Frank is in his 12<sup>th</sup> season as the Head Coach at the Air Force Academy. He brings over 25 years of high level coaching experience to his Hockey

Camps. In twelve seasons at Air Force, Frank's Falcon teams have claimed virtually every school record at the DI level, culminating in back to back AHA titles and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2007 and 2008. Prior to arriving at Air Force, Frank was the Director of Hockey Operations and Head Coach of the Minnesota Moose of the IHL. Frank was also the Head Coach at Denver University from 1990-94, and served as an Assistant at North Dakota from 1987-89. In addition to his College and Professional experience, Frank coached six years in the United States Hockey League, winning Junior "A" Championships with the Austin Mavericks, Rochester Mustangs, and Omaha Lancers. His 1987 Rochester Mustangs won Junior "A" Hockey's "Triple Crown" winning the USHL League and Playoff titles, as well as the National Championship. Frank has also been involved at the National level of USA Hockey for over 20 years. He has coached and lectured at numerous Camps, Symposiums, and Olympic Sports Festivals. Frank was named Head Coach of the 2003 USA U-17 Team and captured a Gold Medal at the Five Nations World Cup Tournament in Prievidza, Slovakia.

## GENERAL INFO

**DIVISIONS:** The CSF features three Divisions; Pee Wee (97-98), Bantam (95-96), and U16 Midget (93-94). The CSF Staff will attempt to balance the teams as closely as possible. Team placement consideration given to car poolers; make sure to note travel partners on registration. All competitive Travel/High School players encouraged to attend, strong experienced goalies only, no Rec players please. Positions filled on first come basis, however, Director reserves right to refuse any applicant.

**GAMES/ICE TIME/ROSTER NUMBERS:** Games consist of two 25 minute stop time periods. If tied, a shootout will decide winner. All players receive equal time. Teams consist of 16 Skaters and 2 Goalies. Each Goalie plays half the game.

**AWARDS/STATISTICS:** Standings and Scoring Stats kept. Each game features a Player of the Game, All Festival Teams and Festival MVP's selected in each birth year.

**OFFICIALS/RULES/CONDUCT:** USA Hockey rules utilized, only exception is "tag up" offside. Certified USA Hockey officials utilized. Checking permitted but excessive/cheap physical play and/or unsportsmanlike conduct is not tolerated. The Director reserves right to remove any player from the CSF whose conduct (on or off ice) is deemed inappropriate.

### EQUIPMENT NEEDS

Players provide their own equipment and sticks. Players are required to supply all protective equipment recommended by USA Hockey. This includes a certified helmet, facemask, mouth guard, hockey pants, gloves, shoulder pads, elbow pads, shin pads, and hockey skates. Each player will be given a CSF jersey that he/she will be able to keep.
