2003 -- Wake Forest fell one game short of becoming bowl-eligible for the third straight season, finishing 5-7 overall and seventh in the ACC with a 3-5 league mark ... set a school record for home attendance, averaging 28,273 fans a game ... had three first-team All-ACC selections a year ago - the most since 1992 ... only two true freshmen saw action in 2003, including Jyles Tucker, who started the final four games of the season at defensive end.

Dependable Deacs -- Over the past three years Wake Forest has been penalized less than any team currently in the ACC.

Turnovers -- Over the past two seasons, Wake Forest is a +25 in turnover margin - the top figure in the league ... after leading the ACC and finishing fifth nationally in 2002 (+1.38), the Deacs were second to Florida State last season (+0.58).

Barclay Bits -- Tailback Chris Barclay finished second in the ACC and 29th nationally in rushing a year ago with 1,192 yards on 235 carries ... his season total was the second-best in school history and his 12 rushing touchdowns led the ACC ... ran for 243 yards in the season finale against Maryland ... averaged a league-best 132.3 yards per outing against ACC opponents ... already 10th among school career rushing leaders with 1,895 yards and fifth with 21 career rushing touchdowns.

Getting Defensive -- Wake Forest scored five defensive touchdowns in 2003 - one more than in the previous eight seasons combined ... the Deacons scored three touchdowns on fumble returns and two via interceptions ... Wake Forest ranked second in the ACC in defensive touchdowns.

King Eric -- Cornerback Eric King established himself as one of the top cornerbacks in the ACC last year earning first-team All-ACC honors after leading the league with 18 passes defended -15 PBUs and three interceptions -- an average of 1.50 per game.

Long Distance Jason -- Wide receiver Jason Anderson is second among all active ACC receivers with a career 18.5 yards per catch average ... has 95 receptions in his first two seasons for 1,758 yards and 14 touchdowns.

Tackling Trio -- Three of the team's top four tacklers from a year ago are back ... LB Caron Bracy led the way with 90 tackles, including a team-high 68 solo efforts ... LB Brad White, who had a team-high 94 stops in 2002, tallied 78 tackles last season, including five TFLs ... SS Warren Braxton was fourth on the team with 66 tackles.

Deacon Bits -- Freshman Willie Idlette led all ACC freshmen in all-purpose yardage (92.4) ... punter Ryan Plackemeier led the ACC (by nearly three yards) and was fifth nationally in punting (45.6).

Jim Grobe



After just three seasons at Wake Forest, head coach Jim Grobe has certainly elevated the level of excitement and expectation surrounding Demon Deacon football. Grobe began his Wake Forest tenure in impressive fashion in 2001, orchestrating one of the greatest turnarounds in Wake Forest football history, leading the Demon Deacons to a bowl-eligible 6-5 record following a 2-9 mark the previous season. In his second campaign, he guided the Deacs to a 38-17 victory over Oregon in the Seattle Bowl. Grobe owns an 18-18 record after three years at Wake Forest and is 51-51-1 in nine overall seasons as a head coach. Before Grobe arrived in Winston-Salem, the Deacons had compiled a 26-63 record in the eight previous seasons. Grobe, 52, has gained a national reputation as a builder of programs. He came to Wake For-

est after turning a struggling Ohio University program into a contender for the Mid-American Conference championship. In the 10 seasons before Grobe left his assistant's position at the Air Force Academy to become Ohio University's head coach, the Bobcats won 17 games. In the six years under Grobe, they won 33 and finished with winning records in the Mid-American Conference five straight seasons. Grobe led the Bobcats to a cumulative six-year record of 33-33-1. Grobe was named the MAC Coach of the Year in 1996 and was a candidate for The Sporting News Division I-A Coach of the Year in 1997. Prior to working at Ohio, Grobe enjoyed a long and successful stint under Fisher DeBerry at the Air Force Academy. He served as linebackers coach and national recruiting coordinator from 1984 to 1994. Grobe also worked previously as an assistant coach at Marshall (1978-84) and Emory & Henry (1978). He began his coaching career as head coach at Liberty High School in Bedford, Va., from 1976-79 after serving as a graduate assistant coach at Virginia in 1975-76. As a player at Virginia in 1973 and 1974, Grobe played middle guard (1973) and linebacker (1974). He was a two-year starter for the Cavaliers and earned academic All-ACC honors. A native of Huntington, W. Va., Grobe earned his undergraduate degree (B.S.) in Education from Virginia in 1975 and earned a Master's degree in Guidance and Counseling from Virginia in 1978.
