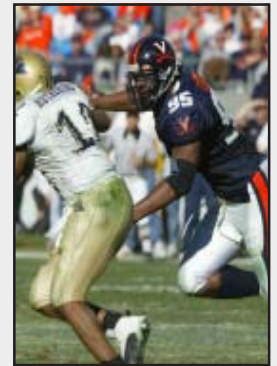

2003 -- The Cavaliers won their final three games of the season to finish 8-5 overall and tied for fourth in the ACC with a 4-4 league mark ... Virginia made its second-straight post-season appearance, and 14th overall, defeating Pittsburgh 23-16 in the Continental Tire Bowl.

All-ACC -- For the second year in a row, Virginia had six players earn first or second-team All-Conference honors ... all but one of those players return in 2004 ... the lone departing All-ACC performer was QB Matt Schaub, the 2002 ACC Player of the Year, a second-team All-ACC choice last year and owner of more than 20 school records, threw for 7,502 yards and 56 touchdowns in his career.

Heath -- Tight end Heath Miller was the lone Cavalier selected first-team All-ACC a year ago ... was a freshman All-American in 2002 ... led the nation's tight ends in receiving in 2003 with 70 receptions for 835 yards and six touchdowns - both the catches and yards are ACC records by a tight end ... has caught at least one pass in 21 straight games and has at least three catches 18 times ... had 13 receptions for 145 yards against Virginia Tech (N29) ... has 103 career receptions for 1,162 yards and 15 touchdowns.

122 Starts -- Virginia is one of only two ACC teams to return their starting tight end and all five starters along the offensive line ... the six players total 122 career starts ... headlining the returning starters is senior guard Elton Brown, a three-year starter, and junior tackle D'Brickshaw Ferguson ... Brown was last year's recipient of the Jacobs Blocking Trophy as the ACC's best blocker.

Near Perfect -- A second-team All-American and a Lou Groza semifinalist, PK Connor Hughes was nearly perfect in 2003, making 23 of 25 field goal attempts, including three-of-four from 50 yards or more ... finished second in the ACC and 24th nationally in scoring (8.4) ... his 109 points are a school record for a place kicker.

Tailback Tandem -- Junior Wali Lundy and senior Alvin Pearman give the Cavaliers one of the more productive tailback tandems in the nation ... Lundy was fourth in the ACC in rushing a year ago with 929 yards and 10 TDs and was fifth on the team with 29 catches for 253 yards and four scores ... Pearman was

eighth in the ACC with 643 yards rushing and led all ACC running backs with 63 catches for 518 yards ... Lundy and Pearman have combined for 3,112 yards rushing, 196 receptions for 1,682 yards, 10 100-yard games and 40 total touchdowns in their careers.

Canty Kudos -- Senior DL Chris Canty a two-time All-ACC second-teamer, led all ACC defensive linemen in tackles a year ago, averaging 8.0 tackles per game ... had 10-or-more tackles four times last fall.

Junior LB -- LB Darryl Blackstock averaged 6.5 tackles per game as a sophomore in 2003 ... 19 percent (16 of 85) were behind the line of scrimmage, including a team-high six sacks ... a freshman All-American in 2002, already has 16 career sacks which ranks eighth in school history.

Sophomore LBs -- Ahmad Brooks was a consensus Freshman All-American in 2003 while Kai Parham earned second-team Freshman All-America recognition ... Brooks led the Cavaliers and all ACC freshmen with 117 tackles (9.0 pg) while Parham totaled 89 tackles, including seven tackles for losses, despite starting only eight games in 2003.

Al Groh

Named as Virginia's 38th head football coach on December 30, 2000, Al Groh owns a three-year record of 22-17 with the Cavaliers, including a 13-11 record against ACC competition. Groh's overall record in nine seasons as a collegiate head coach is 48-57. Virginia finished 8-5 (4-4 ACC) in 2003 and celebrated a return trip to the Continental Tire Bowl with a 23-16 win over Pittsburgh. With the victory over the Panthers, Virginia claimed consecutive bowl victories for just the second time in school history. Groh was named ACC Coach of the Year in 2002 after guiding the Cavaliers to a 9-5 record, a second place finish in the ACC with a 6-2 mark, and a 48-22 Continental Tire bowl victory over 15th-ranked West Virginia. Prior to his arrival in Charlottesville, Groh was head coach of the NFL's New

York Jets, the position from which he resigned to take over at Virginia. He coached the Jets to a 9-7 mark in his only year at the helm. He was the Jets' linebackers coach for three seasons (1997-99) before being named head coach. Prior to his tenure with the Jets, Groh was an assistant coach under Bill Parcells with the New England Patriots from 1993 to 1996. He spent the 1992 season as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach on Bill Belichick's staff with the Cleveland Browns. Groh joined the New York Giants' staff in 1989 following a one-year stint as offensive coordinator at South Carolina in 1988. He coached the Giants' linebackers from 1989 to 1990 and was defensive coordinator in 1991. He got his first taste of NFL coaching when he joined the Atlanta Falcons as special teams and tight ends coach in 1987. His first collegiate head coaching assignment was at Wake Forest from 1981-86, where his teams compiled a 26-40 overall record. At the time, he was the second-winningest coach in school history. He began his coaching career at Albemarle High School in Charlottesville in 1967. The following year, he moved to Tom Cahill's staff at Army where he was the defensive coach for the plebe squad and worked with Parcells for the first time in his career. He returned to Virginia in 1970 to serve as the head coach of the freshman team and as the defensive line coach through the 1972 season. From 1973 to 1977 he served as an assistant at North Carolina. He joined Parcells at Air Force in 1978 as defensive coordinator before moving to Texas Tech in 1980 as defensive coordinator.
