### Air Force closes 2017-18 Season

Falcons 12-19 overall; 9th in MW with 6-12 mark

#### SEASON RECAP

Air Force ended the season with a 12-19 overall record and finished ninth in the Mountain West with a 6-12 mark. The Falcons were 4-5 in conference play over the second half of the season with victories over third-place New Mexico and tournament semifinalist Utah State. The New Mexico win was record-setting, as the Falcons out-lasting the Lobos, 100-90. Air Force set a record for most points in a conference game, breaking the record of 93 set vs. BYU (91) Jan. 30, 1987. Air Force and New Mexico's 192 points combined points is a new school record for most combined points in a conference game. The 192 points broke the record of 184 set vs. BYU Jan. 30, 1987 in a 93-91 Air Force win. Air Force's 36 made field goals vs. the Lobos tied the school record for most made in a conference game. The Falcons turned around several trends this season, including snapping several long streaks. Air Force defeated Denver, 61-59, Dec. 2 in Denver to snap a 22-game road losing streak dating back to a 67-60 win at UC Davis Dec. 19, 2015. The Falcons defeated San Jose State, 78-71, Jan. 10 to snap a 24-game Mountain West road losing streak. The Falcons won their first conference road game since beating San Jose State, 66-52, Jan. 28, 2015. Air Force defeated Colorado State, 76-71, Jan. 17 to snap a 12-game losing streak to the Rams, winning for the first time since Feb. 26, 2011 at the Academy, 75-47. The Falcons snapped a nine-game losing streak in Fort Collins, winning for the first time since a 61-59 victory, Feb. 23, 2008. Air Force had several notable accomplishments this season which are listed below.

#### Notable accomplishments in 2017-18

- Air Force swept the season series against Colorado State for the first time since 2008.
- Air Force won back-to-back games vs. Colorado State for the first time since the 2008 series sweep listed above.
- Air Force's season series sweep vs. Colorado State is its first of a Mountain West opponent since sweeping San Jose State in 2014-15.
- Air Force beat Colorado State and New Mexico in consecutive home games to register the program's first back-to-back conference home games since 2015-16 when the Falcons beat UNLV, 79-74, Feb. 15 and New Mexico, 76-72, Feb. 20.
- Air Force won at San Jose State (78-71) and Colorado State (76-71) to post back-to-back Mountain West road wins for the first time since 2011 when the team won at TCU, 66-65 in overtime, Jan. 29, and at Utah, 54-49, Feb. 5.
- The Falcons finished the Men Against Breast Cancer Showcase with a 3-1 overall record with all four games at the Academy. The Falcons finished second overall, tying with Pacific at 3-1.

## AIR FORCE'S LAST GAME

For the second time in as many Mountain West Tournament meetings, UNLV and Air Force went overtime to decide the victor. The Runnin' Rebels defeated Air Force, 97-90, in the opening round of the 2018 version, as it did in triple overtime in 2016, to advance to take on top-seeded Nevada.

Brandon McCoy scored 23 points, grabbed 12 rebounds and blocked three shots to lead the Rebels. Juiston Shakur added 21 points, Jovan Mooring 17 and Jordan Johnson 10 points and 12 assists to lead UNLV.

The Rebels shot 49.2 percent from the field, including 41.2 from three, and out-rebounded Air Force, 41-31, on their way to a 20th win this season. UNLV used an 11-2 run to open the second half to take a 48-35 lead with 14:57 to play. Air Force battled back and tied it four times, the last on a hoop and foul shot by Frank Toohey with 25 seconds left.

Air Force took its only lead of the game, 79-76, with a three-point play by Trevor Lyons to open the overtime period. UNLV took the look for good with a hoop and foul shot by Juiston with 3:19 to play and extended the lead to as many as 10 points in the extra session.

Lavelle Scottie scored 23 points and grabbed a career-best nine rebounds to lead the Falcons. Jacob Van added 20 points, Caleb Morris a career-high 17 and Frank Toohey 11. Trevor Lyons scored five points and had a team-best seven assists.

The Falcons shot 46.4 percent from the field, including a 48.1 clip from three on 13-of-27 shooting. Air Force had 22 assists on 32 made field goals and recorded nine steals.

## Team Notes

- Air Force starters for the UNLV game: Trevor Lyons (G), CJ Siples (G), Sid Tomes (G), Lavelle Scottie (F) and Ryan Swan (C). The lineup started for the sixth time this season and is the 11th different lineup in 31 games this season.
- Air Force improved its school record streak of consecutive games with a 3-pointer to 277 games dating back to Nov. 21, 2009 vs. Northern Colorado.
- Air Force and UNLV played overtime for the second straight game they have faced each other in the Mountain West Championships. The teams played a triple overtime game in the opening round in 2016.
- Air Force played its first overtime game this season and first since Feb. 18, 2017 vs. San Jose State.

## Individual Notes

- Senior Trevor Lyons played in his 117th career game which ranks ninth in Air Force history. Lyons handed out seven assists and has 102 this season which is the most by a Falcon since Evan Washington had 127 in 2010-11.
- Sophomore Lavelle Scottie scored 23 points to record his team-leading 20th double-figure scoring game of the season. Scottie has scored in double figures in 13 of the last 17 games. Scottie also grabbed a career-best nine rebounds.
- Sophomore Caleb Morris scored a career-best 17 points and had career highs with six field

goals and four 3-pointers.

- Senior Jacob Van scored 20 points and has scored 43 points in his last two games, topping the 20-point mark in both games.
- Senior Frank Toohey scored 11 points to record his first double-figure scoring game since scoring 11 vs. UNLV Jan. 10 in Clune Arena.

Air Force hit a season-high 92.7 percent vs. Canisius, hitting 38-41. The percentage is the 11th best in school history and best since shooting 94.1 percent vs. Colorado College on Nov. 17, 2010. The 38 made free throws is just four off the school record of 42 set vs. Navy Dec. 6, 1993.

- Air Force's 43-point victory margin is the 13th largest in school history and is the most since beating Colorado College, 82-31 (51 points) Dec. 9, 2006.

#### SEASON NOTES

- Air Force overcame a 15-point (45-30) first half deficit vs. Utah State to win, 75-65. The comeback is the team's biggest in conference play this season. The previous was an 11-point comeback vs. New Mexico.

- Air Force improved to 30-32 all-time in season openers, including a 22-8 mark at home. The Falcons have won 11 straight season openers at home dating back to a 73-68 loss to Valparaiso Nov. 23, 1991.
- Air Force Head Coach Dave Pilipovich improved to 4-2 in season openers, including a 2-0 mark at home.

#### AIR FORCE NUMBERS GAME

- Air Force played its 62nd varsity season in 2017-18. The Falcons have a 741-942 all-time record. The Falcons picked up their 700th win with a 76-75 victory over UNLV Feb. 14, 2015.
- Air Force is 112-29 in non-conference home games as a member of the Mountain West.
- The Falcons are 110-192 in Mountain West play since joining the league as an inaugural member in 1999-2000. Air Force is 274-307 overall since joining the conference.

#### WILD COMEBACKS

The Falcons trailed by 23 points, 27-4, Dec. 4 vs. Western State before coming back to win, 79-67.

Denver hit 10 of its first 14 shots while Air Force hit just 2-11 during the opening stretch. Western State hit 9-13 while Air Force was 2-11 to open the game.

The Falcons hit 43.2 percent from that point at Denver while holding the Pioneers to just 30.0 percent (9-30). Air Force shot 65.1 percent after the poor start while holding Western State to just 44.4 percent. Air Force held both teams to just 21 points in the second half.

#### SCOTTIE LEADS FALCONS IN SCORING

Sophomore Lavelle Scottie led the Falcons in scoring with a 12.2 average. Scottie averaged 12.8 points per game in conference play which ranked 19th in the MW. Scottie closed the season with 23 points and a career-best nine rebounds in a career-high 42 minutes vs. UNLV in the Mountain West tournament. He hit double figures in and 12 of the last 16 games and led the team in scoring a team-best 11 times this season.

Scottie scored 26 points and grabbed six rebounds vs. UNLV which is the most he's scored in a Mountain West game and just one off his career high. Scottie hit 10-17 field goals and added a career-high four threes. He scored a career-high 27 points to lead Air

Force past Western State Dec. 4. He scored 19 of his points in the second half to help the Falcons rally from a 23-point deficit to win. His 27 points are the most by a Falcon since Jacob Van had 37 vs. UNLV March 9, 2016.

### VAN SOELEN LEADS THE ROOKIES

Freshman Keaton Van Soelen led all freshmen with 28 games played and 11 starts this season. He scored four points, grabbed four rebounds, had a career-best four assists and a block vs. San Diego State. He scored 10 points, grabbed three rebounds and had three assists at Boise State. He had four points, four rebounds, three assists and two blocks at UNLV and six points and a career-best two blocks in Air Force win over New Mexico.

Van Soelen started the first game of his career at Fresno State and scored eight points and grabbed four rebounds in 30 minutes. Van Soelen scored six points, had three rebounds, two assists, a block and a steal in a career-best 34 minutes vs. Nevada.

Van Soelen scored three points and had a career-best nine rebounds at Colorado State. He also had two assists and a blocked shot.

### LYONS LED THE WAY

Senior Trevor Lyons led the team in rebounding (4.7), assists (10.2), steals (4.3) and minutes played (32.6). He was second on the team in scoring (9.4). His 102 assists are the most by a Falcon since Evan Washington had 127 during the 2010-11 season.

Lyons led the team in scoring five times, rebounds nine times and assists a team-best 16 times.

Lyons scored nine points and grabbed a career-best 13 rebounds in Air Force's win over San Jose State. His 13 boards were the most by a Falcon this season.

Lyons recorded his second-career double-double against Fresno State with 11 points and 10 rebounds.

He led the Falcons with 19 points and a career-best eight rebounds at UNLV. He became the 25th player in school history to reach the 1,000-point mark in his career during the game. He had 16 points, five rebounds and three assists vs. New Mexico. Lyons nearly had a triple-double in Air Force win over the Rams with 10 points, seven rebounds and a career-best 10 assists.

### LYONS BROTHERS THE FIRST

Senior Trevor Lyons scored 1,060 career points and ranks 21st in Air Force history in career scoring. He became the 25th player in school history to score 1,000 or more points with a 19-point effort at UNLV Feb. 14. He joins his older brother, Michael, in the 1,000-point club. Michael ranks fourth in Air Force history with 1,527 points from 2009-13.

The Lyons' are the first set of brothers to score 1,000 or more points at Air Force and first in Mountain West history at the same school. They are the first set of brothers to accomplish it nationally since Adam and Jake Koch at Northern Iowa. Adam had 1,186 points from 2006-10 while Jake had 1,113 from 2009-13.

### LYONS AMONG ALL-TIME BESTS

Senior Trevor Lyons closed his career among the program's all-time best in several areas.

Lyons ranks 21st in school history with 1,060 career points. He is tied for 10 all-time in games played in Air Force with 117. He became the 41st player in school history to hit the 100-game mark earlier this season. Lyons is third all-time in steals with 162 and seventh in career assists with 309.

Air Force had several Falcons stand out in the conference statistics. Trevor Lyons appeared in eight categories, ranking ninth in assists (3.3), eighth in steals (1.4), ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7) and ninth in minutes (33.0). Lyons ranked sixth in assists (3.6), sixth in steals (1.4), sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.9) and 11th in minutes (33.6) in conference games.

Sophomore Lavelle Scottie was 19th in scoring in conference games (12.8). Fellow sophomore Ryan Swan was 16th in rebounding (5.9) and tied for ninth in blocks (0.7) in Mountain West games.

### SWAN STEPPED UP

Sophomore Ryan Swan led the team in rebounding (5.4) and was second in scoring (11.9) in conference games this season. He was third overall in scoring (9.2) and second in rebounding (4.5) in all games.

Swan started 18 games this season and scored in double figures in 13 of the 18. He has led the team in scoring and rebounding eight times each in the games he started.

His first start came at UC Riverside Dec. 8 and he responded with a team-high 16 points.

Swan averaged 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in games vs. UNLV and at San Jose State.

He recorded career highs of 16 points and eight rebounds vs. UNLV, then upped those career highs with 19 points and a then-career-best nine rebounds at San Jose State. Swan averaged 17.5 points and 9.0 rebounds in Air Force's wins over Colorado State and New Mexico. He led the team with 18 points and eight rebounds vs. Colorado State and with his first-career double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds vs. New Mexico. He also matched his career high with two blocks.

# HEAD COACH DAVE PILIPOVICH/STAFF



Dave Pilipovich completed his sixth season as head coach at the Academy. He became the eighth head coach in the history of the program on February 8, 2012. He was in his fifth season as a member of the coaching staff and first as associate head coach when he was promoted to head coach. Pilipovich completed the rest of the 2011-12 season. This season marked his 11th overall at the Academy. Pilipovich has led the Falcons to a 84-113 record.

After taking over the program, Pilipovich won two of his first three games as head coach, including a come-from-behind 58-53 win at Wyoming in his first road game. He then led his team to one of the biggest victories in program history with a 58-56 triumph over 13th-ranked San Diego State at Clune Arena, marking Air Force's first-ever win over a Top 20 team.

In 2012-13, his first full season as head coach, Pilipovich led the Falcons to an 18-14 overall record, tying the fourth-most wins in one season in program history. He also became the first Air Force head coach to beat two ranked teams in the same season and owns three of AFA's four wins against ranked opponents, including an 89-88 regular-season finale victory over No. 12 New Mexico, the highest ranked opponent ever defeated by Air Force. He also coached Air Force to its first-ever postseason road win with a 69-65 victory at Hawai'i in the first round of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

Pilipovich's tenure at the Academy is already one of the most successful. He is one of two coaches in school history to post multiple conference home winning records in a season, accomplishing it in 2013 and last season. He has led the program to more six-win conference seasons, four from 2013-15, 2018, than any other coach. Only two others have accomplished two seasons with six or more wins.

In his nearly five seasons as an assistant coach, Pilipovich helped the Falcons earn their first trip to the postseason since 2007 with an appearance in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament following the 2010 campaign and snap a 16-game losing streak in conference tournament play in 2009. In his first season at Air Force (2007-08), the Falcons finished fifth in the Mountain West Conference after being picked eighth in the preseason media and coaches poll, the greatest

margin between predicted and actual finish in the league that season. He also helped Tim Anderson earn the conference's Defensive Player of the Year award that campaign.

Prior to joining the Falcons, Pilipovich spent two years with the University of Michigan basketball program. In his first season with the Wolverines, he served as the administrative assistant to head coach Tommy Amaker and helped the Wolverines to the two NIT appearances, including an NIT final, then was an assistant coach during the 2006-07 campaign.

Pilipovich has 32 years of coaching experience. He served as an assistant coach at Eastern Michigan for five years (2000-05) prior to joining the Michigan staff. Before his stint at EMU, he served four years as an assistant coach at Robert Morris (1996-2000), two years an assistant coach at Georgia State (1994-96) and two years as the assistant head coach at Florida Atlantic (1989-91) before being named associate head coach the following four years (1991-94).

Pilipovich began his coaching career serving as a graduate assistant at California University (Pa.) for two years (1986-88), before being named as an assistant coach for one season.

A 1986 graduate of Thiel College in Greenville, Pa., with a degree in business administration, Pilipovich earned four varsity basketball letters and served as team captain during his senior season. He earned his master's degree from California (Pa.) in 1988 in geography and regional planning. He is an active member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and has served on the NABC Assistant Coaches Committee.

Pilipovich and his wife, Kelly, have a son, Kyle, and a daughter, Kelsey.
