NOTES

THE SERIES

Air Force and Colorado State are meeting for the 111th time overall. Colorado State leads the series, 79-31. The Rams are 41-10 at home, 33-19 at Air Force and 5-2 in neutral site games. Colorado State has won 12 straight in the series dating back to Air Force's last win, 75-47, on Feb. 26, 2011 at the Academy. Colorado State swept a pair of meetings last year. The Rams won 85-58 in Fort Collins Jan. 7. Colorado State beat Air Force, 81-58, in the MW tournament in Las Vegas. The teams first played Jan. 19, 1957 in the Denver Auditorium Arena. Air Force won the game, 70-62.

LAST SEASON VS. COLORADO STATE (March 9, 2017 at MW Tourn.)

Colorado State senior guard Gian Clavell scored 30 points to lead second-seeded Colorado State to an 81-55 victory over No. 10 seed Air Force in Thursday's quarterfinal round.

Also scoring in double figures for the Rams were Prentiss Nixon with 15, Emmanuel Omogbo with 12 and Nico Carvacho, who had 10 points and led the team with nine rebounds. After trading buckets over the first six minutes of the contest, and falling behind 16-12 early, the Rams went to work, paced by Clavell and sophomore Braden Koelliker. The pair combined to score the game's next 11 points, pushing Colorado State ahead by seven, 23-16. Air Force wasn't done, though, and used an 8-0 run to move ahead 24-19. It would be the last lead the Falcons would see, as Colorado State closed the first half on a 16-2 run and take a 39-26 lead into halftime.

The Rams surged to a 20-point lead over the first three minutes of the second half, 46-26. The Falcons did their best to stay with Colorado State, which had the league's second-best scoring defense during the regular season, but Clavell was clearly on a mission.

During a span of 6:23, the 6-foot-4 shooting guard from Puerto Rico scored 14 of Colorado State's 20 points, as the Rams maintained their 20-point lead, and eventually extended it to 28, with 9:23 left in the game, at 69-41. The Rams' lead swelled to 30 at one point. Hayden Graham led the Falcons with 15 points, while Lavelle Scottie contributed with 12.

(Jan. 7, 2017 at Colorado State) Gian Clavell scored 28 points and Prentiss Nixon added 20 as Colorado State defeated Air Force, 85-58, Jan. 7 at Moby Arena in Fort Collins, Colo.

Colorado State closed the first half with seven straight points to take a 33-28 halftime lead. Nixon scored five points in the run, including a 3-pointer to start it to give the Rams the lead for good, 29-28, with 2:20 to play. Colorado State scored 12 straight points early in the second half to extend the lead to 15 points, 47-32, with 15:15 remaining. The Rams went on to lead by as many as 34 points, the largest deficit Air Force has faced this season, 83-49, with 4:49 to play. The closest Air Force got after that was the final margin, 27 points.

Colorado State hit 50 percent from the field, including a 43.8 clip from 3-point range on 14-of-32 shooting. The Rams out-rebounded

Air Force, 31-29, and scored 26 points off 18 Air Force turnovers. Emmanuel Omogbo added 14 points and game highs of 10 rebounds and five assists for the Rams. Anthony Bonner chipped in with 11 points.

Air Force hit 41.7 percent from the field and just 26.3 from three, hitting five of 19 attempts beyond the arc. Frank Toohey scored 14 points and had four assists to lead the Falcons. Jacob Van added 11 points. Zach Kocur chipped in with eight points and a team-high nine rebounds.

AIR FORCE'S LAST GAME

Sophomore Ryan Swan recorded career highs of 19 points and nine rebounds to lead Air Force past San Jose State, 78-71, Saturday afternoon in The Event Center in San Jose, Calif. The win snapped a 24-game conference road losing streak for the Falcons and is their first MW road win since beating San Jose State, 66-52, Jan. 28, 2015.

Air Force came out of the gates fast and opened an 11-2 lead in the first four minutes. The Falcons hit 63 percent from the field and made seven of their first 11 threes to build a 28-12 lead with 11:08 left in the first half. Air Force went on to lead by as many as 18 points, 33-15, with 7:27 left. San Jose State closed the first half on 19-7 run to cut the lead to 40-34 at the half.

San Jose State opened the second half with an 11-2 run to take its first lead of the game, 45-42, with 16:13 left. The Falcons opened the half 0-7 from the field, including a 0-5 mark from three during the run. The teams exchanged leads until senior Trevor Lyons hit a jumper to give the Falcons the lead for good, 52-51, with 9:04 left. The Falcons build the lead to as many as 10 points, 69-59, with 1:04 left. Air Force hit 9-14 free throws from that point, including five of its last six in the final 17 seconds, to secure the win.

Air Force shot 41.1 percent from the field, including a 39.4 clip from three on 13 of 33 shooting. The Falcons hit 67.9 percent from the free throw line and out-rebounded San Jose State, 37-33. The team had 16 assists on 23 made field goals and recorded just eight turnovers.

Jacob Van came off the bench to score a season-high 14 points while recording a season-best four rebounds and match his career high with three 3-pointers. Pervis Louder added 12 points off the bench, while Lavelle Scottie chipped in with 11 points and six rebounds.

The Falcons had a 12-7 edge in second chance points and out-scored the Spartans, 39-13, in bench scoring. San Jose State was led by Ryan Welage, who had 17 points and eight rebounds. Jalen James added 13 points, Noah Baumann 11 and Keith Fisher 10. The Spartans hit 47.1 percent from the field, but were held to just 37.0 percent in the second half.

- Air Force snapped a 24-game Mountain West road losing streak. The Falcons won their first conference road game since beating San Jose State, 66-52, Jan. 28, 2015.
- Air Force improved to 6-6 all-time vs. San Jose State, including a 3-3 mark in San Jose. The Falcons snapped a three-losing streak to the Spartans, winning for the first time since a 64-57 win Jan. 2, 2016 at the Academy.
- Air Force led, 40-34, at the half. The Falcons improved to 5-1 this season when leading at the half. The halftime lead is the first for Air Force in conference play this season.

Individual Notes

- Senior CJ Siples started for the first time this season and 22nd time in his career.
- Senior Trevor Lyons scored nine points to move into 35th place on the Air Force career scoring list with 922. He moved past Tim Anderson (2004-08), who had 913 points, Tom Bellairs (1999-03), who had 914, and Chris Loll (1992-95), who had 919.
- Sophomore Lavelle Scottie scored 11 points and has scored in double figures three straight and five of the last six games.
- Sophomore Ryan Swan recorded career highs with 19 points and nine rebounds. His previous highs were 16 points and eight rebounds vs. UNLV in Air Force's last game. Swan has scored in double figures in all five games he's started this season, including four straight.
- Senior Jacob Van matched his season high with 14 points and tied a career high with three threes. Van also hit three 3-pointers vs. UC Davis Nov. 22, 2016. Van also grabbed a season-high four rebounds. His previous rebounding high was three vs. Army Dec. 17.
- Junior Pervis Louder scored 12 points to record his fifth double-figure scoring game this season and first in conference play.

• Air Force is 2-5 all-time in the Mountain West-Missouri Valley Challenge. The Falcons are 2-1 at home and 0-4 on the road. Air Force lost at Indiana State, 74-64, Nov. 29, in this year's action.

• The Falcons finished the Men Against Breast Cancer Showcase with a 3-1 overall record with all four games at the Academy. The Falcons finished second overall, tying with Pacific at 3-1. Pacific was named the champion as a result of its win over Air Force.

• Air Force improved to 30-32 all-time in season openers, including a 22-8 mark at home. The Falcons have won 11 straight season openers at home dating back to a 73-68 loss to Valparaiso Nov. 23, 1991.

• Air Force Head Coach Dave Pilipovich improved to 4-2 in season openers, including a 2-0 mark at home.

SHOOTING IMPROVED AT HOME

Despite a tough night from the field against UNLV, Air Force has had its best stretch of

shooting at home the last three games. The Falcons have hit 52.2 percent (97-186) from the field, 36.8 (25-68) from three and 76.8 (43-56) from the line.

The team hit a season-best 61.4 percent from the field and 40.7 percent from three vs. Johnson & Wales Dec. 22. The Falcons hit a conference season-best 52.7 percent from the field and 38.1 percent from three vs. Nevada Jan. 6. The team hit just 41.0 percent from the field and 30.0 from three vs. UNLV, but hit 83.3 percent from the line.

Air Force had hit just 37.9 percent from the field and 27.3 percent of its 3-pointers in the first two conference games sandwiched between JWU and Nevada.

AIR FORCE FREE THROWS

Air Force is third in the Mountain West in free throw percentage with a 74.0 mark which is sixth all-time in school history and best since hitting 75.5 percent in 2006-07. Air Force hit a season-high 92.7 percent vs.

Canisius, hitting 38-41. The percentage is the 11th best in school history and best since shooting 94.1 percent vs. Colorado College on Nov. 17, 2010. The 38 made free throws is just four off the school record of 42 set vs. Navy Dec. 6, 1993.

Jacob Van leads the team at 88.9 percent (24-27) while three other Falcons are at 80 percent or better than 80 percent. Frank Toohey is at 84.4, followed by Ryan Manning (80.6) and Lavelle Scottie (80.0).

Air Force has had all 20 players see action so far this season and 19 have scored. The team has nine players averaging double figures in minutes played, led by senior Trevor Lyons at 32.0 per game.

The Falcons have used seven different starting lineups with Lyons and Lavelle Scottie the only players starting each game.

AIR FORCE'S 3-POINT STREAK

Air Force has hit at least one 3-pointer in 264 straight games dating back to Nov. 21, 2009 vs. Northern Colorado.

HITTING THE BOARDS

Air Force is averaging 32.8 rebounds per game overall and 31.2 in conference play. Air Force only out-rebounded five opponents in non-conference play, but have out-rebounded three of five in MW action. The team has out-rebounded New Mexico (39-34), UNLV (33-29) and San Jose State (37-33).

LEADING TO TRAILING

Air Force trailed for just 2:43 combined in its first three games. The Falcons trailed for 1:14 vs. Texas State, :14 seconds vs. Canisius and 1:15 vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

Since that start, the tables have turned. Air Force trailed for 25 or more minutes in 10 of its next 13 games. Air Force trailed for 23:09 vs. Colorado in a loss, 3:06 vs. Johnson & Wales in a win and 20:11 in a loss vs. Nevada. The time trailed in the other games follows: Pacific (39:43), Indiana State (34:48), Denver (37:08 W), Western State (28:15 W), Abilene Christian (34:57), UC Riverside (37:27), Army (39:37), New Mexico (34:27), Fresno State (35:21) and UNLV (37:34). Air Force won two of the games, despite the deficits, with victories at Denver and vs. Western State.

The Falcons turned it back around in the win at San Jose State in the last game. Air Force led for 32:43 in the game.

WILD COMEBACKS

Air Force overcame 20-plus point deficits at Denver and vs. Western State earlier this season to win. The Falcons trailed by 22 points, 27-5, at Denver Dec. 2 before coming back to win, 61-59, and snap a 22-game road losing streak. The Falcons trailed by 23 points, 27-4, Dec. 4 vs. Western State before coming back to win, 79-67.

Denver hit 10 of its first 14 shots while Air Force hit just 2-11 during the opening stretch. Western State hit 9-13 while Air Force was 2-11 to open the game.

The Falcons hit 43.2 percent from that point at Denver while holding the Pioneers to just 30.0 percent (9-30). Air Force shot 65.1 percent after the poor start while holding Western State to just 44.4 percent. Air Force held both teams to just 21 points in the second half.

SCOTTIE LEADS FALCONS IN SCORING

Sophomore Lavelle Scottie leads the Falcons in scoring with an 11.6 average. Scottie has picked up his overall game in conference play. He is averaging 14.8 points per game in conference play which ranks 15th in the MW. He is fifth in the conference in field goal percentage (55.3) and tied for fifth in 3-point field goal percentage (50.0). He is averaging 2.4 offensive rebounds per game which is tied for eighth in the league.

Scottie scored 11 points and had six rebounds at San Jose State. He scored 26 points and grabbed six rebounds vs. UNLV which is the most he's scored in a Mountain West game and just one off his career high. Scottie hit 10-17 field goals and added a career-high four threes in a career-high 37 minutes.

Junior Pervis Louder scored 12 points and had two rebounds and two assists in Air Force's 78-71 win at San Jose State. Louder hit a pair of threes and 6-8 free throws to record his first double-figure scoring game in conference play this season.

Louder averaged 14.5 points in the comeback wins over Denver and Western State earlier this season. Louder shot 83.3 percent (10-12) from the field and 60 percent (3-5) from three. He recorded career highs of 15 points, seven rebounds and six assists against Western State, hitting 5-5 field goals. Louder scored a then-career-high 14 points to help lead the Falcons past Denver Dec. 2 in Denver. Louder broke a tie game with a three and won the game with a driving dunk with 3.7 seconds left.

He hit 10-12 field goals and 2-4 threes. His 22 points are the most by an Air Force reserve since Max Yon had 25 at Texas Tech Nov. 30, 2014.

CJ NEARING 100 GAMES

Senior guard CJ Siples is nearing 100 games played in his career. The Cibolo, Texas, native has played 96 games and needs just four more to become the 42nd player in school history to hit the century mark. He would join teammate Trevor Lyons with 100 or more games played.

FALCONS RANK IN THE MW

Air Force has several Falcons standing out in the statistics for conference games. Trevor Lyons is the lone Falcon that is in the rankings in any statistical category in all games, ranking 11th in minutes played with a 32.0 average. Lyons is in three categories in conference games, ranking eighth in assists (3.6), 15th in minutes (32.2) and sixth in assists-to-turnover ratio (2.0).

Sophomore Lavelle Scottie is 15th in scoring in conference games with a 14.8 mark. He is in the top 10 in three other categories. Scottie is fifth in field goal percentage (55.3), fifth in 3-point field goal percentage (50.0) and eighth in offensive rebounds (2.4). Fellow sophomore Ryan Swan appears in four categories. He is 18th in scoring (14.0), 16th in rebounding (5.8), seventh in blocked shots (1.0) and third in offensive rebounds (3.0).

SWAN MOVES INTO STARTING LINEUP

Sophomore Ryan Swan is second on the team in scoring (14.0) and leads in rebounding (5.8)

in conference games this season. He is fourth overall in scoring (7.9) and second in rebounding (4.1) in all games.

Swan has started five games this season, including four straight, and responded with double-figure scoring efforts in each one. He has led the team in scoring and rebounding in three each. His first start came at UC Riverside Dec. 8 and he responded with a team-high 16 points. He added a team-best 13 points at Fresno State Dec. 30 and had 15 points, six rebounds and a career-high two blocked shots vs. Nevada. Swan has played his best basketball the last two games, averaging 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in games vs. UNLV and at San Jose State. He recorded career highs of 16 points and eight rebounds vs. UNLV, then upped those career highs with 19 points and nine rebounds at San Jose State.

Swan is averaging 15.8 points and 5.6 rebounds per game as a starter while shooting 56.5 percent (26-46) from the field, 45.5 (5-11) from three and 78.6 (22-28) from the free throw line.

HEAD COACH DAVE PILIPOVICH/STAFF



Dave Pilipovich is in his sixth season as head coach at the Academy. He became the eighth head coach in the history of the program on February 8, 2012. He was in his fifth season as a member of the coaching staff and first as associate head coach when he was promoted

to head coach. Pilipovich completed the rest of the 2011-12 season. This season marks his 11th overall at the Academy. Pilipovich has led the Falcons to a 79-104 record.

After taking over the program, Pilipovich won two of his first three games as head coach, including a come-from-behind 58-53 win at Wyoming in his first road game. He then led his team to one of the biggest victories in program history with a 58-56 triumph over 13th-ranked San Diego State at Clune Arena, marking Air Force's first-ever win over a Top 20 team.

In 2012-13, his first full season as head coach, Pilipovich led the Falcons to an 18-14 overall record, tying the fourth-most wins in one season in program history. He also became the first Air Force head coach to beat two ranked teams in the same season and owns three of AFA's four wins against ranked opponents, including an 89-88 regular-season finale victory over No. 12 New Mexico, the highest ranked opponent ever defeated by Air Force. He also coached Air Force to its first-ever postseason road win with a 69-65 victory at Hawai'i in the first round of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

Pilipovich's tenure at the Academy is already one of the most successful. He is one of two coaches in school history to post multiple conference home winning records in a season, accomplishing it in 2013 and last season. He has led the program to more six-win conference seasons, three from 2013-15, than any other coach. Only two others have accomplished two seasons with six or more wins.

In his nearly five seasons as an assistant coach, Pilipovich helped the Falcons earn their first trip to the postseason since 2007 with an appearance in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament following the 2010 campaign and snap a 16-game losing streak in conference tournament play in 2009. In his first season at Air Force (2007-08), the Falcons finished fifth in the Mountain West Conference after being picked eighth in the preseason media and coaches poll, the greatest

margin between predicted and actual finish in the league that season. He also helped Tim Anderson earn the conference's Defensive Player of the Year award that campaign.

Prior to joining the Falcons, Pilipovich spent two years with the University of Michigan basketball program. In his first season with the Wolverines, he served as the administrative assistant to head coach Tommy Amaker and helped the Wolverines to the two NIT appearances, including an NIT final, then was an assistant coach during the 2006-07 campaign.

Pilipovich has 32 years of coaching experience. He served as an assistant coach at Eastern Michigan for five years (2000-05) prior to joining the Michigan staff. Before his stint at EMU, he served four years as an assistant coach at Robert Morris (1996-2000), two years an assistant coach at Georgia State (1994-96) and two years as the assistant head coach at Florida Atlantic (1989-91) before being named associate head coach the following four years (1991-94).

Pilipovich began his coaching career serving as a graduate assistant at California University (Pa.) for two years (1986-88), before being named as an assistant coach for one season.

A 1986 graduate of Thiel College in Greenville, Pa., with a degree in business administration, Pilipovich earned four varsity basketball letters and served as team captain during his senior season. He earned his master's degree from California (Pa.) in 1988 in geography and regional planning. He is an active member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and has served on the NABC Assistant Coaches Committee.

Pilipovich and his wife, Kelly, have a son, Kyle, and a daughter, Kelsey.
