Tube Time

January 8, 1955

The first televised game involving ACC teams, a 95-78 win by North Carolina over Wake Forest, appeared on public television, WUNC, to fans within a 50-mile radius of Chapel Hill. Reaction was mixed. Although the game was a sell-out, the Duke-NC State game played at the same time in Durham, was 2,000 short of capacity, threatening the future of TV games for fear of their effect on ticket receipts.

January 16, 1956

North Carolina's 64-55 victory over Maryland was the first of three television productions called "Broadvision," a unique simulcasting agreement between WUNC-TV and a number of radio stations. Fan reaction was positive.

December 7, 1957

Castleman D. Chesley's live ACC-TV network began with UNC defeating Clemson 79-55 at Chapel Hill, in the first of 11 Saturday afternoon games over 12 stations. Jim Simpson and Bill Creasy announced the game. Pilot Life Insurance, now Jefferson-Pilot Corporation, was an original sponsor.

March 15, 1957

The first TV basketball game to be broadcast live across the state of North Carolina was North Carolina's 87-75 victory over Canisius in the NCAA East Regional semifinals at Philadelphia's Palestra. C.D. Chesley arranged for the broadcast through WPPB-TV of Wilmington, Del. The game aired on Charlotte's WBTV, Durham's WTVD and Greensboro's WFMY.

March 4, 1978

In the first nationally televised ACC Tournament Championship (during ABC's Wide World of Sports), Duke defeated Wake Forest 85-77 for the Blue Devils' first title in 12 years. Fearing a Saturday afternoon tip-off for TV would result in sloppy play, the quarterfinals and semifinals had been moved to Wednesday and Thursday, respectively – the only time the Tournament was not played on successive days. Also for the first time, all seven games were televised live.

January 28, 1979

Duke's Cameron Crazies behaved themselves for a nationally televised game with Marquette after NBC Sports threatened to cut away at moment's notice if the crowd "got out of hand." Undeterred, the Blue Devils posted a 69-64 victory over the Warriors.
