The regular season results accounted for approximately 40 percent of the total and the tournament, the remaining 60 percent. • From 1986 to 1989, the conference champion was determined by a three-day single-elimination dual match tournament with a playback to determine places one through eight. • Since 1990 the conference champion has been determined by a single-elimination dual match tournament with no playback. • Since 1994, the tournament implemented the format of playing three doubles matches of pro-set length (8 games) with the team winning two of the sets receiving one point for the team match prior to playing six singles matches with the team scoring four points to be the team winner.
