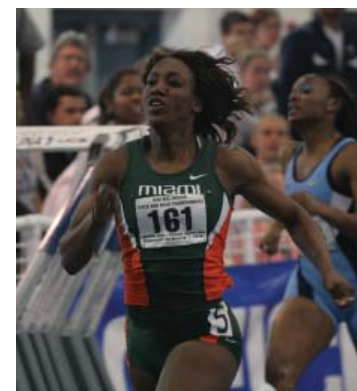
Florida State senior **Drew Brunson** joined his teammate, Barroilhet, as ACC national champion with a blistering 7.53 in the event's finals. Brunson, who broke the ACC Championship meet record and earned the league individual title with a time of 7.69 seconds in Chapel Hill, N.C., bested his previous top time twice this week. Brunson was the top qualifier after running a 7.60 in the preliminaries, and then narrowly beat out South Carolina's Jason Richardson by three one-thousandths of a second in the final to win the individual championship. Brunson, who also smashed the ACC's all-time record of 7.60 seconds with his performance in the final, is the first ACC male athlete to win a title in a hurdles event since 1995.

The Seminoles' **Hannah England** earned the Florida State women's team 10 valuable points, and put her name in the record books with a first-place finish in the women's mile run. Crossing the line in a time of 4:35.30, England, a sophomore from Oxford, England, bested the second-place finisher by just under a half second and broke the ACC's mile record, set by teammate Susan Kuijken at the ACC Championships just two weeks prior. The win by England, who was the runner-up to Kuijken at the league championships, helped propel the FSU women to their highest team finish since 1986, when the Seminoles won the team title.



A junior from Nijmeijer, Netherlands, Florida State's **Susan Kuijken** added to her growing list of individual titles with an incredible performance in the women's 3,000-meter run at this year's NCAA Championships. Already an ACC Cross Country champion and an ACC Indoor Track individual champion in 2007-08, Kuijken became an NCAA champion with an 8:58.14 finish in the 3,000-meter race. With the performance, Kuijken narrowly edged North Carolina's Brie Felnagle for top honors, and became the first ACC woman in history to break the nine minute mark in the event.

Already an All-American performer for the Hurricanes, junior **Krista Simkins** managed to outdo even herself at this year's NCAA Championships, becoming the first Miami woman to earn a national title since 2005 with a win in the 400-meter dash. Simkins, who took first-place in both the 200- and 400-meter at this year's league championships and was named ACC Women's Track Athlete of the Year, broke the ACC record and ran the nation's fastest time of the year in the preliminaries, finishing in 51.95 seconds. She then came back in the finals with a time of 52.16 to earn the individual title. Simkins, who hails from Ambler, Pa., is just the second female student-athlete in ACC history to win the 400-meter title.

2008 ACC Women's Indoor Track & Field Championship

Virginia Tech Repeats as ACC Champion

Led by a dominating performance in the sprints, the Virginia Tech women claimed their second ACC Indoor Track & Field Championship at the Eddie Smith Field House in Chapel Hill, N.C., on Feb. 28-March 1. The Hokies, who won their first-ever ACC track title at the 2007 Indoor Championships, piled up 138 points during the three-day event to seize the 2008 championship by the largest margin of any women's squad since 1998.



Tech, which completed the 2008 Indoor season with a No. 10 national ranking, took top honors in six of the weekend's 17 events, swept the top two spots in three events, and placed at least one athlete among the top three in nine overall events. Hokie individual champions included Patrice Potts in the 60-meter dash, Tasmin Fanning in the 3,000-meter run, Kelly Phillips in the pole vault, Brittany Pryor in both the shot put and weight throw, and the 4X400-meter relay team.

2008 ACC Men's Indoor Track & Field Championship

Seminoles Earn Sixth-Straight Men's Title

With another outstanding performance on the championship's final day of competition, Florida State earned its sixth-straight and seventh overall league title at the 2008 ACC Men's Indoor Track & Field Championships, held Feb.28-March 1, on the campus of the University of North Carolina. Like they have in years past, the 2008 Seminoles won the title with a balanced team effort, winning title in both the sprints and distance events, as well as in the field events.

Leading the way for FSU this time around was senior Drew Brunson, who broke the championship meet-record with a 7.69 finish in the 60-meter hurdles, and freshman Gonzalo Barroilhet, who smashed the meet and league record to finish first in the heptathlon. Also earning titles for the 'Noles was Michael Ray Garvin in the 200-meter dash, Charles Clark in the 400-meter dash, Daniel Roberts in the mile run and Luke Gunn in the 3,000-meter run. In all, FSU won or placed in the top three in 12 of the meet's 17 events to outdistance second-place Georgia Tech by more than 50 points.
