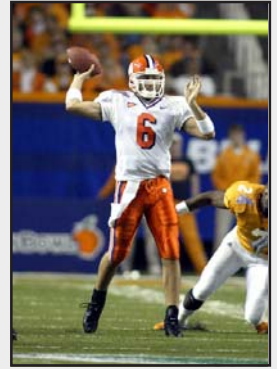

2003 -- Clemson finished 9-4 overall and third in the ACC with a 5-3 league mark ... the Tigers made their fifth-straight bowl appearance, and 27th overall, defeating Tennessee 27-14 in the Peach Bowl ... Clemson finished the season ranked 22nd in both polls.

Fast Finish -- The Tigers won their final four games of the season by an average margin of 27.0 points ... three of the wins were over No. 3 Florida State, arch-rival South Carolina and sixth-ranked Tennessee.

Honors -- Clemson had one first-team and three second-team All-ACC selections ... Tommy Bowden was named ACC Coach of the Year for the second time in his five years with the Tigers ... Bowden is the only coach in ACC history to take a league team to a bowl game in each of his first five seasons with the program.

Whitehurst -- With 246 yards passing in the Peach Bowl, Charlie Whitehurst joined NC State's Philip Rivers as only the second sophomore in ACC history to reach the 5,000-yard plateau ... already third on the school career passing list with 5,115 yards, Whitehurst has thrown for over 200 yards in 15 of his 18 career starts, including five games of 300 yards or more ... 16th

on the ACC career passing efficiency chart with a 133.3 rating ... missed earning 2nd-team All-ACC honors by one vote a year ago ... already owns 33 school records.

Tailback Tandem -- The Tigers return both of their leading rushers of the past two seasons ... Duane Coleman led the team and finished ninth in the ACC in rushing a year ago with 619 yards and two TDs and was fourth on the team with 34 catches for 309 yards and three TDs ... Yusef Kelly led the team in rushing as a sophomore in 2002 with 520 yards rushing but injuries limited him to five games and 125 yards rushing in 2003.

O Line -- Senior guard Cedric Johnson, a two-year starter and honorable-mention All-ACC in 2003, heads up a trio of returning starters on the offensive line ... Tommy Sharpe, a former walk-on, has started at center in 16 of the last 18 games for the Tigers.

Airese -- With two of the top five pass catchers in school history - Derrick Hamilton and Kevin Youngblood - departing, senior Airese Currie is

the team's leading returning receiver ... despite an injury-plagued year in 2003, Currie totaled 43 catches for 560 yards and four TDs and finished 10th in the ACC in receptions (4.3).

King of the Hill -- Senior LB Leroy Hill is the top returning tackler in the ACC ... a first-team All-ACC selection and an honorable mention All-American last fall, Hill averaged 11.2 tackles per game and led the ACC with 27 tackles for loss, including eight QB sacks ... had 10 or more tackles in all but three games ... was third in voting for ACC Defensive Player of the Year.

Miller Memo -- A second-team All-ACC selection as a freshman in 2002 and an honorable mention All-ACC defensive back as a sophomore, Justin Miller was named to Sports Illustrated's 2003 All-Bowl team this past season ... the Tigers' top cover corner, Miller has 10 career interceptions and is averaging 29.1 yards on 30 career kickoff returns ... 21 career starts.

Fudge Facts -- Honorable mention All-ACC in 2003, rover Jamaal Fudge was the second-leading tackler among sophomores in the ACC a year ago (128), averaged 9.8 tackles per contest.

Tommy Bowden

Tommy Bowden was named Clemson's head football coach on December 2, 1998. Named ACC Coach of the Year in 2003, for the second time in his five seasons at Clemson, and a finalist for the Bear Bryant National Coach of the Year Award, Bowden has compiled a 56-28 mark in seven seasons as a head coach, including a 38-24 mark with the Tigers. With Clemson's victory over Tennessee in last year's Peach Bowl, Bowden became the first head coach in ACC history to take a team to a bowl game in each of his first five seasons. Under Bowden, Clemson has played in the Peach Bowl in 1999 and 2003, the Gator Bowl in 2000, the 2001 Humanitarian Bowl and the 2002 Tangerine Bowl. Clemson finished the 2003 season 9-4 overall and third in the ACC with a 5-3 league mark and ranked 22nd in both polls. The Tigers won their final four games of the season by an average margin of 27.0 points, including wins over No. 3 Florida State (26-10), Duke (40-7), arch-rival South Carolina (63-17) and sixth-ranked Tennessee (27-14). In 2000, Bowden led Clemson to nine regular season wins, the school's highest win total since 1991 and a No. 15 ranking in the USA Today Coaches' Poll. In his first year at Clemson in 1999, Bowden was named ACC Coach of the Year after leading the Tigers to a 6-6 overall record, a second-place tie in the ACC with Virginia and Georgia Tech with a 5-3 league mark, and a Peach Bowl bid. Bowden came to the Tiger program after successful back-to-back seasons at Tulane University. At Tulane, he led the Green Wave to an 18-4 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark and a No. 7 ranking in both major polls.
