Individual records:

Drew Weatherford, FS – first completion (11 yards to De’Cody Fagg) moves him into second among ACC freshman in single-season passing yardage (with 2,036); finished with 2,950.

Willie Reid, FS – moves into 10th on the all-time ACC punt return yardage list with 883
Moved into 10th with 83-yard return in third quarter.

Greg Carr, FS – moved into a tie for fourth place in single-season receiving yards by an ACC freshman with 593 on the season – had 78 in the game.

Leon Washington, FS – Finished with 30 rushing yards, moving his career total to 2,021 rushing yards.

Marcus Vick, VT – With 335 passing yards, Vick established a new career high, surpassing his previous high 280 yards against Boston College on Oct. 27. He also established new career highs in attempts (52) and completions (26). With a career-high

346 yards of total offense, he surpassed the 3,000-yard plateau for his career, finishing the game with 3,137 career yards of total offense.

Josh Morgan, VT – Established new career highs with 7 receptions and 128 receiving yards.

Bobby Bowden, FS – Improves to 15-0 as a head coach against Virginia Tech, including three wins while at West Virginia.

Miscellaneous notes:

The Atlantic Division won the season series from the Coastal Division, 10-9.

Florida State won its 12th straight game against Virginia Tech. The Hokies' last win over the Seminoles was a 13-10 decision in 1975.

Florida State improves to 5-0 all time in Alltel Stadium. Virginia Tech falls to 1-3.

Florida State held Virginia Tech to a season-low 41 yards rushing. Mike Imoh (4 yards), Cedric Humes (7), Branden Ore (7) combined for 18 yards on 13 carries. The group came into the game averaging a combined 173.5 yards per game on the ground.

Virginia Tech was tied at the half for the first time this season. Florida State was tied for the third time this season, and third time in the last four games.

The six combined points were the fewest in the first half in a Virginia Tech game this season

Florida State's first two touchdowns were 2:59 apart in the third quarter

Virginia Tech's first two touchdowns were 2:32 apart in the fourth quarter

Virginia Tech attempted a season-high 52 passes – previous high was 28 against Boston College on Oct. 27.

With 2.5 tackles for loss on the game, Brodrick Bunkley sets new Florida State single-season record with 23 this season
