Head coach Sylvia Hatchell enters her 19th season at the helm of the Tar Heel basketball program ... Hatchell holds an overall record of 654-262, while posting a mark of 382-182 with the Tar Heels ... North Carolina returns nine letterwinners and four starters from a team that finished last season with a 24-7 record and a 12-4 mark in the ACC, good for a second place finish ... Camille Little, first-team



All-ACC honoree, and Ivory Latta, second-team All-ACC honoree, were unanimous selections to the ACC All-Freshmen team ... Little, ACC Rookie of the Year, led all freshmen in scoring (14.3) and rebounding (7.9) and was second in field goal percentage (.512) from a year ago ... the Tar Heels return their top three scorers from last season accounting for 52 percent of North Carolina's points in 2003-04 ... senior Leah Metcalf was named to the All-ACC Academic team for the third straight year.
