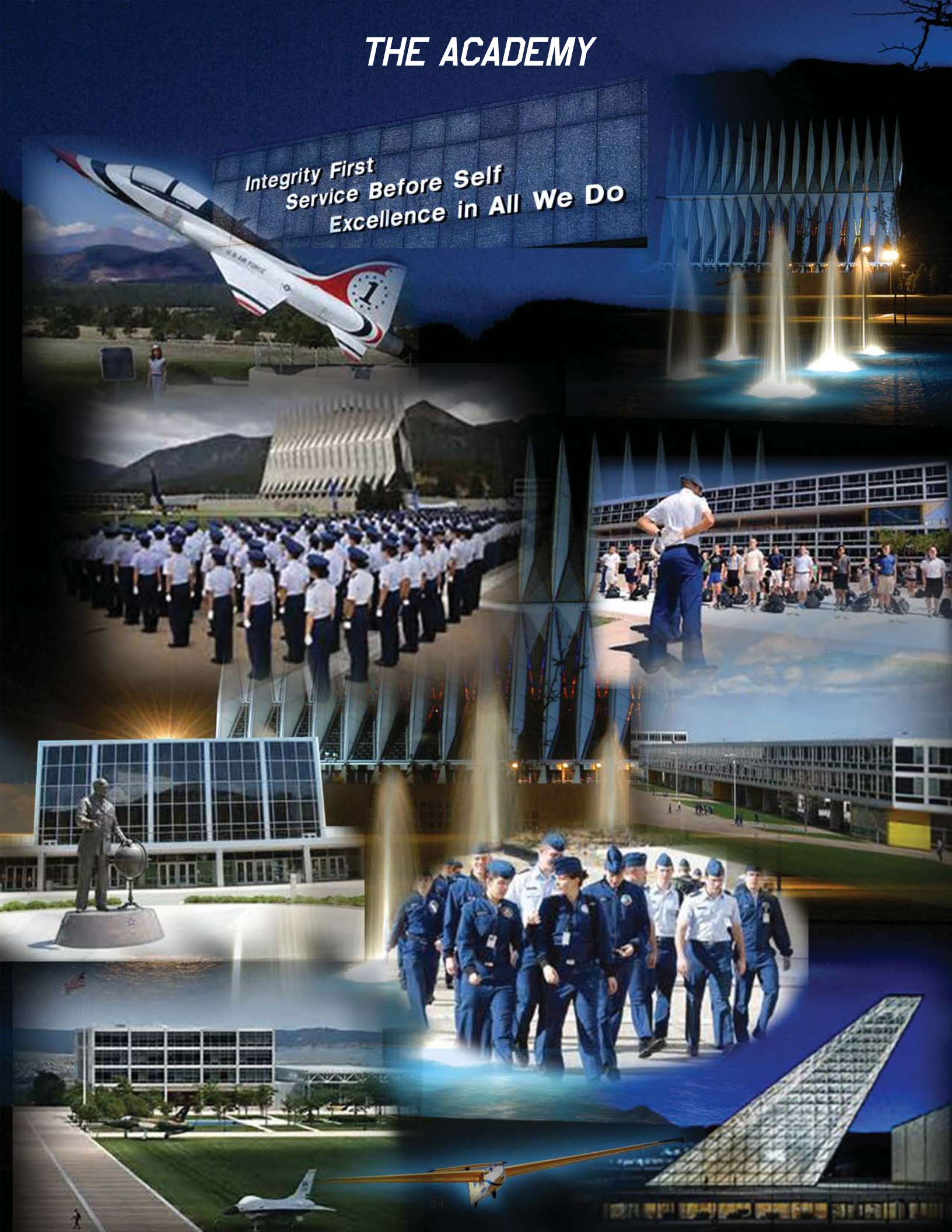

SEASON WRAP/TEAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

15-6 season; -- 5-6 PRC; NCAA 8th

The Air Force rifle team concluded the 2016-2017 season eighth in the nation, fourth in the Patriot Rifle Conference (5-5), and had a 15-6 (.714) season record. Following the PRC Championships on Feb. 4-5, two Air Force members were named all-conference in air rifle. Sophomore Spencer Cap placed second, and freshman Logan Ogden was third in the conference. The season was capped off with a new team record 4704 scored in the NCAA Qualifier Match against TCU on Feb. 18, 2017, and followed by the team's selection to the NCAA Rifle Championships in March.

Following the PRC Championships, the Falcons traveled to Fort Worth, Texas, on Feb. 18 for the qualifier match versus TCU. The Falcons kept the scores close, only losing by one point 2333-2334 in smallbore. In the air rifle, TCU only led by three points (2371-2374). In the final team score, it was Air Force 4704, TCU 4708. The Falcons' team score set a new school record under head coach Launi Meili.

In 2016, the rifle team opened the season on the road with a match against Alaska and TCU in Fairbanks, Alaska, on Oct. 8. The match was the best season opener for the Falcons, as they set a team record by 11 points with a 4698. Senior Ryan Jacobs was the team's top performer in both rifles, setting an overall career best in the smallbore, air rifle and aggregate score. Air Force finished with 2328 points in smallbore and 2370 in air rifle. TCU finished with a 4709, while Alaska came in with 4679 points.

Following the trip to Alaska, the Falcons returned home for two days of PRC matches on Oct. 22-23. Air Force went 2-0 against conference opponents No. 12 Nevada and No. 17 UTEP. In the triangular match, the Falcons won 4673 to Nevada's 4643 and UTEP's 4622. The following day, the Falcons (4696) went 2-0 again against Nevada (4646) and UTEP (4622).

In November, Air Force was host to the President's Trophy Match against Army, Navy and the U.S. Coast Guard (Nov. 5, 2016). The Falcons won the President's Trophy for the third year in a row (four out of the last five years), and set a new President's Trophy Match record (5858) for the second-straight year (5839 in 2015). In NCAA scoring (top four team scores), Air Force won 4698, Army 4646, Navy 4607 and Coast Guard 4474. Cap set a school record 598 in the air rifle.

In the following competition, the Falcons suffered two losses to the TCU Horned Frogs in Fort Worth, Texas, on Nov. 12-13. On Saturday, the Falcons lost 4712-4684, and on Sunday, they lost 4728-4679. Cap scored a career high 585 in the smallbore. Ogden shot a 594 in air rifle, which was a career high. Kyle Cox had a career high in the air rifle (567).

The two matches closed out the first half of the regular season.

On Dec. 2-4, the rifle team competed in the 2016 Winter Air Gun Championships (WAG) at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs. At the WAG, Cap claimed two silver medals for the men's junior championships. On the final day, he scored a 246.4 in the Finals to become the junior champion. Ogden, with a 223.8 in Finals, won bronze in the juniors.

In 2017, returning for the spring, No. 4 Air Force went 1-1 in the

year's opening match at home against PRC opponent No. 6 Ohio State and No. 14 Jacksonville State on Jan. 14. Anna Weilbacher was the Falcons' leading scorer overall in the match. Her aggregate score (1184) and smallbore score (592) were both career highs and school records.

On Jan. 28, the team traveled to Charleston, S.C., for two days of matches hosted by the The Citadel Bulldogs. Fourth-ranked Air Force won the match with 4,767 points, and No. 20 North Georgia placed second with 4,547 points to narrowly hold off the third-place Bulldogs' season-high-tying total of 4,518 points. VMI's men's team was fourth with 4,488 points, with the Keydet women's 4,408 points placing fifth. Wofford scored 4,292 to take sixth, and The Citadel women placed seventh with 4,263 points. The Falcons' top individuals in the match were Weilbacher, with an aggregate score of 1174, and Jacobs with 1171 points. Cap followed with 1169. In smallbore, Ogden had 1162 while scoring a 583 for a career best. Jacobs shot a 594 and had a perfect 200 on his first two air rifle series.

On Jan. 29, the Falcons scored 4,696 points to win the match. The Bulldogs' co-ed team took second with 4,514 points, and The Citadel women's team finished third with 4,273 points. Jacobs was the leading scorer in the contest, finishing with 1180. He had a 587 smallbore and 593 in air rifle, which led all competitors in scoring. Leading in the next six top positions were: Ogden with 1174, Weilbacher's 1173, Cap's 1169, Nick Learn's 1162 and Spencer Brandon's 1145.

In February, Air Force finished 4704 - TCU 4708 in the NCAA qualifier match. The qualifier started with the smallbore contest. With a career best, Cap shot a 587, one point above TCU's Casey Lutz. Jacobs and two of TCU's shooters split with 583 points, but with the highest number of inner tens, Jacobs finished third ahead of the TCU shooters, who finished fourth and fifth in the match. Ogden and TCU's Mindy Miles scored 582. Ogden, with more inner 10s, finished sixth ahead of Miles. Weilbacher split with Ariana Grabowski from TCU with 581 points. Weilbacher finished in eighth place and Grabowski was ninth. The Falcons' official scoring squad finished 2333 to TCU's 2334.

Jacobs led in the top air rifle individual standings with a 596, which is his career best. He finished second in the overall standings with an aggregate 1179. Cap led in the top individual standings with an aggregate 1181, which tied his career aggregate, he scored a 594 in the discipline. The Falcons' Weilbacher and Ogden also ranked in the top 10 of the individual standings. With a 592, Weilbacher had an aggregate 1173, Ogden shot 589 and finished with 1171. The Falcons' finished 2371 in air rifle, TCU won the contest with 2374.

Closing out the season, Air Force finished eighth in the nation. The team scored an aggregate 4653 in the NCAA Men's and Women's Rifle Championships in Columbus, Ohio, on March 10-11. Air Force had 2307 smallbore and 2346 in air rifle. The Falcons' top individual shooters were Cap in smallbore (581) and Jacobs in air rifle (591).

Three cadet-athletes were named CRCA Scholar All-Americans, Mary Simonton, class of 2017, Spencer Brandon, Class of 2018, and Kyle Cox, Class of 2020.

AIR FORCE IN THE PATRIOT RIFLE CONFERENCE

Cap and Ogden named as Patriot Rifle All-Conference individuals

The Air Force rifle team traveled to Columbus, Ohio, for the Patriot Rifle Conference Smallbore and Air Rifle Championships, Feb. 4-5. Two Air Force cadet-athletes earned all-conference for air rifle.

All-Conference: In air rifle, Spencer Cap was tied at 593 with four opponents, but by counts of center shots, Cap, who had the most shots, qualified for the top-eight of the Finals match. Logan Ogden, with a score of 595, was tied with a TCU shooter but advanced to the Finals top eight with the greater count of center shots. TCU's Mindy Miles, who shot a 600/600 on the Falcons Rifle Range in 2015, advanced to the finals with a 598. In Finals elimination, Miles finished first, Cap second and Ogden third to earn individual air rifle all-conference honors.

Recap: On Feb. 4-5, for the third consecutive year, the Falcons finished fourth in the PRC. In team standings, TCU won the conference team title, Alaska took second, and Ohio State finished third. Nevada and UTEP finished fifth and sixth, respectively.

In smallbore (Feb. 4), the Falcons had a team score of 2309. Cap, Anna Weilbacher, and Alaska's Luke Johnson split with 579 points. With more center shots scored, Cap came out ahead of the other two shooters. Ryan Jacobs finished with 577 points, while Ogden had a 574. Nick Learn (568) and Spencer Brandon (559).

In air rifle (Feb 5), the Falcons scored a 2364. Ogden had the team-high score with a 595 and finished the match with 1169 total points. Ogden topped off his air rifle score with a perfect 100 in his last series. Cap finished with 593 points for a final 1172 points. Jacobs scored a 589 in the gun and finished with 1166 points. Learn scored 587 points for a total score of 1155, while Brandon shot a 587 and finished with 1146 points. Both Brandon and Cap scored 100 for their second series, Cap also had a perfect 100 for his fourth series of shots. Weilbacher scored a 586 and had a final score of 1165.

Individual Career Highs: Scoring in the PRC Championships, both Learn and Brandon earned smallbore career highs (587). Ogden claimed a career high for the air rifle with a 595.

2017 PRC Team Record: 5-5 (.500) (Fourth Place)

In 2013, the six-member conference was formed, and Air Force head rifle coach Launi Meili was named the Patriot Rifle Conference commissioner. Competition between the six schools started in 2014.

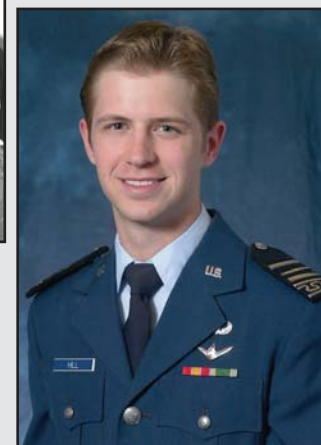

The NCAA was founded in 1980. Prior to NCAA sponsorship in 1980, a collegiate rifle championship was held yearly by the National Rifle Association. From 1980 to 2004, the championship consisted of 120 shots by each competitor in smallbore, and 40 shots per competitor in air rifle. Since 2005, the championship has consisted of 60 shots for both smallbore and air rifle, equaling a total of 120 shots per team member. In 2014, Meredith Carpentier, air rifle, finished 13th with 588 points. She was the only AFA qualifier. The team's 2016 national finish (fourth) is the school's highest national ranking since 2012 (water polo finished fourth).

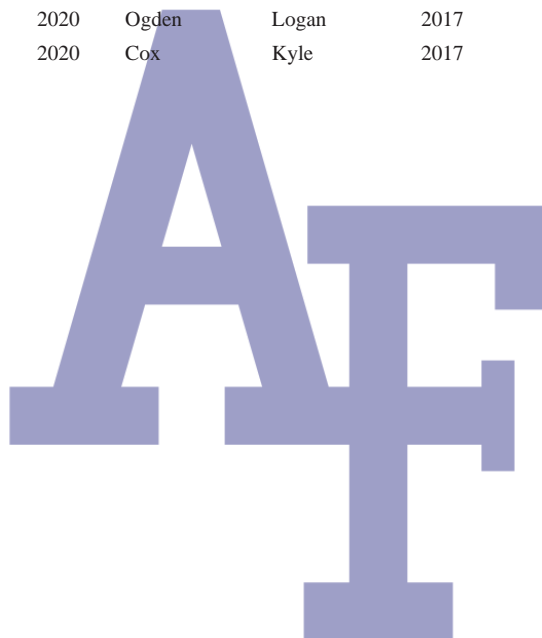
