The Duke Blue Devils enter the 2004-05 season in search of their sixth consecutive ACC Championship ... head coach Gail Goestenkors led Duke to a 30-4 record, 15-1 in the ACC, last season advancing to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament for the third year in a row ... now entering her 13th season at the helm, Goestenkors has posted an overall record of 302-88 and returns from the 2004 Olympic games with a gold medal after serving as assistant coach ... Monique Currie, a second-team All-ACC selection, returns as the Blue Devils' leading scorer (12.3 ppg) and rebounder (6.1 rpg) ... a third-team All-ACC selection and member of the ACC All-Defensive team, Lindsey Harding returns for her junior season having led the ACC with a 2.21 assist-to-turnover ratio and finishing third in assists per game at 4.94 ... Mistie Williams is the league's top returning shooter posting a .611 field goal percentage connecting on 132 of 216 shots from the floor.

DUKE HEAD COACH GAIL GOESTENKORS

Gail Goestenkers has led Duke to five consecutive ACC Tournament titles (2000-04) and has become the first league coach to perform such a feat ... After leading Duke to an ACC record 35 wins in 2003, she was named the Naismith, WBCA and Victor Award winner as the National Coach of the Year in 2003 ... Goestenkers was also named the 2000 *Basketball Times* and 1999 Victor Award winner as the National Coach of the Year ... in addition, she has been named ACC Coach of the Year on six occasions in the last nine years – 1996, 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003 and 2004 ... Guided the 2003 Blue Devils to the NCAA Final Four, their third appearance in five years ... her 1999 squad defeated three-time defending NCAA Champion Tennessee in the East Region Final and Georgia in the Final Four to reach the NCAA championship game ... Goestenkers' Duke teams won regular-season ACC championships in 1998, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004, and have posted back-to-back 19-0 league marks, going undefeated in both regular season and league championship play ... Led the Blue Devils to ten straight NCAA Tournaments, advancing to the Sweet 16 each of the last seven years and the Final Four in three of the last six years ... Recorded nine 20-plus win seasons in the last nine years, including four-straight 30-plus win seasons (2001-04) ... Before coming to Duke, Goestenkers served as an assistant coach for six seasons at Purdue (1986-92) ... Spent one year as a graduate assistant at Iowa State ... Played basketball at Saginaw Valley State from 1981 to 1985, where she was an NAIA All-American, team and conference MVP and an Academic All-Conference selection ... Was an assistant coach for the 2004 Athens Olympic gold medal team.
