Eagle Edicts

The Eagles finished 21-12 overall and tied for third in the ACC with a 10-6 league record ... earned their sixth NCAA Tournament bid in the last seven years ... Al Skinner is the school's all-time winningest coach with 196 wins in 10 seasons ... Boston College has won 20 or more games in six of the past seven years and has averaged 23.4 wins per season over that span ... forward Jared Dudley was voted ACC Player of the Year and unanimous first team All-ACC after finishing first in the ACC in scoring (19.0) and second in rebounds (8.3) ... Dudley started all 130 career games and finished fifth on the school's all-time scoring list (2,071) and seventh in rebounds (936).

Tyrese Rice started all 33 games as a sophomore and earned second team All-ACC honors after averaging 17.6 points, 5.4 assists and 3.4 rebounds ... averaged 24.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists in the Eagles' two NCAA Tournament games ... ranked second in the ACC in minutes played (36.6), fourth in assists, sixth in scoring and sixth in free throw percentage (.795) ... scored 10 or more points in all but three games a year ago, including 13 games with 20 or more points.

Shamari Spears played in 31 games as a freshman in 2006-07 ... team's leading returning rebounder (4.6) ... made 13 starts, averaging 21.6 minutes and 7.1 points per outing ... shot .554 from the floor and .750 from the free throw line ... fifth among all ACC freshmen in offensive rebounds per game (2.0) ... had two double-doubles and three games with 10 or more rebounds.

John Oates played in and started 31 games as a junior in 2006-07, missing two games with a foot injury ... averaged 4.7 points and 3.7 rebounds per game ... scored in double figures five times ... has started 67 games the past two years ... has made 40-of-127 three-point field goal attempts in his career.

Tyrelle Blair averaged 2.7 points, 2.9 rebounds in 30 games ... finished fifth in the ACC with 2.1 blocked shots per game ... blocked four or more shots in each of seven games ... had six blocked shots three times in 2006-07.

Tyler Roche started the last six games of the season ... averaged 1.7 points, 1.7 rebounds and 0.7 assists per game as a freshman.

Al Skinner, Boston College Head Coach

Al Skinner was named the 15th head coach in Boston College history on April 17, 1997 ... is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 196-119 (.622) record in 10 seasons ... in Boston College's first season in the ACC in 2005-06, the Eagles posted a school record 28 wins, advanced to the finals of the ACC Tournament and a berth in the "Sweet 16" of the NCAA Tournament ... has guided Boston College to 98 victories over the past four years - an average of 24.5 wins per season ... after leading the Eagles to a share of the Big East regular-season in 2004-05, Skinner was awarded Big East Coach of the Year accolades ... Boston College opened the 2004-05 season with a school-record 20-0 start, also a school standard for consecutive victories ... after leading his 2000-01 squad to 27 wins and a NCAA Tournament seed (#3) in school history, Skinner was named the National Coach of the Year by Chevrolet/CBS, ESPN, *Sports Illustrated*, *The Sporting News*, Eastern Basketball and the USBWA, in addition to being named the Big East and NABC District I Coach of the Year the same year ... prior to his arrival in Chestnut Hill, Skinner served as the head coach at Rhode Island from 1988-97 ... in nine seasons at Rhode Island, Skinner led the Rams to three 20-win seasons and four postseason appearances and was named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year in 1991-92 ... Skinner served as assistant coach at Marist from 1982-84 and at Rhode Island from 1984-88.

Tiger Tidbits

Four starters return from a team that won six of its last eight games to finish 25-11 overall and reached the championship game of the NIT ... started the 2006-07 season with 17 straight wins ... the 25 wins tied for the most in school history ... Clemson was 18-1 in non-league play and had 13 wins over teams that won 20 or more games ... Oliver Purnell became one of only seven active head coaches to have a least one 20-win season at four different schools ... Vernon Hamilton finished sixth among ACC career steal leaders (271) ... 11 of Clemson's 17 games against ACC opponents were decided by five points or less ... over the past two seasons the Tigers are 10-4 in games after February 25th.

Cliff Hammonds has averaged 10 or more points in each of his first three seasons ... bidding to become only the sixth player in school history to average in double figures four consecutive years ... enters his senior season with 1,077 points scored, 340 assists and a 1.89:1 assists to turnover ratio ... ranked third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio as a sophomore and second a year ago ... a two-time member of the league's All-Academic basketball team.

James Mays was an honorable mention All-ACC and All-ACC Defensive team performer ... tied for first on the team in rebounds (6.4), second in steals (69), and third in points (12.2) and assists (2.6) a ... also third with 34 blocked shots ... led all ACC frontcourt players in steals per game (1.9) ... had seven double-doubles.

Trevor Booker averaged 10.4 points per game, and tied for the team lead in rebounds (6.4) ... had 78 blocks, second-most in school history by a freshman ... finished fourth nationally among freshmen and 33rd overall in blocked shots per game (2.2) ... shot .602 from the floor ... averaged 12.4 points and 7.2 rebounds in five NIT games ... scored 10 or more points in 10 of Clemson's final 12 games.

K.C. Rivers led the team in scoring (14.0) and was third in rebounds (4.5) ... came off the bench the first 26 games of the season before starting the final 10 contests ... ranked third in the ACC in three-point goals per game (2.4) ... led the team in free throw percentage (.735) ... scored in double figures 29 times a year ago - the Tigers were 24-5 in those 29 games.

Oliver Purnell, Clemson Head Coach

Named Clemson's 21st head basketball coach on April 5, 2003, Oliver Purnell is one of only seven active Division I coaches to have at least one 20-win season at four different schools - Radford, Old Dominion, Dayton, Clemson ... directed the Tigers to their third-straight post-season appearance and a school-record tying 25 wins a year ago, including a 17-0 run to start the season ... under Purnell, Clemson has improved its victory totals from 10 in 2004, 16 in 2005, 19 in 2006 and 25 last season and is one of only three coaches in league history to have at least a three-game improvement in three consecutive years ... in 2004-05, Purnell led the Tigers to a 16-16 record and their first postseason tournament appearance since 1999 ... has taken teams to 11 post-season tournaments and has nine 20-win seasons on his resume ... is only the third coach in Division I history to be a coach of the year in three different Division I conferences ... in 1997-98, Purnell was named Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year ... named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year at Old Dominion in 1993 and the Big South Conference Coach of the Year while at Radford in 1991 ... in 2003, as the head coach at Dayton, he was named a finalist for the Naismith Award ... prior to taking the reins at Dayton, Purnell spent three years as head coach at Old Dominion, his alma mater, compiling 57 wins and three postseason appearances ... in his final two seasons at Old Dominion, his teams claimed the CAA regular season championship, won 21 games and advanced to the NIT.

The Blue Devils return four starters from last year's team that finished 22-11, tied for sixth in the ACC with an 8-8 league mark and made the school's 12th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance ... Mike Krzyzewski's 775 career wins rank ninth all-time and third among active coaches ... Krzyzewski is one of only eight head coaches ever to win 700 or more games at one school ... Josh McRoberts averaged 13.0 ppg, was second in the ACC in blocked shots (2.5), third in rebounds (7.9) and was named second team All-ACC ... freshmen (64) and sophomores (70) accounted for 81 percent of the starting lineups in 2006-07 ... the Blue Devils have lost only 53 games the past 10 years.

DeMarcus Nelson scored 10 or more points in all but five games a year ago and led the team in scoring (14.1) and steals (1.4) ... was second on the team in rebounding (5.4) and third in blocked shots (17) ... one of only two guards in the ACC to average more than five rebounds per game ... earned honorable mention All-ACC Defensive team honors.

Greg Paulus finished the season by scoring 10 or more points 12 games in a row and in 16 of his last 17 ... hit on 68-of-151 (.450) from three-point range and over his last four games of the season averaged 21.0 points and 3.0 assists ... had 20 or more points in three of the last four games of the season ... led the ACC in assists (5.2) as a freshman in 2005-06.

Jon Scheyer earned All-ACC Freshmen

team honors a year ago starting 32 games and averaging 12.2 points and 3.3 rebounds per game ... averaged 13.9 points per game in ACC play ... tallied 10 or more points 23 times in 2006-07 ... finished third in the ACC in free throw percentage (.846) ... named ACC Rookie of the Week three times.

Gerald Henderson started 10 games and finished fifth on the team in scoring (6.8) ... averaged 7.9 points per contest in conference action, shooting an even 50 percent from the floor ... averaged 13.0 points and 5.0 rebounds over his last three games.

David McClure started 11 games as a sophomore in 2006-07, averaging 4.2 points and 4.9 rebounds per game ... had five or more rebounds 19 times last season.

Mike Krzyzewski, Duke Head Coach

Duke's Mike Krzyzewski stands as the ACC's winningest active coach with 775 career wins ... named ACC Coach of the Year five times, Krzyzewski is also the winningest coach in Duke history with 702 wins in 27 seasons ... has coached the Blue Devils to the ACC title in seven of the past nine years and 10 times overall - the second-best total in league history ... has won three national titles in 1991, 1992 and 2001 ... owns an NCAA record nine 30-win seasons and 22 seasons with 20 or more wins, including 11 straight 20-win seasons from 1984 to 1994, averaging 28.3 wins in the process ... Duke's 37 wins in 1999 matched its own 1986 standard for most victories in a season in NCAA history ... only the second coach in NCAA history to take his team to five straight Final Four berths (1988-92); also made it to the Final Four in 1986, 1994, 1999, 2001 and 2004 ... has guided the Blue Devils to postseason play in 24 of his 27 seasons, including 11 consecutive NCAA appearances (1984-94) ... Krzyzewski is the nation's all-time leader with 68 NCAA Tournament wins and has posted a 68-20 (.773) mark in NCAA Tournament play ... the 1998-99 team set an ACC single season record with 16 regular season league wins ... has been named National Coach of the Year 12 times in eight different years ... in 1992, The Sporting News named him the Sportsman of the Year, becoming the first college coach to win the honor.

Florida State returns four starters from a team that finished 22-13 overall and tied for eighth in the ACC with a 7-9 league mark ... the 22 wins were the most since a 25-10 record in 1992-93 ... advanced to the quarterfinals of the NIT before losing 86-71 at Mississippi State ... won a school record 16 games at home ... the Seminoles led the ACC and were ninth nationally in free throw percentage (.758) ... Al Thornton was a unanimous first team All-ACC selection after finishing first in the ACC in scoring (19.7), eighth in rebounding (7.2) and fifth in field goal percentage (.530).

Toney Douglas ranked second on the team in scoring (12.7) and assists (2.7) as a sophomore in 2006-07 after transferring from Auburn ... averaged 16.9 points and earned Freshman All-America third-team honors with the Tigers in 2004-05 ... shot .475 from the floor and .788 from the free throw line last season ... missed five games in February with a broken hand.

Isaiah Swann returns for his third consecutive season as a member of the Seminoles' starting line-up ... finished seventh in the ACC in three-point field goals made (1.94) per game as a junior ... made nine three-point field goals against Mississippi State in the NIT quarterfinals ... averaged a career-high 10.3 points per game as a junior ... is shooting .372 from the three-point line for his career... ranks ninth in school history with 151 steals.

Jason Rich has averaged in double figures scoring in each of the last two seasons and is the Seminoles leading active career scorer with 823 total points in 95 career games ... averaged 10.3 points per game as a junior last year following a 10.0 ppg mark as sophomore in 2005-06 ... has 74 career starts ... averaged 3.5 rebounds and 1.7 assists last year while starting all but one game.

Uche Echefu averaged 6.9 points, 4.3 rebounds per game as a sophomore last season ... was second on the team with 20 blocked shots and was one of only two Seminoles to start every game in 2006-07 ... averaged 7.2 points and 4.7 rebounds in 16 ACC games during the season ... made 58 of 75 free throws (.773) and had 15 games with five or more rebounds.

Leonard Hamilton, Florida State Head Coach

Entering his sixth season at the helm of the Florida State program, Leonard Hamilton has 34 seasons of coaching experience, including 19 seasons as a head coach ... named the seventh head coach in FSU history on March 18, 2002 ... is 87-71 in his first five seasons in Tallahassee, including a 42-23 mark the past two seasons ... earned national recognition at the University of Miami after guiding the Hurricanes to three straight NCAA Tournaments over his final three seasons and earning UPI National Coach of the Year honors in the process ... in his final season at Miami, the Gastonia, N.C., native directed the Hurricanes to their second straight 20-win season, a share of the Big East regular season championship and the school's first trip to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament ... twice named the Big East Coach of the Year, Miami registered a league-best 28-6 record over his final two seasons in Coral Gables ... Hamilton arrived at Miami from Oklahoma State where he spent four years rebuilding the Cowboy program ... led OSU to consecutive appearances in the NIT, which were the first back-to-back postseason appearances for the Cowboys since 1953-54 ... prior to his stint at Oklahoma State, Hamilton served as an assistant at the University of Kentucky where he spent 12 seasons with one of the top programs in the country.

Buzz Bits

The Yellow Jackets lost their top two scorers, but eight lettermen return from a team that won seven of its last 11 games, finishing 20-12 overall, tied for sixth in the ACC with an 8-8 league mark and earned their third NCAA appearance in the last four years ... Tech freshmen combined to average 37.2 points per game this past season, the ninth highest average in ACC history ... All-ACC freshman Javaris Crittenton led the team in scoring (14.4), assists (5.8), steals (2.0) and minutes played (31.3) ... Paul Hewitt is 19th on the ACC career coaching win list with 127 wins in seven seasons at Tech ... over the past two seasons, freshmen and sophomores have accounted for 67 percent of the team's starting lineups.

Anthony Morrow ranks eighth in Tech history with 177 three-point field goals ... started 10 of the last 11 games averaging 10.8 points and 3.8 rebounds over that stretch ... scored in double figures in 15 of his last 20 games ... is averaging 10.4 points per game in his career ... earned honorable mention as a sophomore in 2005-06.

Ra'Sean Dickey ranks sixth at Tech with 96 career blocked shots ... third among school career field percentage leaders (.601) ... started Tech's last 23 games ... averaged 9.1 ppg and shot .636 from the floor in 16 ACC games last season.

Lewis Clinch lead the team in scoring through the first 10 games of the season, reaching double digits in every game ... scored 20 or more four times ... suspended

from the team for spring semester following a violation of Institute policy, but remained in school ... shot .532 from the floor and .476 from three-point range.

Jeremis Smith is the only Tech player to start every game last season ... the team's fourth-leading scorer (8.3) and leading rebounder (5.9) per game) ... averaged 7.3 rebounds over his last eight games.

Zach Peacock started nine games as a freshman last season, averaging 5.5 points and 2.9 rebounds ... scored 10 or more points four times.

Mouhammad Faye played in all but two games as a freshman in 2006-07 ... averaged 3.9 points and 2.6 rebounds ... had a career-high 17 points against Virginia Tech (J28).

Paul Hewitt, Georgia Tech Head Coach

Paul Hewitt was named the 12th head coach in Georgia Tech basketball history on April 6, 2000 ... in seven years at Tech, Hewitt has recorded a mark of 127-95 and guided the Yellow Jackets to post-season play five times, including four NCAA Tournament berths ... in 2004-05, he led the Jackets to their second consecutive 20-win season, a first for Georgia Tech since 1989-90 ... three of his last four Tech teams have won 20 or more games ... despite being picked for seventh in the media preseason poll in 2003-04, the Yellow Jackets tied a school record with 28 wins and advanced to the NCAA's National Championship game ... in 2001, Hewitt became only the second first-year coach to earn ACC Coach of the Year honors ... his overall record as a head coach is 193-122 (.613), with a total of seven post-season appearances in nine years ... prior to his arrival at Tech, Hewitt guided Siena College to two postseason appearances and an average of 22 wins in three seasons as a head coach ... at Siena, Hewitt guided the Saints to a 66-27 (.710) record ... following a three-year stretch in which Siena posted a 22-59 mark, Hewitt guided a young Saints team to a 17-12 overall record and its first-ever MAAC Tournament Championship game ... in his second year, Siena finished with a 25-6 record, the school's first-ever MAAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA Tournament appearance.
