**AIR FORCE IN THE WAC CHAMPIONSHIP:** The Falcons return to the WAC Championship for the first time since playing Fresno State in the 1996 finals match. The Falcons and Rebels are slated for a 1:00 p.m. MT match at Utah Valley's Clyde Field. A live stream and live stats will be provided by the WAC Digital Network. Fans can access the stream by going to the WAC Soccer homepage and clicking the links in the schedule window.

**LAST TIME AT THE WAC TOURNAMENT:** The last time Air Force played in the WAC tournament was in the 2013 season, in which the Falcons hosted the tournament. In the first round, four-seed Air Force topped five-seed Houston Baptist, 2-1. In the semi-finals, the Falcons fell, 0-2, to Seattle U. Air Force has had three WAC tournament appearances prior to this season (1996, 1998 and 2013), and are now 3-3 while playing in the WAC postseason.

**THE ROAD TO THE CHIP:** Air Force held off CSU Bakersfield and WAC powerhouse Seattle U in the first round and semi-finals of the 2016 WAC tournament, respectively. Austin Dewing and John Sims registered a goal apiece in the 2-0 shut out over CSU Bakersfield in the first round of the WAC tournament, Nov. 10. On Nov. 11, a second half surge lifted the Falcons to a 3-1 victory over 2015 WAC champions Seattle University. Senior team captain Cameron Duley logged a career-single game high three assists. Tucker Axhøj, Jaric Marton and Tucker Bone registered a goal apiece in the shutout.

**THE SERIES VS. UNLV:** The championship match between the Rebels and the Falcons will mark the 38th meeting between the programs. Air Force leads the series, 18-15-3. Earlier this season UNLV edged by the Falcons, 3-2, in what became a second period shootout with UNLV, Oct. 21, in Las Vegas, Nev. When playing at UNLV the Falcons are 5-9-1, when playing at Air Force the Falcons are 11-3-1; on neutral turf the series is tied 3-3-1. The Falcons and Rebels have been to overtime six times. In the 36-match series Air Force has scored 64 goals, while UNLV has scored 45.

**UP NEXT:** The winner of the tournament will be awarded an automatic bid into the NCAA championship tournament. The DI Men's Soccer College Cup will be hosted at BBVA Compass Stadium, Houston, Tex., on Dec. 9-11. An Air Force victory would guarantee the Falcons their seventh trip to the NCAA tournament in program history. The last time the Falcons played in the NCAA tournament was in 2012, Air Force fell to the Washington Huskies, 0-1.

**THE TALLY:** Air Force as a team has logged 131 points from 44 goals and 43 assist; marks higher than the previous five seasons concluded with. In 21 matches, 14 different Falcons have logged goals and five Falcons have double-digit points. If the Falcons win the championship match, they will have tied the program record for most wins in a season (15, 1980, 1993)

AIR FORCE SOCCER NOTES

**WENDT EARNS WAC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Air Force's John Wendt has been named Western Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Week, for Oct. 31 – Nov. 6. Wendt, a junior goalkeeper from Sylvania, Ohio, made six saves to hand Seattle U its first WAC loss of the season with his fifth shutout of the year. Four of the saves came in the second half as the Redhawks fired off 10 shots but the netminder used his athleticism to keep the ball out of the net and keep SU scoreless for just the second time this season.

**NATIONAL RANKINGS:** Air Force made their debut appearance in CSN's Top 30 teams at No. 29 for the weekend ending Oct. 9. Air Force is currently ranked 80th in the RPI rankings. Utah Valley remains among the nations' best in the latest RPI rankings, sitting at 34. Seattle U is also making sure they are on the radar of the NCAA selection committee, sitting at 62.

**NSCAA NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S WESTERN REGION TOP 10 RANKINGS:** Air Force remains at sixth in the NSCAA NCAA Division I Men's Western region top-10 rankings for following the win over Seattle U. The Falcons first broke into the polls at No. 7, in week three (Sept. 13). In September of 2015 the Falcons were ranked as high as No. 6. In 2014 they held the No. 1 spot in the western region for a week.

**AIR FORCE IS FLYING HIGH:** Air Force is playing amongst the best in DI soccer as they are ranked third in the nation in total goals (44), total assists (43) and total points (131). The Falcons are also fifth in the country in points per game (6.23), eighth in the country in scoring offense (2.05) and twelfth in the nation in assists per game (2.04). Air Force leads the WAC in all aforementioned stat categories

The Falcons displayed their ability to play on the road finishing the regular season road slate at 5-3-1 and extending to a 7-3-1 overall road slate in the WAC post season. In seven of the conference road matches, (including the WAC tournament) the Falcons have registered 15 goals.

In the 1-0 shutout over GCU, the Falcons held the Lopes' explosive scorers to nil in front of a home crowd exceeding 3,800 fans. The Falcons put up a two-goal shutout over Houston Baptist; a pitch they have had trouble winning on in the past. In the match against Incarnate Word, the Falcons logged four goals; their fourth four-goals plus performance this season. In their only conference loss on the road, UNLV edged by the Falcons, 3-2. In their only tie this season, Air Force left UTRGV's pitch knotted at one on Oct. 29.

**DEWING IS DOING THE JOB:** Austin Dewing is the Falcons' stat leader with 23 points from nine goals and five assists. He also has the most shots on the team (39). The Colorado Springs native is ranked amongst the top-50 players in the NCAA. He is 19th in the nation in game-winning goals (4) and 48th in the nation in total points (21).

Dewing logged his third two-goal match against Houston Baptist; helping the Falcons break a three-game winning drought on Houston Baptist's pitch

and facilitating the second conference win on the road.

The sophomore forward was tabbed with the WAC Offensive Player of the Week honor on Sept. 26, as he led the Falcons' charge scoring as many goals as Gonzaga had allowed in their previous two matches combined.

**AXHOJ, BONE, PARKER AND SIMS - A FORCE TO BE RECKONED WITH:** Tucker Axhoj, Tucker Bone, Clint Parker and John Sims combine for 57 points, 20 goals, 17 assists and five game-winning goals. The quartet has taken 111 shots this season with 59 coming on frame.

Sophomore midfielder Bone leads the team with six assists. He is second on the team with 16 points and two game-winning goals. Bone was credited with his second game-winner in the match against GCU. The Granite Bay, Calif., native was announced to TopDrawerSoccer.com's Men's Team of the Week, Sept. 12-18, as he contributed assists in both of Air Force's wins against St. Mary's and San Francisco. He also had the only assist in the Falcons' shutout victory over Seattle.

Senior midfielder Axhoj is second on the team in shots (38) and leads the team in shots on goal (19). The Waxhaw, N.C., native has 13 points from four goals and five assists.

Sophomore defender Parker is tied with Sims for third on the team in points (14). The Charlotte, N.C., native is tied for third most goals on the team with five and is fourth on the team in assists (4). He has the second most shots on goal on the team (17).

John Sims logged a career high two-goal game against CSU Bakersfield, Oct. 16. The Colorado Springs, CO, native has six goals which is second most on the team. He has 14 points, tying him for third most on the squad.

**DULEY AND PUJATS ON LOCKDOWN DUTY:** Team captain Cameron Duley and Trey Pujats are linchpin defenders in the Falcon defense. The duo has played an integral role in marking the opponent's top scorers, contributing to Air Force outscoring their opponents, 44-23, this season.

The Falcon defense mustered their eighth shutout on the season holding WAC heavyweight Seattle U to nil in the regular season finale and CSU Bakersfield to nil in the first round of the tournament.

Albeit Air Force fell to UNLV, Oct. 21, Pujats was instrumental in getting the Falcons back within striking distance of the Rebels. He fired in a laser beam from 30 yards to give the Falcons some momentum and get them back in the match. His leadership as a defender kept the Falcons in the match until the final second.

Duley and Pujats were integral in the CSU Bakersfield shutout in which the Roadrunners only took three shots with none on goal. Furthermore, on Oct. 8, Duley was tasked with marking GCU's leading scorer Niki Jackson, who has two hat-trick

performances this season and leads the WAC in goals; he was held to two shots on goal and no goals under Duley's watch.

Earlier this season, Keller, Tex., native Pujats marked the leading scorer for Gonzaga, Sept. 25, and held him to zero shots as the Falcons earned a 4-1 win at home. He was credited as the WAC's Defensive Player of the Week.

**BETWEEN THE PIPES:** Sylvania, Ohio, native John Wendt is tied for first in the conference in shutouts (5). Wendt holds a 1.15 goals against average and has logged 70 saves.

He made six saves to hand Seattle U its first WAC loss of the season on Nov. 5. Four of the saves came in the second half as the Redhawks fired off 10 shots but the netminder used his athleticism to keep the ball out of the net and keep SU scoreless for just the second time this season.

Wendt was also credited with Player of the Game honors in the shutout against GCU. Wendt made two remarkable saves against GCU's leading scorer Niki Jackson, in free kick and penalty kick opportunities, to cease the Lopes' momentum and ultimately hold them to nil, on Oct. 8.

Senior goalkeeper Jake Schenk is undefeated in the box. He's logged two shutouts and has only allowed two goals in 225 minutes between the pipes. Schenk was dubbed the WAC's Defensive Player of the Week, Sept. 12. The Flemington, N.J., native has logged six saves and has a .750 save percentage.

### AIR FORCE SWEEPS WEEKLY CONFERENCE

**HONORS:** Austin Dewing and Trey Pujats have been named Western Athletic Conference Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, for Sep. 19 - Sep. 25.

Dewing collected the brace in the 4-1 win over Gonzaga, scoring twice against the Bulldogs. The Falcons' leader in goals helped lead Air Force to a three-game home winning streak.

Pujats marked the leading scorer for Gonzaga and held him to zero shots as the Falcons earned a 4-1 win at home. He also played 77 minutes in a 1-0 loss to Omaha, who is ranked 49th in the NCAA RPI rankings.

**FALCONS GO BIG IN HOME OPENER:** Six Falcons logged goals in the 6-0 shutout against Bryant in the home slate opener, Sept. 9, at Cadet Soccer Stadium. The last time Air Force put up six goals in a single match was against Buffalo in 2011.

**FALCONS SHOW OUT IN EXHIBITION ACTION:** Air Force hosted the University of Denver for an exhibition match, Aug. 20, at Cadet Soccer Stadium. At the end of regulation Air Force held the top-ranked Pioneers to nil.

In an unofficial overtime period, the Falcons would be the ones to net a goal and take the exhibition victory, unofficially.

**FALCON TIDBITS:** Seniors Cameron Duley and A.J. Esparza are the 2016 team captains.

John Sims and James Sims are brothers, they play alongside their cousins David Louthan and Austin Dewing. The Sims brothers and Dewing played together at Air Academy High School. Dewing and James Sims led Air Academy to an undefeated season and class 4A state title in their senior year.

Air Force senior Tucker Axhoj and sophomore Clint Parker are both graduates of Marvin Ridge High School in Waxhaw, N.C.

Freshmen Ben Blessing and Nick Blessing are twins; the first set of twins on the roster in men's soccer program history. Ben and Nick graduated from Wakeland High School, the same school senior Ryan Ward and freshman Cayne Cardwell graduated from.

Freshman Muneer Abousaud's older brother, Shaban, plays soccer at Army West Point, he is a junior. They met on the pitch for the first time as service academy rivals at West Point, N.Y., Aug. 26. Team captain Cameron Duley played club soccer for Abousaud's father, Ibrahim.

**THE SERIES VS. UNLV:** The championship match between the Rebels and the Falcons will mark the 38th meeting between the programs. Earlier this season UNLV edged by the Falcons, 3-2, in what became a second period shootout with UNLV, Oct. 21, in Las Vegas, Nev. When playing at UNLV the Falcons are 5-9-1, when playing at Air Force the Falcons are 11-3-1; on neutral turf the series is tied 3-3-1. The Falcons and Rebels have been to overtime six times. In the 36-match series Air Force has scored 64 goals, while UNLV has scored 45.

**AIR FORCE AT UNLV, OCT. 21:** The Rebels' Timo Mehlich put the first goal on the board in the 33rd minute. The Falcon defenders were quick to collapse on the Rebel's leading scorer Danny Musovsky as he charged the box; Musovsky quickly sent the ball out to an open Mehlich where he found an opening for the goal.

Trailing by one, the Falcons continued to press the ball to the Rebels' side of the pitch. Stubborn defense on both ends kept the match at 1-0 at the end of the first period. The Falcons took six shots with two on goal in the first period.

In the 60th minute Musovski sent in a bold shot from 25 yards out, grazing the left pipe into the back of the goal to extend the Rebels' lead, 2-0.

The Falcons found some fuel in the tanks in the 78th minute when Austin Guerrero sent a free kick in from midfield which was deflected by a Rebel defender directly to Falcon midfielder Trey Pujats. Pujats cocked back and fired a laser beam from 30 yards out to the left side of the goal for the Falcons first goal of the match. The goal marked Pujats second of the season.

The Rebels quickly bounced back with a goal of their own in the 79th minute as Musovski took a turn-around shout from the middle of a crowded box to extend the Rebel lead, 3-1.

Undeterred the Falcons charged down the pitch to apply pressure on the Rebel goalkeeper. With time winding down Austin Dewing dribbled into the box and took launched a shot at the Rebel goal. Dewing's shot was on trajectory for nylon but was instead deflected into the goal by a Rebel defender for the Falcons' second score of the match. UNLV was credited with an own goal for the Falcons.

Sensing the final minutes drawing near, Air Force picked up the intensity by taking several attempts at the Rebel goalkeeper. The Falcons were unable to punch one in for the tie before the clock expired.

The Falcons took 12 shots with six coming on goal. Junior goalkeeper John Wendt logged four saves against 16 shots faced in 90 minutes.

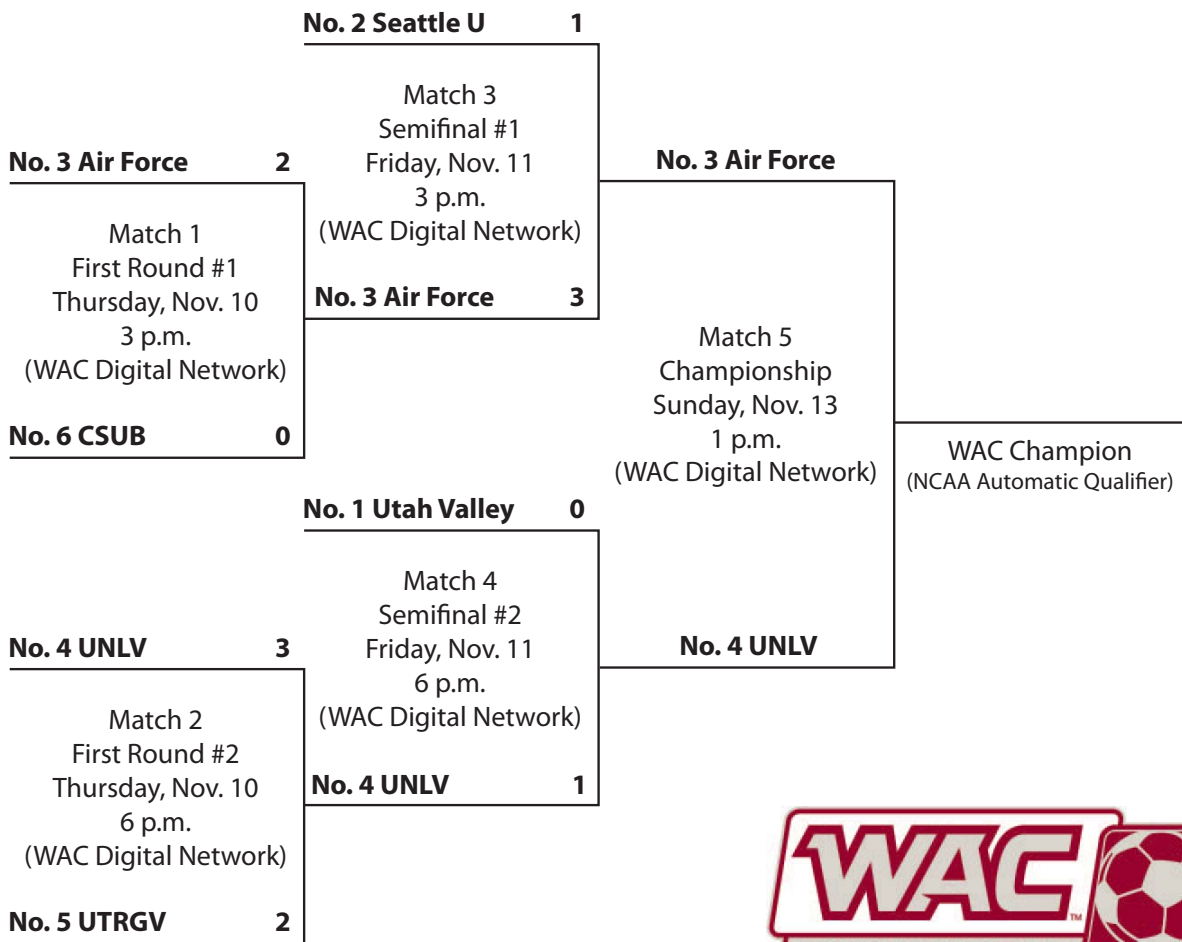
