DUKE AND NORTH CAROLINA SHARE ACC VOLLEYBALL CROWN

For the second time in league history, two teams shared the ACC Volleyball Championship. Duke captured its ninth league title while North Carolina won its 11th ACC Championship. Both teams finished the league play at 15-5. North Carolina earned the league's automatic bid based on a 4-3 aggregate score in the teams two meetings. The Tar Heels were joined in the NCAA Championship by Duke and Clemson. Each of the three teams posted a 1-1 record in the tournament.
