Virginia's Debbie Ryan returns for her 28th season as head coach of the Cavaliers welcoming back eight letterwinners and three starters ... Ryan needs nine wins to become the third coach in the ACC to eclipse 600 career victories joining Sylvia Hatchell and Kay Yow ... Brandi Teamer was Virginia's leading scorer from a year ago averaging 11.5 ppg while



appearing in 24 games ... Kate Kreager led the team in field goal percentage with a .521 mark, good for third overall in the conference ... LaTonya Blue is the league's best returning free throw shooter from a year ago connecting on 69 of 86 attempts (80.2%) ... Blue also ranked second in the ACC in steals per game (2.39) and fourth in assists per game (4.36) en route to earning Third Team All-ACC honors.

## VIRGINIA HEAD COACH DEBBIE RYAN



Virginia head coach Debbie Ryan has led her teams to postseason play in 21 of her 27 years, including an ACC record, 20 straight appearances ... In 2000, Debbie Ryan was named ACC Coach of the Year for the seventh time, more than any other active ACC coach ... The 2000 team also won the regular-season ACC title, the 11th time the Cavaliers have finished first under Ryan ... On Feb. 21, 1999, Ryan collected her 500th win as Virginia defeated Florida State, becoming only the sixth coach to reach that milestone ... Averaging more than 22 wins a season, Ryan ranks among the NCAA Division I coaching leaders in all-time victories and winning percentage ... Ryan has led her teams to three Final Fours, and her 1991 team played in the NCAA championship game ... Ryan was named the Naismith Coach of the Year in 1991 and has also been honored by the Virginia Women's Forum and the Virginia General Assembly ... She has written three books: *Virginia Defense*, *Virginia Summer Development Program* and *Women's Basketball Drills-Conditioning* ... In her first taste of international competition as head coach of USA Basketball, Ryan led the women's basketball team to a silver medal performance at the Pan American Games this past August in the Dominican Republic ... Ryan played collegiate basketball at Ursinus College, where she earned her bachelor's degree in 1975 ... She received her master's degree from Virginia while working as an assistant basketball and field hockey coach.
