Clemson returns two starters in Julie Talley and Amanda White and welcome back six letterwinners for the 2004-05 season ... White, who earned All-ACC Academic honors for the second straight year, finished last season averaging 6.2 points and 4.9 rebounds per game as she played in over 26 minutes a game ... guard Julie Talley led the Tigers' in three-point shooting (37.7 percent) and finished fourth in the ACC ... Talley is the team's

top returning free throw shooter, connecting on 75 percent of her chances (33-for-44) from a year ago ... junior Khaili Sanders was Clemson's top shot blocker accumulating 39 blocked shots in 26 games, good for third overall in the conference at 1.50 blocks per game ... head coach Jim Davis will start his 18th season at the helm of the Clemson Tiger program where he holds a 346-178 record, having captured the ACC Championship twice in 1996 and 1999.

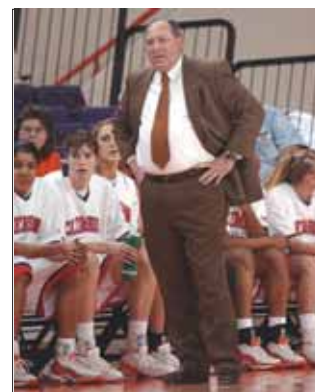

## CLEMSON HEAD COACH JIM DAVIS



Jim Davis has led the Tigers to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during the past 17 years, including a string of seven straight between 1996-2002 ... With 347 victories at Clemson, Davis is the all-time winningest coach in Tiger history ... He has led the Tigers to the final of the ACC Tournament on five occasions, with Clemson winning ACC titles in 1996 and 1999 ... In the 1999 Tournament, Davis' team knocked off No. 1 seeded Duke in the semifinals and beat North Carolina in the final ... Davis' 1999 squad recorded a school-record 26 wins and reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament ... Davis has guided Clemson to a post-season tournament 16 times in his 17 years as head coach ... Named ACC Coach of the Year twice, in 1990 and 1994 ... Davis' teams have recorded 20 wins or more during 11 of his 17 seasons as head coach ... Before coming to Clemson, Davis coached one year at Middle Tennessee State (1987), where he led the team to the regular-season Ohio Valley Conference title ... Davis served as an assistant women's basketball coach at the University of Florida in 1986 and spent six years (1979-85) as head coach at Roane State Community College ... At Roane State, Davis compiled a record of 127-35 (.784) and led his teams to four division championships and the 1984 National Junior College Athletic Association National Championship.
