#2 Boston College vs. #3 North Carolina

Boston College coach Alison Kulik:

In terms of the competition I think it was two great teams out there, two teams that always battle and always leave everything out on the field. I thought as the game went on I was really impressed with the way I thought we got better, given the fact that our last two matches were double overtime games. So I was really proud of our ability to endure and continue to play really good soccer. It is an unfortunate way to lose in second overtime and on your own goal. But I think leaving the ACC tournament playing two really really good teams, Virginia and UNC certainly prepares you for the NCAA.

Anything you are going to do to prepare for the tournament?:

Rest.

North Carolina coach Anson Dorrance:

"I thought the first half we played magnificent soccer. Even the games where we beat UCLA 7-2 and Notre Dame 6-0, I don't think we played any better than we did in the first half against Boston College tonight. I think BC in the second half played a lot better which forced us to make some adjustments. I'm certainly very proud of my kids, proud of the fact they were dying to win it in overtime and obviously we did."

"Tonight we played very well and I think we're within an eyelash of breaking open some of these games. With the exception of just putting it in the back of the net, we created so many chances."

On overtime: "We're just happy to be in the final. There are a lot of players we're not playing now, that we've been playing before.....I think we've got enough depth to rotate players through so we can stay relatively fresh."
