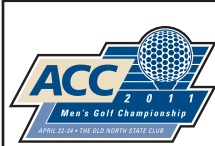

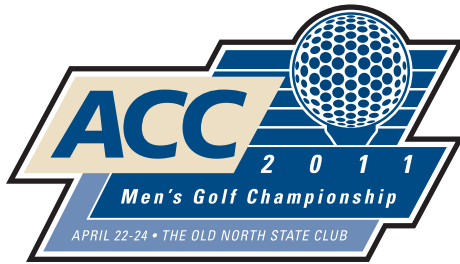

2011 NCAA HIGHLIGHTS
THREE ACC MEN'S GOLF TEAMS
(DUKE, GEORGIA TECH, NC STATE)
WAKE FOREST'S LEE BEDFORD
ADVANCED TO
NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Three ACC men's golf teams, Duke, Georgia Tech, NC State and Wake Forest's Lee Bedford (Jr., Cary, N.C.) advanced to the NCAA Championship, played May 31-June 5, 2011 at Karsten Creek in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

Noteworthy:

-With the team title at the NCAA East Regional, Duke had three team championships on the season... this marked the fourth time in school history Duke has won three or more tournaments in a season.

-Duke's first place finish at the NCAA East regional was the best showing in school history. The Blue Devils previous regional play highs were fourth place finishes in 2010 and 1997.

-The Blue Devils advanced to the NCAA Championship for the third straight season under head coach Jamie Green...this was the second time in school history the team has reached the NCAA Championship in three straight seasons.

-Jamie Green was the first Duke head coach to guide the Blue Devils to three consecutive NCAA Championship trips.

-The Blue Devils ended the year with three tournament victories and reached match play at the NCAA Championship for first time in school history.

-Georgia Tech was in the finals for the 25th time in its history, and for the 24th time since 1985.

-Georgia Tech earned the second seed for the match play portion of the NCAA Championship and was defeated 3-2 in the quarterfinals by eventual national champion Augusta State.

-NC State advanced to the NCAA Championship after a fourth-place finish (855, -9) at the NCAA Florida Regional at the Golden Ocala Golf Course in Ocala, Fla.

-NC State's Mitchell Sutton (So., London, Ontario) earned a share of the medalist honors at 10-under par 206 with Augusta State's Patrick Reed and Missouri's Jace Long at the NCAA Florida Regional.

-This was the 16th appearance in the NCAA finals for the Wolfpack, and the first since 2006. However, Matt Hill did play as an individual in 2009 and won the event that year as he was named the top collegiate golfer in the nation.

-NC State finished 27th in the medal play portion of the NCAA Championship.

-Wake Forest junior Lee Bedford (Jr., Cary, N.C.) made a clutch birdie at the final hole of the NCAA Central Regional to secure the individual qualifying spot and earned a berth to the NCAA Championship. Bedford finished the tournament at 1-under par 212.

-Wake Forest's Lee Bedford was the first Demon Deacon to qualify as an individual for the NCAA Championship since Bill Haas in 2004.

-Lee Bedford finished tied for 32nd (222, +6) at the NCAA Championship.

In the June 5th Golfweek/Sagarin rankings, eight of the eleven ACC teams were ranked: Georgia Tech (2nd), Duke (12th), Virginia (21st), Clemson (27th), Wake Forest (30th), NC State (31st), Virginia Tech (43rd), and Florida State (44th).

Individually, three Georgia Tech players were ranked in the Top 15 of the June 5th Golfweek/Sagarin rankings: Kyle Scott (8th), J.T. Griffin (11th), and James White (14th). Wake Forest's Evan Beck is ranked 31st, Virginia's Ben Kohles ranked 36th, Wake Forest's Lee Bedford (37th) and NC State's Albin Choi (45th).

GREENSBORO, N.C. – Georgia Tech's Paul Haley has been named Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Golfer of the Month for April.
