Challenge Notes

■ The ACC has won each of the eight ACC-Big Ten Challenges played to date ... ACC teams have won 48 of the 75 games played in the Challenge ... Duke (8-0) is the only undefeated team in Challenge play.

■ The ACC (.668) and the Big Ten (.622) are two of winningest conferences in NCAA Tournament history.

■ Since 1988, the ACC (20) and the Big Ten (15) have had 35 of the 80 teams in the Final Four and have captured eight national titles.

■ Teams from the ACC (323) and the Big Ten (291) have combined for 614 NCAA Tournament victories.

■ The ACC (26) and the Big Ten (18) have combined to produce 40 percent of the No. 1 seeds since the NCAA started assigning seeds in 1979.

■ Teams that lead at halftime are 57-17 (.770) in Challenge play ... the largest halftime deficit overcome was 12 points (39-27) by Georgia Tech in a 62-61 win over Wisconsin in 2001 ... the ACC has won 13 games after trailing at halftime, the Big Ten four ... four of the eight games played in the 2001 Challenge were won by teams that trailed at the intermission, including three by ACC teams.

■ Teams that shoot 50 percent or better in Challenge play are 24-5 (.828) ... the lowest field goal percentage by a winning team was 29.8 percent by Iowa in a 45-42 win over NC State in 2005.

■ 43 of the 75 Challenge games played to date have had at least one ranked team playing ... 21 games have had both teams ranked ... the 2001 game between Michigan State and Virginia that was cancelled because of a slippery floor, both teams were ranked.
