Kay Yow is back for her 30th season as head coach of the NC State Wolfpack having compiled a record of 596-280 while in Raleigh ... Yow and the Wolfpack faced the 13th toughest schedule in the nation last year, including ten games against ranked teams, leading to a berth in the 2004 NCAA Tournament ... sophomore Marquetta Dickens returns as the Packs' leading scorer after averaging 8.3 points per game a season ago ... Dickens appeared in all 32 games for NC State and posted a team leading 30 three-point field goals ... Kendra Bell was only one of four players in the ACC to play 40 plus minutes in two or more games in 2003-04 ... NC State ranked second in the league in assists per game with 16.28 tallying 521 assists over a 32 game span ... the Wolfpack will host the third annual Jimmy V Classic on November 21 when it squares-off against Tennessee on ESPN2.

## NC STATE HEAD COACH KAY YOW

Kay Yow led the Pack to its 17th NCAA appearance and finished the season with a 17-15 mark ... In September of 2002, NC State head coach Kay Yow was inducted into the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame ... On January 11, 2001, she became only the fifth women's basketball coach to reach the 600 career win milestone with a 71-64 victory over Temple ... in her 29 seasons as NC State's head coach, Kay Yow has led the Wolfpack to a 20-win season 18 times ... Her teams have received 17 bids to the NCAA Tournament, including eight since 1995 in the 21-year history of the tournament ... Yow was selected as *Sports Illustrated for Women's Coach of the Year* in 2000 and on Nov. 11, 1999, she was awarded the President and Mrs. George Bush Community Impact Award ... Yow has led the Wolfpack to four ACC Tournament titles, the most recent in 1991 ... Yow's 1997-98 squad made the program's first appearance in the NCAA Final Four after defeating No. 2 Old Dominion and No. 3 Connecticut in the Regionals ... With 636 wins, Yow ranks fifth nationally among the winningest Division I active women's basketball coaches by victories ... In Major International competition, Yow's teams have compiled a 21-1 record, and her 1998 U.S. Olympic team won gold at Seoul, Korea ... As head coach at Elon College, Yow's teams posted a 57-19 record and won two North Carolina state titles.
