NOTEWORTHY

2012 SPRING HIGHLIGHTS

All-American James White (Sr., Acworth, Ga.) shot a 4-under-par 68, and freshman Ollie Schniederjans (Powder Springs, Ga.) added a 3-under 69 on the last day of the tournament, pacing Georgia Tech to a 10-under team total of 278 and fourth-place finish at the 22nd annual Amer Ari Invitational, played February 1-3, at the Waikoloa Kings Course in Waikoloa, Hawaii (845, -19). It was the second top-10 finish this year for White.

Georgia Tech (7th), Clemson (16th), Duke (17th), Florida State (20th), Virginia (34th) and Wake Forest (43rd) ranked in February 5 Golfweek/Sagarin team rankings.

Three ACC golfers ranked in Top 25 of February 5 Golfweek/Sagarin individual rankings: (5th) Brooks Koepka, Florida State (Sr., Wellington, Fla.), (12th) Corbin Mills, Clemson (Jr., Anderson, S.C.), (21st) James White, Georgia Tech (Sr., Acworth, Ga.). 2011 ACC FALL HIGHLIGHTS

TEAM

Virginia opened its season in impressive fashion, smashing the team tournament scoring record en route to a victory at the VCU Shootout (837, -27), played September 26-27 at Hermitage Country Club in Manakin-Sabot, Va.

Duke posed a three-under 861 score for a nine-shot victory to win the Rod Myers Invitational at the Duke University Golf Club in Durham, N.C., played October 1-2.

Georgia Tech finished in first place with a 16-under par 848, the only one of the 15 teams to finish below par at the Brickyard Collegiate, played October 7-9 in Macon, Ga.

INDIVIDUAL

Five separate ACC players captured individual medalist honors this past fall.

Duke's Julian Suri, St. Augustine, Fla. junior, shot the low round of the Rod Myers Invitational with a four-under 68 to pace the Blue Devils. Suri posted rounds of 70-73-68 for a five-under 211.

Clemson's Corbin Mills, a native of Anderson, S.C. tied the Clemson record for a low 54-hole score shooting a 201 (65-69-67), to win the Jerry Pate Intercollegiate, played October 3-4 in Birmingham, Ala.

Brooks Koepka, Florida State senior (Wellington, Fla.) earned his first collegiate victory (205) at the Brickyard Collegiate Championship, played October 7-9 in Macon, Ga.

N.C. State's Mark McMillen shared medalist honors at the Bank of Tennessee @ Blackthorn, played October 14-16 in Jonesborough, Tenn. The Smithfield, N.C. senior shot a two-under 214.

N.C. State sophomore Albin Choi, (Toronto, Canada), earned his third collegiate victory with a five-under par 139 at the Bridgestone Golf Collegiate, played October 29-30 in Greensboro, N.C.
