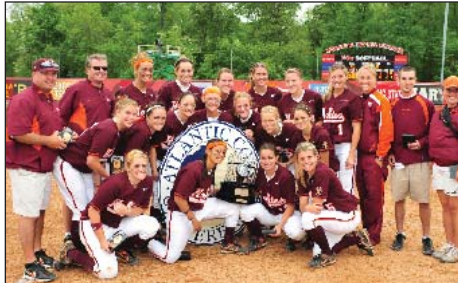

Virginia Tech advances to the College World Series for the first time in school history ... the Hokies were the first ACC team to earn a berth in the WCWS since Florida State did so in 2004 ... league pre-season favorite Virginia Tech captures second straight ACC trifle with a 2-0 win over NC State in the finals of the 17th annual ACC Tournament held in College Park, Md. ... North Carolina finished first in the ACC during the regular season for the first time since 2000 with a 18-2 league mark ... Virginia Tech's Angela Tincher named the 2008 USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year ... Tincher, the ACC Pitcher of the Year for the third year in a row, and North Carolina's Danielle Spaulding, the ACC Player of the Year, earn All-America recognition ... NC State's Alyssa Allbritten named ACC Freshman of the Year ... North Carolina's Donna Papa tabbed ACC Coach of the Year for the fourth time ... Virginia Tech ranked 8th in final ESPN.Com/USA Softball and 16th in the USA Today/NFCA ranking ... North Carolina ranked 25th and 15th, respectively ... four ACC teams - Virginia Tech, North Carolina, Maryland and Georgia Tech - were ranked at least one week during the 2008 season ... Virginia Tech's Tincher finishes as the ACC's all-time leader in wins (123), strikeouts (2,149) and innings pitched (1116.1) and second in complete games (125) ... Georgia Tech senior Savannah Brown is the ACC career leader in runs batted in with 194 while teammate Whitney Haller is tied for first with 49 career home runs ... for the second straight year Tincher led the NCAA in earned run average (0.63) ... Tincher also led the nation in strikeouts per seven innings (13.8) ... Florida State second on the NCAA's all-time victories chart with 1,174 wins in 24 seasons.

NOTING THE 2008 ACC CHAMPIONSHIP

• North Carolina's Danielle Spaulding tossed the first perfect game in ACC Championship history in North Carolina's 6-0 win over Virginia on day one of the championship. In that performance, the ACC Player of the Year needed only 87 pitches to record her seventh shutout of the season, moving the Tar Heels on to day two in the winner's bracket.

• After giving up three hits and three runs in the first inning of her first start of the week against No. 7 seed Maryland, Virginia Tech's Angela Tincer allowed only five more hits and zero runs over her last 20 innings pitched, as the ACC Pitcher of the Year led Tech to its second consecutive ACC title. Tincer, who struck out 39 in the three games, has 81 strikeouts in the Championship over the last two years and was named the tournament MVP in both 2007 and 2008.

• ACC Pitchers registered two no-hitters, including Spaulding's perfect game and Tincer's no-hitter against Florida State in semifinal play, in nine contests during the Championship. Entering the week, only one solo no-hitter, by FSU's Rebecca Aase in 1992, had ever been recorded in ACC Championship competition.

• Despite her defeat in the title game, NC State's Lindsay Campana completed the tournament with a 0.00 ERA in 21 innings pitched. Campana, who only allowed two unearned runs in the title game, tossed a one-hit complete game shutout against Georgia Tech on day one before holding top-seeded North Carolina scoreless on only three hits in the Wolfpack's 1-0 upset over the Tar Heels.

• With her second strikeout against Boston College on the opening day of the Championship, Florida State senior pitcher Tiffany McDonald broke the school's career record of 899, held by two-time first-team All-American Jessica van der Linden. McDonald, who finished with 13 strikeouts against the Eagles, now has 914 in her career with the Seminoles.

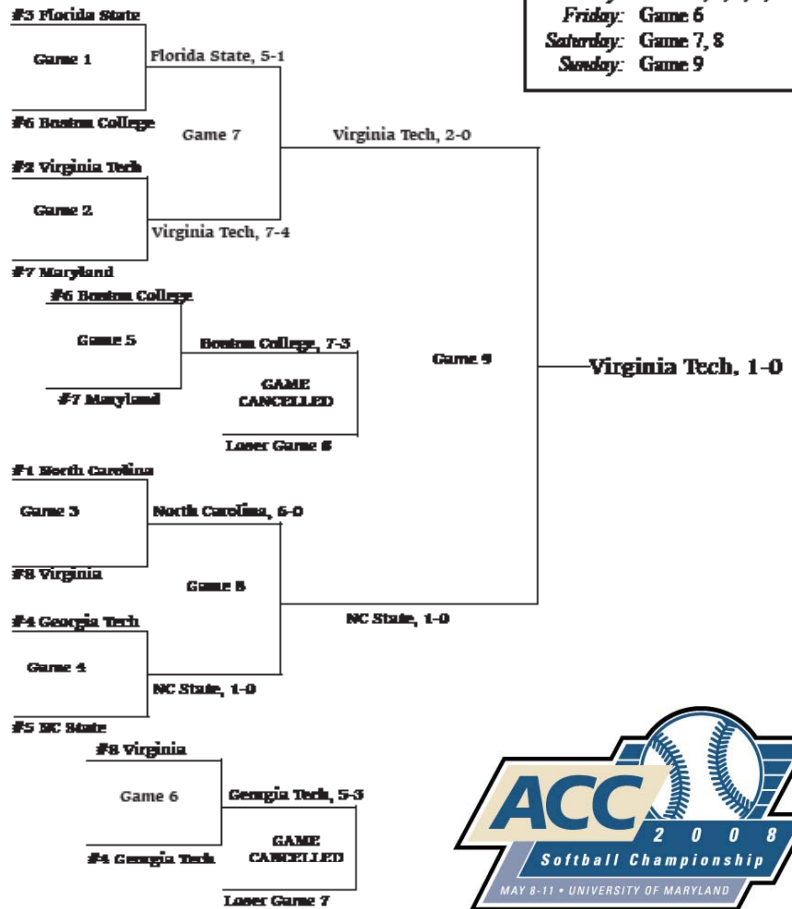
