## TERRAPIN TIDBITS TERRAPIN TIDBITS TERRAPIN TIDBITS

Three starters and seven letterwinners return for Maryland, a year after the Terrapins made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2001 ... in her third year as head coach at Maryland, Brenda Frese will look to build off last season's third place conference finish and a berth in the semifinals of the ACC Tournament ... sophomore Shay Doron led the Terps and was eighth in the league in scoring with 13.5 points per game ... Doron, a third-team All-ACC honoree, netted a school-record 136 free throws last year and in the process set a new Maryland and ACC record as she posted 23 points in her regular season debut from the charity stripe, tying an NCAA single-game record ... Kalika France, who started all 31 games for Maryland in 2003-04, joined Doron on the ACC All-Freshmen squad ... guard Anesia Smith led the team in assist with 87.

## MARYLAND HEAD COACH BRENDA FRESE

Brenda Frese posted a 18-13 overall record and a 8-8 league mark in her second season at the helm of the Maryland women's basketball program ... under her leadership, the Terrapins improved from a 4-12 league mark in 2003 to an 8-8 mark last year ... the Terps advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament, making their first appearance since 2001 ... Prior to becoming the third head coach in the history of Maryland's women's basketball program, Frese was named the 2002 Associated Press National Coach of the Year and Big Ten Coach of the Year ... led an 8-22 Minnesota team to a 22-8 season the next year (2002), one of the best one-season turnarounds in NCAA history ... Frese took the Gophers to what was only the school's second NCAA appearance, where they defeated UNLV in the first round of the NCAA Tournament before being eliminated by three points in the second round by North Carolina ... Frese started her head coaching career during the 1999-2000 season at Ball State, a program that had gone 66-169 in the nine seasons prior to her arrival, she guided the Cardinals to a 16-13 showing in 2000 and garnered Coach of the Year honors in the Mid-American conference ... she led Ball State to a school-best 19-9 mark in 2000-01, capturing the school's second back-to-back winning seasons in Ball State history ... Frese launched her Division I coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach at Kent State University, helping the Golden Flashes to records of 20-8 (1994) and 17-10 (1995) during her two years there ... The Cedar Rapids, Iowa native then joined Bill Fennelly's staff at Iowa State as the Cyclones' recruiting coordinator where she assisted in another impressive turnaround, helping ISU to three NCAA Tournament appearances in four years.
