Comeback -- Maryland rallied from an 0-2 start to finish 10-3 overall and second in the ACC with a 6-2 league mark ... 2003 marked the second-straight year that Terps won 10 of their final 11 games ... capped off the season with an impressive 41-7 win over 20th-ranked West Virginia in the Gator Bowl ... Ralph Friedgen, 31-8 in his three years with the Terrapins, is the winningest third-year head coach in ACC history.

Terrapin Trilogy-- Maryland is one of five teams nationally to have won at least 10 games in each of the past three seasons.

Balance -- Since Friedgen's arrival in 2001, the Terps have featured the conference's most balanced offensive unit ... over the last three years, Maryland has averaged 415.0 yards per game - 212.4 yards per game passing and 202.6 yards per game rushing.

Gone -- Offensively, the Terps return five starters among 23 lettermen from a unit that averaged 34.8 points and 460.3 yards over the last 11 games of the season ... missing are QB Scott McBrien who threw for 5,169 yards and 34 TDs in his two years as a starter and TB Bruce Perry who ran for 2,494 yards in his career and was the 2001 ACC Offensive Player of the Year.

Top Terp Tailback -- Josh Allen led the team and was sixth in the ACC in rushing (70.9) ... ran for 922 yards as a sophomore a year ago ... has averaged 5.5 yards per rush attempt in his career and has scored eight TDs in each of his first two seasons ... averages a touchdown every 15.3 carries ... has four 100-yard games in his career including a 261-yard, four-touchdown effort against Virginia (N13) ... in Maryland's three losses in 2003, Allen averaged 22.7 yards rushing per game while in the 10 wins he averaged 85.4 yards per contest.

Poll Positive -- Maryland finished the 2003 season ranked third in the final New York Times computer poll and 10th in the Sagarin Computer poll.

All-ACC selection, Steve Suter enters his senior season third among ACC career punt return leaders with 1,108 yards on 94 returns ... has an ACC-record six career punt returns for touchdowns ... Maryland's leading returning receiver from a year ago with 29 catches for 471 yards.

Turtle Toe -- A two-time first-team All-ACC selection, placekicker Nick Novak ended the 2003 season just three points shy of becoming the league's all-time leading scorer ... currently second on the ACC career list with 324 points ... has made 64 of 84 field goal attempts in his career with five of the 20 misses coming from 50 yards or more.

Foxworth -- Senior cornerback Domonique Foxworth earned first-team All-ACC honors as a sophomore and second-team recognition as a junior in 2003 ... a three-year starter ... has eight career interceptions and 25 passes broken up.

Action Jackson -- In his first year as the Terps' starting middle linebacker, D'Qwell Jackson led the team with an average of 10.5 tackles per outing (136 total) ... earned second-team All-ACC honors ... had eight games with 10 or more tackles.

Ralph Friedgen

Ralph Friedgen, the first coach in Atlantic Coast Conference history to lead a team to three-straight seasons of 10 wins or more, enters his fourth year at the University of Maryland with a rapidly-growing reputation as one of the top coaches in the game. The consensus national Coach of the Year in 2001 after leading Maryland to its first ACC championship since 1985, Friedgen was a long-time successful assistant coach at Georgia Tech, where he was credited with overseeing one of the nation's most potent offensive attacks. Friedgen continues to build a new level of pride and glory to his alma mater's football program, guiding the Terps to a 31-8 record and a trio of major bowl appearances - including two decisive wins -- in his three seasons as a collegiate head coach.

Not only are his 31 wins four more than any third-year coach in Atlantic Coast Conference history, his 31-8 start is the seventh-best in the history of Division I-A college football. Only one other coach since 1978 (Miami's Larry Coker, 35-3) has posted as many wins in his first three years at the helm. Three years ago, in his first season as the Terps' grid boss, Maryland won its first seven games and eventually halted Florida State's reign as perennial ACC Champion, earning the league's automatic berth in the Bowl Championship Series. In 2002, despite a 1-2 start and without 19 seniors from the previous year, the Terps made their way back to a major bowl game, winning 10 of their last 11 games and finishing in a tie for second in the ACC. The 2003 campaign provided a bit of déjà vu for Friedgen and the Terrapins as they again started 1-2, again running off 10 wins in their final 11 games to earn a second New Year's bowl bid in three years. Named the winner of the Frank Broyles Award as the top assistant coach in the country in 1999 while at Tech, Friedgen brought 32 years of assistant coaching experience - including 21 as an offensive coordinator either in college or the NFL - with him in his return to College Park.
