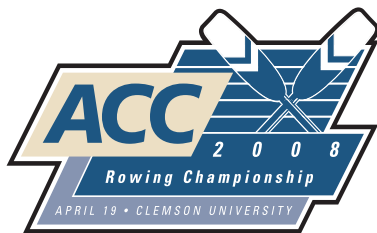

Virginia's 2008 Atlantic Coast Conference Rowing Champions captured UVa's ninth straight ACC title Saturday at Lake Hartwell in Clemson, S.C.

Virginia, led by its Varsity Eight+ crew, claimed its ninth consecutive Atlantic Coast Conference Rowing Championship Saturday morning on Lake Hartwell at Clemson University as the meet resulted in ACC Championship record times for three of the four events.

The Cavaliers, coached by Kevin Sauer, who was voted the ACC's Coach of the Year, captured three of four events to score 58 points and outdistance host Clemson, which finished second for the fifth time in the nine-year history of the ACC Rowing Championships.

Duke finished third with 33 points, followed in fourth place by North Carolina with 28, Miami was fifth with 24 points and Boston College finished in sixth place with 12.

Virginia's Varsity Eight+, ranked 3rd nationally, was named the ACC's Crew of the Year after claiming the ACC title in an ACC Rowing Championships record time of 6:22, 10 seconds better than the second-place Tigers, who recorded a time of 6:32.6. The previous ACC Rowing Championships record was a 6:28.1 finish by the Virginia Second Varsity Eight in 2007.

The Virginia First Varsity Eight is composed of Caitlin Mixter (cox-

swain, Oakton, Va.), Jennifer Cromwell (Bellevue, Wash.), Rebecca Ryall (Auckland, New Zealand), Lauren Hutchins (North Vancouver, Canada), Kelsie Chaudoin (Germantown, Tenn.), Desiree Burns (Poughkeepsie, N.Y.), Augusta Stratos (Charlottesville, Va.), Bridget Wandell (Clifton, Va.) and Katrin Sydlik (Schonebeck, Germany).

Virginia's record setting effort was one of three on the day as Clemson's Novice Eight+ set an ACC Championship mark with a time of 6:46.3, nudging Virginia (6:47.9) by 1.6 seconds. The win by Clemson in the Novice Eight marked only

the third time in the ACC Rowing Championships that a team other than Virginia captured an individual event. All three of those wins have been claimed by Clemson. In all, Virginia has won 33 of 36 individual ACC Rowing events in route to nine straight ACC Championships.

Virginia recorded an ACC Championship record in the First Varsity Four with a time of 7:18.10, edging Clemson (7:25.9). The previous standard of 7:23.4 was set by UVa in 2006.

Virginia also won the Second Varsity Eight race (6:31.4), edging Clemson.

Clemson freshman Liz Robb of Roswell, Ga. was named as the ACC's Freshman of the Year and earned a spot on the All-ACC Rowing Team.

Virginia coxswain Caitlin Mixer earned her third straight All-ACC Rowing accolade, becoming the first coxswain in ACC history to be named to the ALL-ACC team three times. North Carolina senior Lisy McIntee was also named to the all-conference team for the third consecutive year. Mixer and McIntee are only the third and fourth ACC rowers to be named three times to the All-ACC Rowing team. Duke's Joanna Hingle (2001-03) and Clemson's Sarah Cooper (2005-07) are the others.

Sauer was named ACC Coach of the Year for the fifth time in his nine years at UVa.

Robb, Mixer and McIntee led by the All-ACC team selections which also included Kelsie Chaudoin, Katrin Sydlik, Bridget Wandelt and Augusta Stratos of Virginia; Suzanne Van Fleet and Jessica Leidecker of Clemson; Gwen Coleman and Alex Japhet of Duke; Ruby Woodside of North Carolina; Laura Cordner and Kelly Amster of Miami and Tracy Maciolek of Boston College.

VIRGINIA'S VARSITY EIGHT VOTED
2008 ACC CREW OF THE YEAR

APRIL 19, 2008

Virginia's Varsity Eight+ crew was voted the Atlantic Coast Conference Crew of the Year on a vote of the league's six head coaches at the Ninth Annual ACC Rowing Championships held April 19 at Lake Hartwell in Clemson, S.C.

Virginia 1V8+ captured the ACC title in an ACC Championships record time of 6:22.0, more than 10 seconds better than second-place Clemson.

The Virginia Varsity Eight crew, ranked 3rd nationally, has only one loss on the year, and that to top-ranked California by two and a half seconds at the PAC-10 Challenge on March 29. Since then, Virginia's V8+ has won eight straight races including defeating six nationally-ranked foes in the process including Michigan State (7), Michigan (9), Stanford (10), Ohio State (14), UCLA (16) and Clemson (18).

Clemson freshman Liz Robb was voted the Atlantic Coast Conference Rowing Freshman of the Year by a vote of the league's six head coaches. Robb was one of two freshmen named to the All-ACC Rowing team. She is Clemson's first ACC Freshman of the Year selection and is the second Rowing student-athlete to win the honor.

Virginia Head Rowing Coach Kevin Sauer, who guided UVa to its ninth straight ACC Rowing title, was named the ACC's Rowing Coach of the Year by the vote of the ACC's six head coaches. Sauer, whose Cavaliers have captured 32 of the 36 events in the nine years of the ACC Rowing Championships was honored as ACC Coach of the Year for the fifth time.

STRAIGHT WEEK

APRIL 9, 2008

Virginia's Varsity Eight+ was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Rowing Crew of the Week Monday after defeating 7th-ranked Michigan State and unranked Wisconsin and Oregon State in a series of races this weekend at Lake Monticello outside of Charlottesville, Va.

The honor was the third consecutive ACC "Crew of the Week" award for the Virginia team.

Virginia's Varsity Eight+, ranked 3rd nationally, posted a time of 6:22.1 to defeat the Spartans (6:27.1) by five seconds. Later Saturday, the Cavaliers then posted a time of 6:30.8 defeating Wisconsin by more than 12 seconds. UVa then capped off the weekend on Sunday, recording a season's-best 6:17.8 time in outdistancing Oregon State by more than eight seconds.

The Virginia First Varsity Eight is composed of Caitlin Mixter (coxswain, Oakton, Va.), Jennifer Cromwell (Bellevue, Wash.), Rebecca Ryall (Auckland, New Zealand), Lauren Hutchins (North Vancouver, Canada), Kelsie Chaudoin (Germantown, Tenn.), Desiree Burns (Poughkeepsie, N.Y.), Augusta Stratos (Charlottesville, Va.), Bridget Wandell (Clifton, Va.) and Katrin Sydlik (Schonebeck, Germany).

Virginia's First Varsity Eight Crew was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Rowing Crew of the Week for the second week in a row Tuesday after defeating 9th-ranked Ohio State and 10th-ranked Michigan at the Big Ten/ACC Duals this past weekend at the Griggs Reservoir in Columbus, Ohio.

Virginia's Varsity Eight+, ranked 3rd nationally, posted a time of 6:20.4 to defeat the Buckeyes (6:31.1) by more than 10 seconds. The Cavaliers then posted a time of 6:18.1 in defeating the 10th-ranked Wolverines.

Clemson's Varsity Eight Crew, ranked 17th nationally in the pre-season, was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Rowing Crew of the Week Wednesday after posting wins in a dual meet with Boston College and capturing the Clemson Challenge, held on Lake Hartwell in Clemson.

The Clemson Varsity Eight is composed of Elyse Roenick (coxswain, Palm Harbor, Fla.), Brittany Robinson (Waxhaw, N.C.), Ford Heiner (Oak Ridge, Tenn.), Megan Bendick (Marietta, Ga.), Mairi Trimboli (Ludlow, Vt.) Michelle Nance (Simpsonville, S.C.), Elizabeth Robb (Roswell, Ga.), Suzanne Van Fleet (Exton, Pa.) and Jessica Leidecker (Westerville, Ohio). The Tigers came in first in the Clemson Challenge in a time of 6:48.7, outdistancing Penn (6:57.63), Indiana (7:07.7), Purdue (7:09.53) and Ithaca (7:15.95).

Earlier on March 8 at Lake Hartwell, Clemson's Varsity Eight defeated Boston College in a race limited to 1,000 meters due to weather conditions.

The Tigers were ranked 17th in the USRowing/Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association NCAA Division I Varsity Eight Coaches Poll, which was released last Friday. Virginia's Varsity Eight was ranked second nationally to top-ranked Yale in the pre-season poll.

The Tigers defeated Cornell's Second Varsity Eight+ in a time of 6:51.8, as the Big Red recorded a time of 6:57.64.

Virginia's First Varsity Eight Crew was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Rowing Crew of the Week Tuesday after defeating 10th-ranked Stanford and 13th-ranked UCLA at the PAC-10 Challenge this past weekend in Redwood Shores, Calif.

Virginia, 2nd ranked nationally, also dropped a close decision to 9th-ranked California.

The Virginia First Varsity Eight is composed of Caitlin Mixter (coxswain, Oakton, Va.), Jennifer Cromwell (Bellevue, Wash.), Rebecca Ryall (Auckland, New Zealand), Lauren Hutchins (North Vancouver, Canada), Kelsie Chaudoin (Gerrantown, Tenn.), Desiree Burns (Poughkeepsie, N.Y.), Augusta Stratos (Charlottesville, Va.), Bridget Wandell (Clifton, Va.) and Katrin Sydlik (Schonebeck, Germany).

The Cavaliers defeated 10th-ranked Stanford's First Varsity Eight in a time of 7:20.51, as the Cardinal recorded a time of 7:31.05 and also defeated 13th-rated UCLA with a time of 6:49.33 to the Bruins' 7:06.64.

Virginia lost to 9th-ranked California as the Bears recorded a time of 6:51.36, while UVa was three and a half seconds behind in a time of 6:54.86.

The honor is the first for the nationally-ranked Cavaliers this year.
