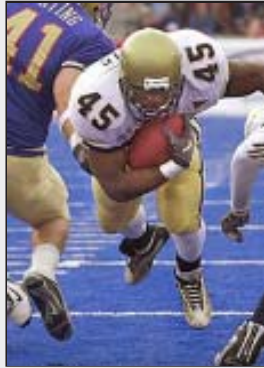

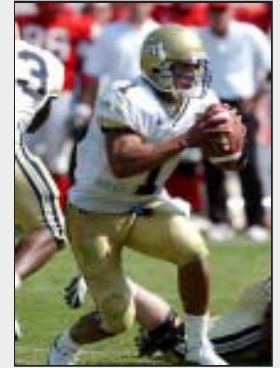

2003 -- Georgia Tech finished the 2003 season 7-6 overall and tied for fourth in the ACC with a 4-4 mark ... the Yellow Jackets set a school record by making their seventh straight bowl appearance, beating Tulsa 52-10 in the Humanitarian Bowl ... eight of Tech's 13 opponents played in a post-season bowl game.

Reggie Raves -- Quarterback Reggie Ball was named the 2003 ACC Rookie of the Year after establishing Tech freshmen records for passing yards (1,980), pass completions (177) and total offense (2,372) ... Ball's total offense yardage was the fourth-best single-season total by a freshman in ACC history while his passing yardage ranked fourth ... completed 52 percent of his passes while throwing for 10 touchdowns ... was the Jackets' second-leading rusher with 392 yards and three touchdowns.

P.J. -- Tailback P.J. Daniels was one of five Tech players to make first-team All-ACC in 2003 ... became the first Yellow Jacket since Jerry Mays in 1989 to lead the ACC in rushing ... ran for 1,447 yards and 10 TDs, including an NCAA bowl-record 307 yards and four touchdowns in the Humanitarian Bowl win over Tulsa ... the 1,447 yards was the fourth-highest single season total in ACC history ... a former walk-on,

Daniels had six 100-yard games, including a 240-yard effort against North Carolina.

Oline -- The offensive line, led by all-ACC candidate Kyle Wallace, returns three starters who each started all 13 games a year ago ... among the departed is first-team All-ACC center and three-year starter Hugh Reilly who played every snap during the 2003 season (888 offensive plays).

Nate -- Senior Nate Curry is the team's leading returning receiver ... Curry started all 13 games in 2003, finishing second on the team to Jonathan Smith with 37 receptions for 426 yards and three TDs.

Gone -- Defensive coordinator Jon Tenuta must replace Tech's entire linebacking corps from a year ago, including Daryl Smith and Keyaron Fox who combined for 79 career starts, 755 tackles and 88 tackles for loss.

The Butler did it -- Free safety James Butler, was second in the ACC a year ago with five interceptions ... a Jim Thorpe Award semifinalist and a first-team All-ACC selection in 2003

... recorded six pass breakups, three forced fumbles and six tackles for loss ... set a Tech season record for tackles by a defensive back (119).

Youthful Jackets -- With the loss of several key players, Tech's defensive line was a major question mark entering the 2003 season ... the top six players on the defensive front last year were three freshmen and three sophomores ... despite the youth, Tech still led the ACC and was 12th nationally in rushing defense, allowing 100.5 yards per game on the ground.

Tech trio -- Headlining the defensive line were "veteran" sophomores - Eric Henderson, Travis Parker and Gerris Wilkinson ... the trio combined for 51 tackles for loss, including 17.5 QB sacks.

QB Sack King -- Henderson earned first-team All-ACC honors in 2003 after leading the ACC with 11 QB sacks ... had 49 tackles, including a school-record 24 tackles for loss ... has 16 career sacks in only 26 games.

Wrotto -- Defensive tackle Mansfield Wrotto was one of 11 true freshmen to play for Tech a year ago ... was a third-team Freshman All-America selection by *The Sporting News*.

Chan Gailey

Chan Gailey, a 30-year football coaching veteran, including 14 seasons in the college ranks and 16 years in professional football, was named the 11th head coach in Georgia Tech football history on Dec. 29, 2001. Gailey guided the Yellow Jackets to bowl games in each of his two seasons on the Flats, the first Georgia Tech head coach to do so. With Tech's victory in the 2004 Humanitarian Bowl, the Jackets achieved a feat unprecedented in school history with their seventh consecutive bowl berth. Georgia Tech is one of just 11 schools in the nation to earn a bowl bid each of the last seven years. With a balanced offense and an aggressive defense, Gailey's 2003 Yellow Jackets defied preseason predictions that suggested Georgia Tech would finish eighth

in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Instead, the Jackets managed a 7-6 record, including a 4-4 mark in the ACC, despite a murderous schedule. The season was highlighted by victories over bowl-bound teams Auburn, Maryland and NC State as well as the thrashing of Tulsa in the Humanitarian Bowl. In 2001 in his first season at the helm of the Tech program, Gailey steered the Rambling Wreck through adversity, including season-ending injuries to the team's top offensive and defensive players, to a sixth consecutive bowl berth in the 2002 Silicon Valley Classic. In his two seasons at Georgia Tech, Gailey has posted a record of 14-12 (.538). Gailey, 52, brought to Tech a history of success at every stop in his coaching career, including three seasons as a college head coach at Troy State University and Samford University in Alabama, as well as two years as the head coach of the Dallas Cowboys and two at the helm of the Birmingham Fire of the World League of American Football. He made a name for himself as an innovative offensive mind during NFL stops in Pittsburgh, Dallas and Miami, among others. Entering his sixth season as a college head coach, Gailey has compiled a record of 38-23 (.623), including a 19-5 mark in two years at Troy State and a 5-6 slate at Samford.
