REGIONAL SEMIFINAL GAME 1

Final Score: #1 Connecticut 78, #5 Old Dominion 63

Tournament Notes:

- UConn's Maya Moore led all scorers with her 11th double-double of the season scoring 25 points and grabbing 11 rebounds.
- Five UConn Huskies hit double figures including Maya Moore, Brittany Hunter, Renee Montgomery, Charde Houston and Tina Charles.
- ODU junior Tiffany Green had a double-double of 15 points and 10 rebounds, during a game in which she reached 1,000 career points with 1:50 remaining in the game.
- ODU senior T.J. Jordan ended her career with 1,525 points to rank 13th all-time for ODU players. In addition, fellow seniors, Shahida Williams finished with 953 points and Megan Pym finished with 602 points.
- UConn and ODU last played at the Paradise Jam in St. Thomas on Nov. 23, 2007, in which UConn won, 86-43.
- UConn and ODU have the third and fourth longest streaks of consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament at 20 and 17 respectively.
- UConn improved its all-time NCAA tournament record to 64-14 while ODU's all-time NCAA tournament record is 34-24.
- UConn is 14-2 and ODU is 5-7 all-time in NCAA Tournament regional semifinals.
- UConn entered the 2008 NCAA Tournament ranked #1 in the polls, but in the past five years the #1 ranked team has not won the NCAA Tournament.
- UConn has won 14 consecutive games.
- Five Big East teams made the NCAA regional semifinal, setting a Big East women's basketball record.
- UConn improves to 39-4 in NCAA Tournament games since the 2000 season and has won 29 of its last 31 games in the tournament.
- This will mark UConn's eight straight regional final appearance and its 14th overall.
