Georgia Tech will welcome back seven letterwinners and two starters under second year head coach MaChelle Joseph ... as a team, the Yellow Jackets ranked third in scoring defense holding the opposition to 63.9 points per game and third in blocked shots with a 3.83 per game average ... junior Jessica Williams led the team in field goal percentage last year connecting on 49.6 percent of her shots while starting 21 games for the Yellow Jackets ... Williams was the league leader in offensive rebounds per game (2.93) and ranked 13th in total rebounding at 5.7 rpg ... Kasha Terry, Georgia Tech's leading shot blocker from a year ago, collected 43 blocks during ACC play making her the only player in the conference to average over 2.5 blocks per game ... Stephanie Higgs returns as the team's most accurate three-point shooter connecting on 41.2 percent of her shot from beyond the arc.

## GEORGIA TECH HEAD COACH MACHELLE JOSEPH

MaChelle Joseph begins her second season as the head coach of the Yellow Jackets when Georgia Tech hosts Georgia State on November 19 ... before becoming head coach, Joseph spent the prior two seasons as an assistant coach ... In 16 seasons as a collegiate player and assistant coach, Joseph has been part of programs that produced winning records every year but two, and have reached the NCAA Tournament 11 times ... Joseph came to Tech after serving as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 1997-2001 ... Helped guide the Tigers to a combined 97-50 record in five seasons and the second round of the NCAA Tournament three times ... Before joining the Auburn staff, Joseph coached as an assistant at her alma mater, Purdue, from 1994-96 and helped the Boilermakers post a sterling 73-24 (.753) record in three seasons ... Purdue advanced to the Final Four in 1994 and followed that performance with a trip to the NCAA Elite Eight in 1995 ... Also served one year (1993) as an assistant at Illinois ... Four-year starter for the Boilermakers from 1989-92, Joseph was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Year as well as second-team all-conference in 1989, was a first-team All-Big Ten selection in 1990, 1991 and 1992 and was named Big Ten Player of the Year as a senior ... Also earned Kodak All-America honors in 1992, when she was tabbed the Women's Basketball News' College Player of the Year.
