



## 2010-11 CADET GYMNASIUM ENTRANCE POLICIES

- The Cadet Gymnasium will open 1 hour prior to the start of the event.
- All persons and personal belongings entering the Cadet Gymnasium are subject to search.
- The following items are NOT permitted in the Cadet Gymnasium:
  - Alcoholic beverages
  - Artificial noisemakers of any kind
  - Bags larger than 8" x 11". Hard-sided containers
    - Diaper bags are permitted if infant is present
  - Banners or large signs (No signs larger than 18" x 24")
  - Glass containers or cans
    - Empty transparent soft plastic bottles 24 oz. or less are permitted
  - Items that cannot be readily inspected
    - Backpacks to include bota bags, wine-skins, and camelbacks
    - Infant carrier packs permitted if infant is present
  - Items deemed unsafe by security personnel
  - Laser pointers
  - Pets (other than working service dogs)
  - Sticks, poles or umbrellas
  - Weapons, Firearms, Fireworks
  - Baby Seats, Large Strollers
    - Collapsible strollers are permitted
- Flash photography is not permitted.
- Food and Drink are permitted under the following conditions
  - Food items are allowed if all items can be readily inspected.
  - Factory-sealed transparent soft plastic water bottles, 24 oz. or less are permitted
- Reentry is not permitted for ticketed events.
- Seatbacks 18" or less are permitted. Seatbacks will be permitted as long as they don't require a search due to excessive pockets and compartments.
- Storage of prohibited items or any other items is not provided.
- All cadets must have their military ID card or proximity card and game ticket (if applicable).
