



## 2011 FALCON STADIUM ENTRANCE POLICIES

- Air Force Academy entrance gates (North and South) will open 4 hours prior to kickoff and will remain open to the public 3 hours following the game.
- Stadium Gates and Ticket Booths will open 2 hours prior to kickoff.
- All persons and personal belongings entering the stadium are subject to search.
- The following items are NOT permitted in Falcon Stadium:
  - Alcoholic beverages
  - Artificial noisemakers of any kind
  - Bags larger than 8" x 11". Hard-sided containers
    - Diaper bags are permitted if infant is present
  - Banners or large signs (No signs larger than 18" x 24")
  - Food or drink, including glass containers and cans
    - Factory-sealed transparent soft plastic water bottles, 24 oz. or less are the only drinks permitted
    - Exceptions will be made for medical conditions and infants
  - Items that cannot be readily inspected
    - Backpacks to include bota bags, wine-skins, and camelbacks
    - Infant carrier packs permitted if infant is present
  - Items deemed unsafe by security personnel
  - Laser pointers
  - Pets (other than working service dogs)
  - Sticks, poles or umbrellas
  - Weapons, Firearms, Fireworks
  - Baby seats, Large Strollers
    - Collapsible strollers are permitted
- Express lines available for spectators entering the stadium with nothing to be searched.
- Flash photography is not permitted.
- Smoking is not permitted within Falcon Stadium
- Reentry is permitted for emergencies only.
- Seatbacks 18" or less are permitted as long as they do not require a search due to excessive pockets and compartments.
- Storage of prohibited or any other items is not provided.
- All cadets must have their military ID card.
