## Air Force hosts Canisius, Feb. 16-17

*Falcons in midst of five games in nine days*

### This Week

Air Force (15-13-4, 10-11-3 AHC) hosts the Canisius Golden Griffins (15-13-2, 15-9-0 AHC), Friday-Saturday, Feb. 16-17, at Cadet Ice Arena. Friday's game starts at 7:05 pm MT while Saturday's faceoff is at 5:05 pm MT. Canisius is in first place in the AHC with 30 points while Air Force is in seventh with 23.

### Radio Show Changes to Feb. 18

Due to the rescheduling of the Air Force-Sacred Heart game, the Air Force hockey radio show with head coach Frank Serratore, and host Jay Ritchie, has moved from Tuesday, Feb. 13, to Thursday, Feb. 15, at 6 p.m. at the Old Chicago on Woodmen and I-25.

Every home game and every Atlantic Hockey game will be streamed on AtlanticHockey.tv or a subscription fee.

### Radio/Internet

Both games will be broadcast on Xtra Sports 1300 in Colorado Springs and will be available online at www.GoAirForceFalcons.com. The game is also available on TuneIn. Jay Ritchie will call the play-by-play while Dave Toller will provide color analysis. Pregame show begins 30 minutes before faceoff.

### The Coach

Head coach Frank Serratore is in his 21st season at Air Force with a record of 371-333-80 (784 games). The 2016 AHC Coach of the Year, he is the winningest coach in the history of Air Force hockey, having led Air Force to two regular-season titles, six AHC tournament championships and six NCAA Tournaments in the last 11 years. In his 25th season as a collegiate head coach, he has an overall record of 420-425-89 (934 games).

### Scouting the Griffs

Canisius is in first place in Atlantic Hockey, 15-13-2 overall and 15-9-0 in the league. Canisius split a two-game series at home last weekend with Army and is 3-3 in their last six games. Junior Dylan McLaughlin leads the team with 14 goals and 39 points. His 25 assists and 39 points lead the conference. Three play-

ers have 20 or more points. Sophomore Daniel Urbani has a 2.89 GAA and a .911 saves percentage. Urbani has started the last 11 games. Canisius ranks second in the league in both scoring offense and power play percentage.

### Trending

Air Force won one of three games on a five-day road swing on the east coast ... After a split at Bentley, the Falcons fell to Sacred Heart, 2-1, in overtime on Feb. 13 ... Air Force is 4-2-1 in the last six games ... Evan Giesler (9-10-19) and Erik Baskin (12-7-19) lead the team in points ... Giesler scored a goal in game two at Bentley ... Erik Baskin netted his first career hat trick in the win over Colorado College, Dec. 29 ... Air Force has killed 40 of the last 43 opponent power plays (93 percent) over the last 13 games ... Billy Christopoulos has allowed just 18 goals in his last 12 games and has two shutouts in his last 10 games ... The injury bug has bitten the Falcons hard this season as 17 players have combined to miss 155 games due to injury.

### Killin' It

Air Force has killed 40 of the last 43 opponent power plays over the last 13 games. Over the last 13 games, Air Force has killed: 5-of-5 against Mercyhurst; 6-of-6 against RIT; 2-of-2 against SHU; 10-of-11 against Niagara; 9-of-10 against AIC; 6-of-6 against Bentley and 2-of-3 vs. Sacred Heart. On the season, Air Force is at 84.3 percent (107-of-128) to rank second in Atlantic Hockey and 10th in the nation. AF led the nation in penalty kill last season.

### Senior Night

The Class of 2018 matches the largest senior class under (2007) head coach Frank Serratore. The eight-member class includes Dylan Abood, Erik Baskin, Phil Boje, Jordan Himley, Jonathan Kopacka, Ben Kucera, Tyler Ledford and Kyle Mackey. They have already won 78 games and helped lead the Falcons to the 2017 Atlantic Hockey Championship and a berth in the NCAA Elite Eight. The class has beaten Colorado College all four years, winning the Pikes Peak Trophy every year. They also posted a 7-3-1 record vs. Army and helped earn the Academy's first ever Ice Breaker Tournament last season.

Frank Serratore (Bemidji State, 1982) is in his 21st season as the Falcons' hockey coach. He has led Air Force to two regular-season league titles, six AHC Tournament Championships and six NCAA appearances (2007, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2012 and 2017). The 2016 Atlantic

Hockey Coach of the Year, Serratore owns more wins than any other coach in Air Force hockey history. In service academy competition, Serratore is 30-14-5 (66.3 percent) vs. the Black Knights while at Air Force.

# AHA Quarterfinals at USAFA

**Series vs. Canisius**

Air Force and Canisius have played 40 times and Air Force leads the series, 18-13-9. Earlier this season, the teams split a two-game series in Buffalo. In games played at the Academy, AF leads the series, 10-9-3. In the last four games at the Academy, AF is 2-1-1. Last season, Canisius took three of four points from Air Force at Cadet Ice Arena. The Falcons swept the Griffis in the Atlantic Hockey quarterfinals in 2016.

**Earlier This Season vs. Canisius**

Air Force and Canisius split a two-game series, Oct. 27-28, in Buffalo.

**Friday:** Air Force scored a goal in each period for a 3-1 win over Canisius, in an Atlantic Hockey Conference game Friday, Oct. 27, in Buffalo,

Early in the game with the Griffis on the power play, Canisius' Matt Hoover had some open net after a flurry in front, but Falcon goalie Billy Christopoulos reached back across to his left for the glove save. A few minutes later, Matt Pulver drew a penalty and the Falcons drew first blood. On the power play, Jordan Himley's shot was saved and Matt Serratore scored on the back door for his third of the season, and third in his last three games. Freshman defenseman Zach Mirageas also assisted on the play. Canisius tied the game early in the second period. Griff Grant Meyer forced a turnover behind the Falcons' net and fed Matt Hoover out front who was crashing down with speed. Hoover's second of the season tied the game at 6:48. In the final minute of the second period, Air Force re-gained the lead as Pulver scored with 58 seconds left in the third. After a flurry on the side of the net, Erik Baskin and Trevor Stone moved the puck in front of the net and Pulver scored his first of the season.

Early in the third period, Canisius had some quality opportunities. Two minutes into the period, Matt McLeod had a short-handed breakaway that hit the post. Just a couple minutes later, the Griffis had a 2-on-1 rush, but Christopoulos stopped the Griffis' leading scorer, Dylan McLaughlin. McLaughlin had another breakaway as he skated in all alone and Christopoulos made yet another save.

Midway through the third period, the Falcons struck again on the power play. Ben Kucera slid the puck to Himley in the left circle who quickly made a rink-wide pass to Mirageas. The freshman scored his first career goal for a 3-1 lead at 8:01.

**Saturday:** Canisius' Jimmy Mazza broke a tie in the third period as the Griffis defeated 18th-ranked Air Force, 3-2, in an Atlantic Hockey Conference game, Saturday, Oct. 28, at the HarborCenter in Buffalo. The teams split the two-game series.

Canisius jumped on the board early, outshooting the Falcons 4-0 in the first four minutes. Canisius senior Dylan McLaughlin took a shot that was saved, but Jeff Murray put back the rebound for a 1-0 lead at 3:16. Air Force came back to tie the game at the 11:58 mark. Brady Tomlak set up Kyle Mackey who scored his first of the season. Matt Serratore also assisted on the play.

Midway through the period, McLaughlin, Canisius' leading scorer, had two break-away opportunities. The first one resulted in a penalty shot that was saved by Billy Christopoulos. Then just about two minutes later, McLaughlin had another clean breakaway that was again saved by Christopoulos. Later in the period, McLaughlin scored on the power play with a wrister from the right circle for a 2-1 lead. Early in the third period, the Falcons again tied the game. Sophomore Matt Pulver forced a turnover and then skated the puck deep in to the zone. His back-hander from the right circle went over the pad of the goaltender and hit off the inside of the post at 4:40. Pulver's second of the season, and second of the weekend, tied the game at 2-2. Midway through the period, the Falcons were on the power play but the Griffis had an offensive zone faceoff. Ryan Schmelzer won the draw and Mazza's short-handed shot from the left point gave the Griffis a 3-2 lead at 6:18. The Falcons pulled the goalie with 1:10 remaining and had two shot attempts, but were unable to tie the game.

**Inside the Numbers**

Air Force is 11-2-2 when it scores first and 4-11-2 when the opponent scores first.

With Air Force this season, the game is pretty much decided after two periods. When the Falcons lead after two, they are 14-0-1. When the opponent leads after two, the Falcons are 1-12-2. The only win came when the Falcons trailed Bentley, 2-1, Feb. 10, and came back to win 4-2. The game has been tied after two periods twice and the Falcons are 0-1-1.

When the Falcons win the special teams battle, they are 9-0. When the Falcons lose the special teams battle, AF is 2-10-3. Air Force is 10-1 when scoring a power-play goal. The only came at RIT, Nov. 18.

**No Place Like Home**

Since the 2006-07 season, Air Force has won 67.1 percent of its home games, including a 66.6 mark in home conference games. Air Force was 11-4-2 at home last season and is 3-5-0 this season at home.

## The Falcons in the New Year

Since joining Atlantic Hockey for the 2006-07 season, the Falcons have had a winning record after January 1, in regular-season games, in 10 of the 11 seasons. Last season, the Falcons came up just short of winning the regular season title, posting an 11-3-2 record from Jan. 1 until the end of the regular season. Over the last two seasons, Air Force is 30-10-6 between Jan. 1 and the end of the regular season. Over the last four years (since 2014-15), Air Force's 23 wins in the month of January are the most of any team in the nation. ## Balanced Scoring

Air Force's leading scorer (Giesler and Baskin) each have 19 points, but the Falcons have nine players who have 10 or more points. Twenty-three different Falcons have scored a goal this season and 26 different players have at least one point. Nine different players have scored Air Force's 16 power-play goals.

## Three is the magic number ...

The Falcons are 14-1-2 when scoring three or more goals this season. Air Force is 1-12-2 when scoring two or less. This season's only loss came in a 6-3 defeat to Niagara, Dec. 1. Last season, Air Force was 23-1-3 when scoring three or more. The only loss was a 4-3 overtime loss to eventual national champion Denver. Over the last two years, Air Force is 37-2-5 when scoring three or more.

## The Century Mark

Air Force has nine players who have played in 100 or more career games: Jordan Himley (142), Tyler Ledford (137), Erik Baskin (137), Phil Boje (133), Ben Kucera (121), Kyle Mackey (119), Dylan Abood (110), Evan Giesler (109), Jonathan Kopacka (101). Matt Serratore could be the next to join the club as he has played in 97 career games.

## Get That Man an Ice Bag

Senior Phil Boje is second in the nation with 2.54 blocked shots per game this season. He has 72 blocks in 28 games (missing four games due to injury). He blocked 10 in the CC/DU weekend, Dec. 29-30. He blocked a career high seven shots against Niagara, Jan. 27. He has blocked six or more in a game three times this season (Niagara, Denver, Arizona State) and blocked five in the first game at Canisius. On Tuesday against Sacred Heart, he blocked four.

## New Faces

Six freshman have cracked the lineup this season and all six have at least one point. Two of them, Jake Levin and Alex Mehnert, have earned conference rookie of the week honors. Defenseman Zach Mirageas has played in 30 of the 32 games and is the top freshman scorer with seven points (2-5-7). Marshall Bowery ranks fourth in the league in goals by a freshman with six (6-0-6) in 22 games. Levin has five points (2-3-5) in 14 games, Mehnert has six points (2-4-6) in 12 games, Walker Sommer has three points (1-2-3), including the game-winner at Niagara, in 13 games. Max Harper has an assist (5 games).

### Abood a Candidate for Senior Class Award

Dylan Abood is a candidate for the 2017-18 Senior CLASS Award for hockey. Abood is one of 20 men's hockey student-athletes who excel both on and off the ice. Abood carries a 3.85 overall grade point average while majoring in electrical engineering. The Centennial, Colo., native has been on the Dean's List every semester. He is a two-time, first-team CoSIDA Academic All-District selection and has been named academic all-conference three times. This past summer, he was selected for the Cadet Summer Research Program with MIT Lincoln under Group 73 (Energy Systems), building, developing and testing a portable solar power system to assist with disaster relief operations.

A flight commander in his squadron, he has volunteered numerous hours in the community

On the ice, Abood is a two-time team captain. He has played in 97 career games and has recorded 23 career points (4-19-23) and is a +27, as of Dec. 10. The 20 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists in February, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition. The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2018 Frozen Four in April.

### 50th Season of Falcon Hockey

The 2017-18 season marks the 50th season of Air Force hockey. Prior to the Air Force hockey program going Division I in 1968-69, cadets had been playing hockey, both indoors and outdoors, since 1958. In 1966, Vic Heyliger was hired to coach the Air Force hockey club team and then make the transition to Division I in 1968. Heyliger, a member of the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame, started the Academy program after leading the University of Michigan to six national championships in 13 years. In the first season, 1968-69, under Heyliger, the Falcons posted a 6-12 record. It didn't take long for the Falcons to get on the college hockey map, posting a 25-6 record in 1971-72. Heyliger coached the team from 1969-74, John Matchefts was the coach from 1975-85, Chuck Delich was behind the bench from 1986-97 and Frank Serratore from 1998-Present.

### Last Week

Air Force and Bentley split a two-game series, Feb. 9-10, in Watertown, Mass. Bentley won game one, 2-0, while Air Force took game two, 4-2. Air Force then fell to Sacred Heart, 2-1 in overtime, Feb. 13.

**Friday:** Bentley goalie Jayson Argue stopped all 28 shots he faced as Bentley defeated Air Force, 2-0, in an Atlantic Hockey Conference game Friday, Feb. 9, at the John A. Ryan Arena in Watertown, Mass. After a scoreless first period, Bentley jumped on the board first early in the second. Connor Brassard's shot was saved, but Luke Santerno was there to put back the rebound at 2:42. Bentley held the 1-0 lead until late in the third. The Falcons pulled the goalie in favor of the extra attacker, but Bentley quickly found the empty net. Jake Kauppila's shot from the red line found the back of the net at 1:13 left, just six seconds after the goalie was pulled. Bentley outshot Air Force, 33-28. Billy Christopoulos made 31 saves. AF was 0-for-3 on the power play while Bentley was 0-for-2.

**Saturday:** Air Force scored four unanswered goals, coming from behind for a 4-2 win over Bentley in an Atlantic Hockey Conference game Saturday, Feb. 10, at the John A. Ryan Arena in Watertown, Mass. Bentley opened the scoring at the 7:51 mark of the first period on the rush. Ryner Gorowsky's shot from the left side was saved, but he collected his own rebound and scored his fifth of the season. Six minutes later, Bentley took a 2-0 lead. Jake Kauppila gained the zone down the right side, made a move in front of Billy Christopoulos and netted his sixth of the season. Air Force cut the Bentley lead in half midway through the second period on the power play. Erik Baskin sent the puck to Matt Koch at the right point and his shot was saved. Matt Serratore was in front for the rebound, netting his 11th of the season at 12:03. . Midway through the third period, the Falcons scored two goals in a span of three minutes to take their first lead of the series. On the power play, Tomlak took the puck off the back wall and then slid it through the crease to a slashing Evan Giesler. Giesler tied the game with his ninth of the season at 8:09. Three minutes later, the Falcons took their first lead of the series. Dan Bailey pulled the puck out of a scrum on the wall and set up Alex Mehnert at the left point. Mehnert's shot through traffic found the top corner as the Falcons took a 3-2 lead at 11:22 of the third. Tomlak's empty-netter with 12 seconds left sealed the win. Air Force outshot Bentley, 25-16, in the game. Air Force was 2-for-10 on the power play while Bentley was 0-for-4. Billy Christopoulos made 14 saves for the Falcons while Jayson Argue made 21 for the home team.

**Tuesday:** Matt Tugnutt's goal at 2:54 of overtime lifted Sacred Heart to a 2-1 win over Air Force in an Atlantic Hockey Conference game Tuesday, Feb. 13, at the TD Bank Sports Center in Hamden, Conn. This game was rescheduled from Jan. 20 due to the government shutdown and was played on the campus of Quinnipiac University. In the first two minutes of the opening period, SHU went on the power play and took the early lead as Marc Johnstone scored on the back door at 1:47. The Falcons tied the game early in the third period as Marshall Bowery scored his sixth of the season from Erich Jaeger and Trevor Stone at 5:59. In overtime, Tugnutt's shot from a sharp angle, bottom of the right circle, was the game winner at 2:54. SHU outshot Air Force, 28-24, in the game. SHU was 1-for-3 on the power play while Air Force was 0-for-4. Billy Christopoulos made 26 saves for the Falcons while Brett Magnus made 23 for the Pioneers.

**Solid Between the Pipes**

Junior Billy Christopoulos has started every game this season and ranks among the league's best in every goaltending category.

His 15 wins are the most in the league and the eighth most in the nation. In Atlantic Hockey, he leads the league in GAA (2.28) and is fourth in saves percentage (.915).

He has been named the Atlantic Hockey Goalie of the Month twice (October and January) and the Goalie of the Week twice (Jan. 16 and Feb. 5).

In the month of January, his 1.44 GAA and his .942 saves percentage are the best in the league. A native of Raleigh, N.C., Christopoulos posted a 5-2 record with the only losses coming by one goal. In seven games, he allowed just 10 goals and posted his first career shutout, a 4-0 win at RIT. Christopoulos was named AHC Goalie of the Week (Jan. 16) as he tallied a .982 saves percentage and 0.50 GAA in a road sweep at RIT. When the Falcons got three points against AIC (Feb. 2-3), he posted a .965 saves percentage and a 0.96 GAA.

He has had 30 or more saves five times with his season high of 32 saves coming in the season-opening win at Alaska
