REGIONAL SEMIFINAL GAME 2

Final Score: #2 Rutgers 53, #6 George Washington 42

Tournament Notes:

- Rutgers senior Essence Carson tied her career record with 25 points to lead all scorers.
- George Washington's 16 points tied LSU for the second fewest points in a half of a NCAA regional semifinal game; the record is held by LSU at 15 points in 2006.
- Both teams combined to score only 44 points in the first half to tie LSU and Tennessee for the fourth-fewest points in a half of an NCAA regional semifinal game. Moreover, the combined total points for the teams were the second fewest all-time in NCAA regional semifinal games.
- Rutgers shot over 50 percent from the field in its first three games of the NCAA Tournament.
- GW attempted only four free throws for the fewest free throws attempted in a NCAA regional semifinal game.
- GW had the fourth lowest three-point percentage in NCAA regional semifinal history at 11.8 percent.
- Rutgers held GW to its lowest point total of the season at 42 points, which tied GW's 42 points against Rutgers on Nov. 18, 2007.
- Rutgers has limited 60 straight opponents to fewer than 80 points.
- Rutgers is 27-8 all-time against GW.
- Rutgers improved to 32-18 all-time in the NCAA Tournament, 7-3 in NCAA Tournament regional semifinal games.
- GW is 18-15 all-time in NCAA Tournament games.
- Rutgers is the only team to defeat UConn this season, with a final score of 73-71 at home on Feb. 5, 2008.
- Total attendance for Sunday's regional semifinals was 5,034.
