2003 -- The Tar Heels finished 2-10 overall and ninth in the ACC with a 1-7 league mark ... four of the losses were by eight points or less, including two by two points ... the Sagarin Computer rated UNC's schedule as the nation's 11th-toughest ... a total of 12 true freshmen played in 2003 after playing only seven in 2002 ... UNC has used a different starting lineup on defense in 23 of the last 24 games, dating back to the start of the 2002 season.

They're back -- Twenty-five lettermen, including eight starters return from an offensive unit that averaged 394.3 yards per game in 2003 - the most by a Tar Heel offense since the 1995 season ... UNC totaled over 440 yards in offense five times in 2003, including two games of over 500 yards.

TD Tar Heels -- UNC scored 40 touchdowns last season and all but three of those came from players who are slated to return in 2004.

Defining Darian -- Headlining the eight returning starters on offense is senior quarterback Darian Durant ... Durant has already set most of UNC's career passing and total offense records ... currently ranks first in career completion percentage (.608), TD passes (51), passing

yards (6,517), completions (523) and first in career total offense (7,203) ... is the only player in UNC history to throw for more than 6,000 career yards ... has more games with at least 300 yards of total offense at North Carolina (7) than any other player in school history ... enters his senior season 13th on the ACC's all-time passing efficiency chart (137.3) and 16th in career passing yards (6,517).

Redoubtable Ronnie -- Ronnie McGill finished seventh in the ACC and led all league freshmen in rushing a year ago, totaling 654 yards and seven TDs ... became the fourth freshman in the last six years to lead UNC in rushing ... averaged 5.1 yards per carry and led the Tar Heels in rushing six times, including five of the last seven games ... ran for a career-high 244 yards and three scores in a 42-34 win over Wake Forest (N8).

Jarwarski -- Jarwarski Pollock is the ACC's leading returning receiver ... had a school-record 71 receptions for 745 yards and one TD in 2003 and finished third in the ACC and 33rd nationally in receptions per game (5.9) ... has

102 catches for 1,209 yards and five TDs over the last two seasons ... has three or more receptions in 13 straight games.

Lewis lineage -- Tailback Jacque Lewis led all ACC rushers (with 350 or more yards) a year ago with his 6.1 yards per carry average ... was second on the team to Pollock with 34 receptions for 391 yards and a team-high five touchdowns in 2003 ... has rushed for 1,189 yards in his career with a 4.8 yards per carry average.

Defensive -- Tar Heels must replace four starters on defense, including second-team All-ACC free safety Dexter Reid and cornerback Michael Waddell, who combined for 73 career starts in the secondary ... eight of the team's top nine tacklers are back including junior CB Mahlon Carey and linebacker Larry Edwards ... Carey was second on the team with 96 tackles and had both of UNC's interceptions while Edwards started eight games as a true freshman finishing third on the team with 85 tackles.

Specialists -- Mike Mason was third in the ACC and 18th nationally in kickoff returns (26.0) as a freshman a year ago ... punter David Wooldridge averaged 45.1 yards on 27 punts.

John Bunting

On December 11, 2000, John Bunting was named as the 32nd head football coach at the University of North Carolina. In his first year as the school's head coach in 2001, Bunting led the Tar Heels to an 8-5 season, winning eight of their last 10 games and capping the year with a 16-10 victory in the Chick-Fil-A Peach Bowl. Bunting's eight wins were the most by a first year coach in UNC history and he became only the second coach in school annals to receive a bowl bid in his first year at the helm. Bunting is the first Carolina alum and first UNC football letterwinner to become the Tar Heel football coach since Jim Tatum in

1956. As a linebacker, Bunting was a three-year starter who helped lead Carolina to back to back bowl games in 1970 and 1971. After earning All-ACC and honorable-mention All-America honors in 1971, Bunting was drafted in the 10th round by the Philadelphia Eagles. The Silver Spring, Md., native started three games as a rookie and became a full-time starter in 1974. Bunting went on to start 119 of 133 career NFL games. In 1980, he was a key factor as the Eagles played in Super Bowl XV against the Oakland Raiders. In 1987, Bunting became a full-time assistant at Division III Glassboro State University (now Rowan University). The following season he was elevated to the head coaching position, where he served five years and led the Profs to the NCAA playoffs for the first time in school history. In Bunting's final season in 1992, Rowan finished 12-1 and advanced to the semifinals before falling to Washington and Jefferson. Bunting started his NFL coaching career in 1993 with the Kansas City Chiefs. In 1997, Bunting became the linebackers coach with the St. Louis Rams, where one year later he was promoted to the co-defensive coordinator position. Following the 1999 season, Bunting moved on to New Orleans as the linebackers coach.
