

# Air Force Post-Game Notes

at UNLV, Nov. 18, 2010

## Team Notes

- Air Force uses game captains. The captains for the UNLV game were **Andre Morris, Jr.**, **Reggie Rembert, Jr.**, **Ben Cochran** and **Asher Clark**.
- Air Force extended its school-record consecutive games scoring streak to 219 games dating back to the 1992 Liberty Bowl vs. Mississippi. The streak is the fourth longest active streak in the nation and ties as the 13<sup>th</sup> longest in NCAA history.
- Air Force's first quarter interception marks the 10<sup>th</sup> time in 12 games the team has recorded an interception.
- Air Force closes the regular season 8-4 overall and 5-3 in the MWC. This season marks only the second time in school history and first time since 1982-85 that Air Force has had four straight eight-win seasons. Air Force head coach Troy Calhoun is the first head coach at Air Force to accomplish the feat.
- Air Force improves to 12-4 overall against UNLV, including a 12-3 mark in conference games. Air Force is now 6-3 on the road in the series. The Falcons have won four straight and eight of the last nine in the series vs. UNLV.
- Air Force improves to 16-8 under head coach Troy Calhoun in games during the second half of the season (last six games), including a 3-3 mark this season. Prior to Calhoun's arrival in 2007, Air Force was 12-24 over the second half of seasons since 2001.
- Air Force finishes November with a 3-0 mark this season and is now 10-3 under head coach Troy Calhoun in the month of November. All three losses have come at the hands of nationally-ranked teams.
- Air Force improves to 336-278-13 all-time in its 55<sup>th</sup> season of varsity football. The Falcons are 182-114-3 at home and 153-165-10 on the road and in neutral site games. Air Force improved to 47-43 as a member of the MWC, including a 19-26 mark on the road.
- Air Force head coach Troy Calhoun improved to 33-18 overall in his fourth season. Calhoun is now 21-11 in MWC games, 11-10 in road games (9-6 in MWC road games) and 4-0 vs. UNLV.

## Individual Notes

- Junior RB **Asher Clark** rushed for 82 yards to become the 15<sup>th</sup> player in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. Clark is the first player since Chad Hall in 2007 to reach the 1,000-yard mark and just the third tailback in school history to do it (Hall, 2007; Brian Bream, 1970). Clark has 1001 rushing yards on the season.
- Senior LB **Andre Morris, Jr.** recorded his first interception of the season and third of his career. The interception is the ninth turnover of his career (3 INT, 3 FR, 3 FF) and led to a touchdown. Morris finished the game with a career-high 10 tackles.
- Sophomores **Brandon Hirneise** (WR) and **Austin Niklas** (LB), along with junior **Zach Bell** (PK) each made the first start of their careers.
- Sophomore LB **Austin Niklas** record a career-high 14 tackles in his first-career start. He accomplished the career high with 10 in the first half. His previous high was six tackles at TCU earlier this season.
- Junior QB **Tim Jefferson** threw his career-best 10<sup>th</sup> touchdown pass of the season which is the most by a Falcon quarterback since Shaun Carney had 12 in 2006. Jefferson's 10 TD passes tie as the ninth most in school history for a single season. The touchdown pass is the 20<sup>th</sup> of his career which ranks eighth in Air Force history. Jefferson also rushed for 64 yards and ran for a career-high three touchdowns, giving him 14<sup>th</sup> rushing touchdowns on the season to lead the team. Jefferson has had a rushing and passing touchdown in the same game six times this season and seven in his career. His three rushing touchdown's are a career-high.
- Junior WR **Zack Kauth** finished the game with three catches for 53 yards and scored his team-leading fourth touchdown receiving of the season. Kauth has two straight multiple-catch games and five this season.
- Junior WR **Jonathan Warzeka** recorded a career-long 54-yard touchdown run. The touchdown run is his fourth this season.
