## Air Force closes out season 23-15-5

*Falcons reached NCAA Elite Eight for second straight season*

### In Closing

Air Force closed out the 2017-18 season with a 23-15-5 overall record and a 13-11-4 record in Atlantic Hockey. The Falcons tied for third in the league and were the fifth seed in the AHC playoffs. After a bye week, the Falcons traveled to West Point for a quarterfinal series with fourth-seeded Army. It took three games, but Tyler Ledford's goal in overtime lifted the Falcons to a 1-0 win and a berth in the AHC Final Four. Wins over Canisius and Robert Morris gave the Falcons their seventh AHC tournament title in the last 12 years.

At the NCAA West Regional, Air Force defeated No. 1 St. Cloud State (4-1) before falling to No. 11 Minnesota Duluth (2-1) in the Elite Eight.

### The Coach

Head coach Frank Serratore is in his 21st season at Air Force with a record of 379-335-81 (795 games). The 2016 AHC Coach of the Year, he is the winningest coach in the history of Air Force hockey, having led Air Force to two regular-season titles, six AHC tournament championships and six NCAA Tournaments in the last 11 years. In his 25th season as a collegiate head coach, he has an overall record of 428-427-90 (945 games).

### Atlantic Hockey Champions

Air Force won the Atlantic Hockey championship for the seventh time in the last 12 years. The Falcons joined the AHC for the 2006-07 season. Air Force won the AHC Tournament title in 2007, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2012, 2017 and 2018. The Falcons were the No. 5 seed in the tournament, defeated No. 4 Army (at West Point) in three games in the quarterfinals and then beat No. 2 Canisius (3-0) and No. 7 Robert Morris (5-1) in the Final Four. Air Force is 14-2 all-time at the Blue Cross Arena, 34-11 all-time in the AHC playoffs and 17-5 in AHC elimination games.

### Trending

Air Force made its seventh trip to the NCAA Tournament and its second straight berth in the Elite Eight ... The Elite Eight trip was the third in school history (2009, 2017 and 2018) ... The win over No. 1 St. Cloud State is the highest ranked team Air Force has ever defeated ... On Feb. 1, Air Force was in ninth place with 18 points... The Falcons collected 12 points in February to jump into a tie for third ... Erik

Baskin led the team in goals and points (16-12-28) ... 18 Falcons combined to miss 212 games due to injury this season ... Air Force's 15 road/neutral wins are the most in the nation ... Over the last two years, Air Force's 31 road wins are the most in the nation (Minnesota Duluth has 29) ... Air Force posted back-to-back shutouts (Army and Canisius) for the first time since the 2009-10 season ... Erik Baskin and Billy Christopoulos were the only Falcons to play in every game this season.

### 20-20-20

For the first time in school history, Air Force won 20 games three straight years, winning 20 in 2015-16, 27 in 2016-17 and 23 this season.

### It has been awhile

Billy Christopoulos' 1,026 saves this season are the most by a Falcon since 1972-73 (Al Morrison, 1132). He is just the third goalie in school history to record 1,000 or more saves in a season, Kim Newman did it twice in 1969-70 and 1970-71. Of the most recent Falcon goalies, Shane Starrett's high was 871 in 2016-17, Jason Torf had 969 in 2012-13 and Andrew Volkening had 989 in 2009-10.

### Elite Company

Air Force is one of just four teams over the last two seasons to compete in the NCAA Elite Eight back-to-back years, joining Denver, Minnesota Duluth and Notre Dame.

### The Senior Class

The Class of 2018 matched the largest senior class under (2007) head coach Frank Serratore. Dylan Abood, Erik Baskin, Phil Boje, Jordan Himley, Jonathan Kopacka, Ben Kucera, Tyler Ledford and Kyle Mackey won more games (86) than any class in school history, passing the classes of 2011 and 2012 with who each had 85.

The class has helped lead the Falcons to the 2017 and 2018 Atlantic Hockey Championships and two berths in the NCAA Elite Eight. The class has beaten Colorado College all four years, winning the Pikes Peak Trophy every year. They also posted a 9-4-1 record vs. Army and helped earn the Academy's first ever Ice Breaker Tournament last season. The class combined to play in 1,065 games and has scored 495 combined career points.

Frank Serratore (Bemidji State, 1982) is in his 21st season as the Falcons' hockey coach. He has led Air Force to two regular-season league titles, six AHC Tournament Championships and six NCAA appearances (2007, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2012 and 2017). The 2016 Atlantic

Hockey Coach of the Year, Serratore owns more wins than any other coach in Air Force hockey history. In service academy competition, Serratore is 30-14-5 (66.3 percent) vs. the Black Knights while at Air Force.

**The Falcons in the Big Dance**

Air Force made its seventh appearance in the NCAA Tournament and its second straight. The Falcons are 3-7 all-time in the Big Dance. Of Air Force's seven losses, six have come by one goal including one in double overtime and two in the first overtime. The other was a 2-0 loss to eventual national champion Boston College in 2012, with the Eagles scoring a power-play goal in the final minute. Air Force has had the lead at one point in six of the 10 games (Minnesota, Miami, Michigan, Vermont, Western Michigan, St. Cloud State).

**Inside the Numbers**

Air Force was 18-2-2 when it scores first and 5-13-3 when the opponent scores first.

With Air Force this season, the game is pretty much decided after two periods. When the Falcons lead after two, they were 21-0-2. When the opponent leads after two, the Falcons were 1-14-2. The only win came when the Falcons trailed Bentley, 2-1, Feb. 10, and came back to win 4-2. The game was tied after two periods three times and the Falcons are 1-1-1.

When the Falcons win the special teams battle, they are 12-1. The only loss was to Minnesota Duluth in the NCAA West Regional final. When the Falcons lose the special teams battle, AF is 2-11-3. Air Force was 15-2 when scoring a power-play goal. The only losses came at RIT, Nov. 18 and to Minnesota Duluth in the NCAA West Regional final

**The Falcons in the New Year**

Since joining Atlantic Hockey for the 2006-07 season, the Falcons have had a winning record after January 1, in 11 of the 12 seasons. Air Force was 15-6-2 this season since Jan. 1. Last season, the Falcons posted a 15-4-2 record from Jan. 1 until the end of the season. Over the last three seasons, Air Force is 44-14-7 between Jan. 1 and the end of the regular season (72 percent). Over the last four years (since 2014-15), Air Force's 23 wins in the month of January are the most of any team in the nation.

**Killin' It**

Air Force closed out the season ranked 10th in the nation in penalty kill at 84.1 percent (143-170). Air Force killed all six in the NCAA Tournament, three each against St. Cloud State and Minnesota Duluth. The Falcons killed 17 of the last 18 to end the season.

**Balanced Scoring**

Air Force's leading scorer, Erik Baskin, had 28 (16-12-28) points, but the Falcons had five players who with 20 or more points. Twenty-four different Falcons have scored a goal this season and 26 different players have at least one point. Twelve different players have scored Air Force's 24 power-play goals.

**Three is the magic number ...**

The Falcons were 20-1-2 when scoring three or more goals this season. Air Force was 3-14-3 when scoring two or less. This season's only loss came in a 6-3 defeat to Niagara, Dec. 1. Last season, Air Force was 23-1-3 when scoring three or more. The only loss was a 4-3 overtime loss to eventual national champion Denver. Over the last two years, Air Force is 43-2-5 when scoring three or more.

**The Century Mark**

Air Force has 11 players who have played in 100 or more career games: Jordan Himley (152), Tyler Ledford (148), Erik Baskin (148), Phil Boje (144), Ben Kucera (132), Kyle Mackey (119), Dylan Abood (121), Evan Giesler (118), Jonathan Kopacka (111), Matt Serratore (108) and Kyle Haak (106).

**Get That Man an Ice Bag**

Senior Phil Boje ranked second in the nation with 102 blocked shots this season. He blocked a career high nine twice, against St. Cloud State and in the second game at Robert Morris. In the CC/DU series, Dec. 29-30, he blocked 10 in the two games. He blocked a seven shots against Niagara, Jan. 27. He has blocked six or more in a game five times this season (UMD, RMU, Niagara, Denver, Arizona State).

### **Abood a Finalist for Senior Class Award**

Dylan Abood is a finalist for the 2017-18 Senior CLASS Award for hockey. Abood is one of 10 men's hockey student-athletes who excel both on and off the ice. Abood carries a 3.85 overall grade point average while majoring in electrical engineering. The Centennial, Colo., native has been on the Dean's List every semester. He is a two-time, first-team CoSIDA Academic All-District selection and has been named academic all-conference three times. This past summer, he was selected for the Cadet Summer Research Program with MIT Lincoln Laboratory under Group 73 (Energy Systems), building, developing and testing a portable solar power system to assist with disaster relief operations.

A flight commander in his squadron, he has volunteered numerous hours in the community. The finalists were chosen by national media from the list of candidates announced in the fall. Nationwide fan voting begins immediately to help select the winner, and fans are encouraged to submit votes online at the Senior CLASS Award website through March 26. Fan votes will be combined with those of the media and Division I head coaches to determine the winners. The Senior CLASS Award recipients will be announced during the 2018 NCAA Men's Frozen Four®.

### **Abood wins Derek Hines Award**

Senior defenseman Dylan Abood was named the recipient of the 2018 Derek Hines Unsung Hero Award. He is the second Falcon to win the award, joining Mike Phillipich in 2009. The award was established by the HCA in honor of former Army player Derek Hines, who was a "consum-mate team player and team builder." Hines played at Army from 1999-2003 and was a four-year letter-winner as well as a co-captain his senior season. He was killed in the line of duty on Sept. 1, 2005 in Afghanistan.

### **50th Season of Falcon Hockey**

The 2017-18 season marks the 50th season of Air Force hockey. Prior to the Air Force hockey program going Division I in 1968-69, cadets had been playing hockey, both indoors and outdoors, since 1958. In 1966, Vic Heyliger was hired to coach the Air Force hockey club team and then make the transition to Division I in 1968. Heyliger, a member of the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame, started the Academy program after leading the University of Michigan to six national championships in 13 years. In the first season, 1968-69, under Heyliger, the Falcons posted a 6-12 record. It didn't take long for the Falcons to get on the college hockey map, posting a 25-6 record in 1971-72. Heyliger coached the team from 1969-74, John Matchefts (also a member of the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame) was the coach from 1975-85, Chuck Delich (USAFA grad and the all-time leading goal scorer in NCAA history) was behind the bench from 1986-97 and Frank Serratore from 1998-Present.

### **Beating the Nation's Best**

Over the past 11 years (2007-08 to present). Air Force has beaten nine teams ranked in the top five in the nation at the time of the game. During that span, Air Force is 9-13 in games played against teams ranked in the top five in the country. Most recently, the Falcons defeated No. 1 ranked St. Cloud State in the NCAA West Regional, March 23, 2018. The win marked the highest ranked team Air Force has ever beaten. The highest ranked team the Falcons have ever swept came against 13th-ranked Niagara at the Cadet Ice Arena, March 1-2, 2013, by scores of 5-2 and 6-1.

## New Faces

Six freshmen cracked the lineup this season and all six have at least one point. Three of them, Zack Mirageas, Jake Levin and Alex Mehnert, have earned conference rookie of the week honors. Mirageas has played in 41 of the 43 games and was the top freshman scorer with 17 points (2-15-17). He ranked seventh in the league in points by a freshman in all games and was named to the AHC all-tournament team. Marshall Bowery ranked third in the league in goals by a freshman with eight (8-1-9) in 30 games. Levin had six points (2-4-6) in 21 games, Mehnert had six points (2-4-6) in 15 games, Walker Sommer had five points (1-4-5), including the game-winner at Niagara, in 18 games. Max Harper had an assist (5 games) before suffering a season-ending injury.

## Regional Recaps

After defeating No. 1 St. Cloud State in the NCAA West Regional to advance to the team's second straight Elite Eight, the Falcons fell to No. 11 Minnesota Duluth (2-1) in the regional final, March 24, in Sioux Falls, S.D.

***Vs. St. Cloud State:*** Air Force goalie Billy Christopoulos made 39 saves as Air Force defeated No. 1 St. Cloud State, 4-1, at the NCAA West Regional at the Denny Sanford Premier Center in Sioux Falls, S.D. With the win, Air Force advances to the NCAA Elite Eight for the second straight season and the third time in school history. The Falcons' defeated the nation's No. 1 team for the first time in school history. It is the ninth time in the last 11 years the Falcons have beaten a team ranked in the top five in the nation.

The first period was scoreless, but each team had a couple chances. Falcon winger Evan Giesler had a breakaway that was saved by David Hrenak with just over 14 minutes left. About two minutes later, Blake Lizotte had a breakaway that was saved by Billy Christopoulos. Late in the period, Christopoulos made two big saves on a 2-on-1 rush, stopping Jack Poehling and Easton Brodzinski on the rush.

The Falcons scored two goals in a span of 3:30 early in the second period. Senior Tyler Ledford put the Falcons on the board at 2:57 as he forced a turnover in the Husky end and then batted the puck out of the air, and off of Hrenak, for a 1-0 lead. Ledford's second of the game, sixth of the season, put the Falcons up 2-0 at 6:29. Erik Baskin forced a turnover and Matt Koch collected the puck in the slot. Koch saw Ledford slashing to the net from the right side. Ledford redirected Koch's pass for a 2-0 lead. SCSU outshot AF, 18-11, in the second period.

Early in the third period, Christopoulos again came up big for the Falcons. With the Huskies on the power play, Ryan Poehling, a first-round pick of Montreal, found some space at the bottom of the right circle, but Christopoulos slid to his left and made a glove save that kept the game scoreless. With under three minutes left, the Huskies got on the board. Patrick Newell's pass was redirected by Blake Lizotte with 2:51 left to cut the Falcon lead to 2-1. With under two minutes left, Hrenak started to leave the ice. Just before he was off, the Falcons gained control of the puck in the neutral zone. Matt Serratore flipped the puck to a wide open Jordan Himley at center ice. Himley's empty-netter gave the Falcons a 3-1 lead with 1:34 left. After the ensuing faceoff, Hrenak came off the ice and the Falcons capitalized again. Serratore gave the puck to Kyle Haak who sealed the 4-1 win with 47 seconds left. St. Cloud State outshot Air Force, 40-26. The Falcons were 0-for-1 on the power play while SCSU was 0-for-3. Hrenak made 22 saves for the Huskies. Christopoulos' 39 saves are third most of his career. The Falcons blocked a season high 29 shots, led by senior Phil Boje who tied his career high with nine.

***Vs. Minnesota Duluth:*** Minnesota Duluth scored two goals in the first period and then held off Air Force for a 2-1 win in the championship game of the NCAA West Regional, Saturday, March 24, at the Denny Sanford Premier Center in Sioux Falls, S.D. UMD advances to the NCAA Frozen Four in St. Paul, Minn., April 5-7. The Falcons' season comes to an end with a 23-15-5 overall record.

Minnesota Duluth came at Air Force early and often in the first period, out-shooting the Falcons, 14-0. Two minutes into the game, UMD winger Kobe Roth hit the post and midway through the period, Jade Miller had a breakaway that was saved by Billy Christopoulos. The Bulldogs got on the board at 9:03 on the rush. Riley Tufte's shot was saved but Joey Anderson put back the rebound for a 1-0 UMD lead. After a video review to check for goalie interference, the goal was allowed. Three minutes later, UMD struck again. Scott Perunovich set up his defensive partner on the left side. Nick Wolff's wrist from the top of the left circle gave UMD a 2-0 lead at 12:12.

Air Force played a much better second period with each team having six shots, as UMD held on to the 2-0 lead after two periods.

Midway through the period, Matt Koch drew a penalty on UMD forward Blake Young and the Falcons went on the power play. Evan Giesler won a faceoff in the offensive zone and Zack Mirageas slid the puck across to Matt Koch. Koch's shot was wide, but Giesler collected the loose puck and, from behind the goal line, shot it off the goalie. The power-play goal cut the Bulldog lead to 2-1 at 13:44.

With 1:42 left in the game, the Falcons pulled the goalie for the extra attacker. Air Force had four shots that were blocked by UMD defensemen, but could not find the equalizer.

UMD outshot Air Force, 26-12, in the game. In the final 40 minutes, the shots were even at 12 apiece. Air Force was 1-for-2 on the power play while UMD was 0-for-3. Christopoulos made 24 saves for the Falcons and stopped 63 of 66 in the tournament. Hunter Shepard made 11 saves for the Bulldogs.

**Solid Between the Pipes**

Junior Billy Christopoulos started every game this season and ranks among the league’s best in every goaltending category. He played more minutes than any goalie in the nation (2,534).His 23 wins are the most in the league and the third most in the nation.

A third-team all-Atlantic Hockey selection, he was the MVP of the AHC Final Four and a member of the NCAA West Regional all-tournament team. In all games this season, he led the league in GAA (2.06), the 11th best in the nation. He was second in the league and 12th in the nation in saves percentage (.922).

He was named the Atlantic Hockey Goalie of the Month three times (October, January and February) and the Goalie of the Week twice (Jan. 16 and Feb. 5).

In the month of January, he had a 1.44 GAA and .942 saves percentage. He posted a 5-2 record with the only losses coming by one goal. In seven games, he allowed just 10 goals and posted his first career shutout, a 4-0 win at RIT. Christopoulos was named AHC Goalie of the Week (Jan. 16) as he tallied a .982 saves percentage and 0.50 GAA in a road sweep at RIT. When the Falcons got three points against AIC (Feb. 2-3), he posted a .965 saves percentage and a 0.96 GAA.

In the month of February, he led Air Force to a 5-2-2 record. Air Force was in ninth place on Feb. 1, but Christopoulos’ play led the Falcons to 12 points in the month and a tie for third place. His 1.64 GAA was the second best in the league in February while his .934 saves percentage in the month was the fourth best. He had two shutouts in the month of February, stopping all 29 in the 3-0 win over AIC (Feb. 2) and 29 more in the 1-0 win over Robert Morris (Feb. 23).

He was named the AHC Tournament MVP, allowing just one goal in two games and leading the Falcons to its second straight AHC championship. He stopped 59 of 60 shots he faced. In the play-offs, his shutout streak of 214 minutes over the course of four games (Army games two and three, Canisius and Robert Morris) is the second longest in school history (Andrew Volkening 262, 2008-09). His streak was the 17th longest in NCAA history.

At the NCAA West Regional, he made 39 saves, the second most of his career, in the win over No. 1 St. Cloud State.

His 1,026 saves this season are the fourth-most in school history and the most since Al Morrison had 1132 in 1972-73.
