## NOTEWORTHY

### EIGHT OF ELEVEN ACC MEN'S GOLF TEAMS ADVANCE TO NCAA REGIONAL PLAY FOR SECOND CONSECUTIVE YEAR

The NCAA Division I Men's Golf Committee announced May 7 the teams and individuals selected to participate in the 2012 Men's Golf Regionals.

Six 54-hole regional tournaments will be held May 17-19 to determine the championship field. Thirteen teams and ten individuals not on those teams will compete at each of the three regionals while the other three regionals will have 14 teams and five individuals not on those teams. The low five teams and the low individual not on those teams from each regional will advance to the finals.

2012 marked the second consecutive year the ACC has sent eight teams to the NCAAs and the fourth time since 2006. Nine teams were selected in the 2007, 2008 and 2010 seasons.

The NCAA Men's Golf Championship finals will be held May 29-June 3 at the Riviera Country Club in Pacific Palisades, Calif.

### ACC NOTEWORTHY:

#### University of Georgia Golf Course, Athens, Ga. WAKE FOREST

-The Demon Deacons have won three out of the last seven regionals and since 1989, the team has advanced onto the finals a total of 15 times, including five of the last seven years.

#### Grandover Resort East Course, Greensboro, N.C. DUKE

-The Blue Devils have qualified for NCAA Regional play in each of the last 14 seasons and have advanced to the NCAA Championship eight times in that span.

#### University of Michigan Golf Course, Ann Arbor, Mich. VIRGINIA

-For the fifth consecutive year, the Cavaliers have received a bid to the NCAA Championships. The regional berth marks the 16th time since 1990 Virginia has competed in postseason play.

#### NC STATE

-The Wolfpack earned its 20th trip to the NCAA Regionals since the format was changed back in 1989. That stretch includes 13 appearances in the last 15 years, all under the direction of head coach Richard Sykes.

#### The Club at Olde Stone, Bowling Green, Ky. CLEMSON

-This is the Tigers 31st consecutive year the Clemson program has been selected for the NCAA Men's Golf Tournament, the 29th consecutive under head coach Larry Penley.

#### VIRGINIA TECH

-This is the Hokies sixth consecutive NCAA appearance and their 14th all-time appearance in the NCAA Championship.

#### Jimmie Austin OU Golf Club, Norman, Okla. GEORGIA TECH

-The Yellow Jackets are the No. 2 seed and earned an automatic berth by winning the Atlantic Coast Conference championship last month. Georgia Tech is playing in an NCAA Regional for the 15th straight year and for the 21st time in the 23 years the NCAA has used a regional qualifying format for its championship.

#### FLORIDA STATE

-The Seminoles will make its school record seventh consecutive NCAA Championship appearance. Florida State finished in third place at the national championships in 2010.

**ACC PLAYER OF THE MONTH****DUKE'S JULIAN SURI NAMED ACC MEN'S GOLFER OF THE MONTH FOR FEBRUARY**

Duke's Julian Suri has been named Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Golfer of the Month for February.

Suri, a junior from St. Augustine, Fla. fired a career-low 11-under 205 en route to claiming individual medalist honors at the 36th annual John A. Burns Intercollegiate at the Palmer Course at Turtle Bay in Kahuku, Hawaii. Suri posted a seven-under 65 in the opening round and followed up with back-to-back rounds of 70 to lead the tournament wire-to-wire and claim his second career victory.

At the John Burns Intercollegiate, played February 15-17, Suri led the tournament in birdies (15) and par 4 scoring (-10). His opening round 65 is tied for the fourth-best round in Duke history, while his 11-under 205 is the fourth-lowest tournament in Duke history.

Suri was named Golfweek Player of the Week after capturing the individual title at the Burns Intercollegiate.

**VIRGINIA'S BEN KOHLES AND FLORIDA STATE'S BROOKS KOEPKA HONORED AS ACC MEN'S CO-GOLFERS OF THE MONTH FOR MARCH**

Virginia's Ben Kohles and Florida State's Brooks Koepka have been named Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Co-Golfers of the Month for March.

Kohles, a senior from Cary, N.C. became Virginia's all-time wins leader (seven) with two victories this spring. He took medalist honors at both the Cleveland Golf Palmetto Intercollegiate, played March 5-6 in Aiken, S.C. and the Schenkel Invitational, played March 16-18 in Statesboro, Ga. Kohles set a Virginia tournament scoring record and record for score in relation to par with an 18-under 198 to win the Schenkel. He opened the spring season with a victory at The Cleveland Golf Palmetto (208, -2) and then had a second-place effort at the General Hackler, played March 11-12 in Georgetown, S.C.

Florida State senior, Brooks Koepka (Wellington, Fla.), earned the second and third individual wins of his career as he won medalist honors at the Seminole Intercollegiate and the FAU Spring Break Invitational in back to back events. He carded a nine-under-par score of 204 in the Seminole Intercollegiate and a school record of 14-under-par score of 199 to win the FAU Invitational. Koepka carded a personal best and tied the school record with an eight-under-par 63 in the third round of the FAU tournament.

Both Kohles and Koepka each posted a round of under 200 for the month, which are two of the best individual rounds in ACC history.

Wake Forest's Lee Bedford has been named Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Golfer of the Month for April.

Bedford, a senior from Cary, N.C., finished both tournaments last month in the top seven, including a runner-up finish at the ACC Championship, played April 20-22 at The Old North State Club in New London, N.C. Bedford posted the best finish for a Demon Deacon since Webb Simpson claimed medalist honors in 2008. He finished a season-best 9 under par at the championship, which was one-stroke off his career-best finish.
