THIS WEEK...

The Air Force women's basketball team heads to Las Vegas, Nev., this week for the 2012 Conoco Mountain West Championships, being held March 7-10. The eighth-seeded Falcons will face top-seed San Diego State in the first game of the tournament, slated for 12:00 p.m. (PT) on Wednesday.

LAST TIME OUT...

Snapping a 14-game losing streak, the Falcons captured a 52-47 victory over New Mexico Wednesday evening at the Academy. Junior **Katie Hilbig** tallied her third double-double of the year to lead the Falcons to their first conference win of the year, finishing with 12 points and a career-best 14 rebounds, while sophomore **Cherae Medina** added a career-high 12 points.

SCOUTING THE FALCONS...

Air Force, seeded eighth in the tournament, closed out the regular season with a 6-23 overall mark and 1-13 ledger in the Mountain West.

Junior **Alicia Leipprandt** leads the Falcons in scoring for the season, averaging 12.7 points per game, while classmate **Dymond James** is right behind with 12.3 points and a team-best 6.4 rebounds per contest. In conference play, James leads the Falcons in both scoring and rebounding, averaging 13.1 points and 5.9 rebounds per game.

SCOUTING THE AZTECS...

San Diego State, the top seed in the Mountain West Championship, ended the regular season with a 22-6 overall record and 12-2 record in the Mountain West.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE AZTECS...

Despite winning the second half, the Air Force women's basketball team dropped a 59-46 decision to league-leading San Diego State on Feb. 18 in Viejas Arena.

Junior **Dymond James** scored 16 points to lead the Falcons, while classmate **Katie Hilbig** notched her second double-double of the season, finishing with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Also scoring in double figures for Air Force was sophomore **Cherae Medina** with 10 points.

points, while Chelsea Hopkins added 15 points and 10 assists.

San Diego State cruised to a 33-15 advantage at the intermission, aided by an 18-3 run in the middle of the opening period. The Aztecs dominated on the boards in the first half, outrebounding the Falcons 25-9, as three Air Force players were saddled with three fouls each. The Falcons also struggled to convert at the foul line, missing 7-of-10 free throws before the break.

Air Force started the second half on a hot streak, going on a 9-2 run to start the period. The Falcons eventually cut the margin to nine point following a three-point play by Medina with just over 10 minutes remaining, but the Aztecs responded with the next two scores to push their lead back to 13 points and retained control the rest of the way.

The Falcons shot almost 43 percent from the field in the second half, while the Aztecs knocked down just 25.9 percent of their shots after the break. Air Force had a slight edge on the glass in the final stanza, grabbing 20 rebounds compared to 16 for San Diego State.

AIR FORCE AT THE MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIPS...

Air Force has a 2-12 record all-time at the Mountain West Championships. Both of the Falcons' victories came against Colorado State, defeating the Rams 47-46 in 2007, while capturing a 66-63 victory in 2011.

Meanwhile, Wednesday's contest will mark the first-ever meeting between San Diego State and Air Force in the Mountain West Championship.

JAMES NAMED TO MOUNTAIN WEST ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM...

Air Force junior **Dymond James** has been named to the Mountain West 2011-12 Women's Basketball All-Conference team as an honorable mention selection, earning the first all-conference accolades of her career.

Despite missing part of the season due to injury, James concluded the regular season averaging a career-best 12.3 points and a team-leading 6.4 rebounds per contest, while also ranking among the league's leaders in free-throw percentage (.805).

James, who is the first Falcon to receive all-conference recognition since 2010, is just the ninth Air Force player to be named an All-Mountain West selection.

MOUNTAIN WEST CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK...

Junior **Katie Hilbig** was named the Mountain West Women's Basketball Co-Player of the Week on March 5, sharing the award with UNLV's Kelli Thompson. It marks the first weekly honor for Hilbig and the first for an Air Force player the 2008-09 season.

Hilbig registered her third double-double of the season to lead the Falcons to a 52-47 victory over New Mexico in the regular season finale. She finished the game with 12 points and a career-high 14 rebounds as Air Force won its first conference game of the season, ending a 14-game losing streak. It was also the first time Air Force had beaten the Lobos since January 1992. Hilbig, who grabbed eight of her 14 rebounds on the offensive glass, also registered three steals and two assists in a career-high 35 minutes of action.

In addition to earning conference honors, Hilbig was also named the Air Force Athlete of the Week for the first time in her career.

ENDING THE STREAK...

Air Force's win over New Mexico on Wednesday snapped a 14-game losing streak for the Falcons, as they captured their first conference win of the season. It also marked just the second-ever victory for Air Force against New Mexico, and the first since the initial meeting between the two teams in January 1992.

AIR FORCE 52, NEW MEXICO 47...

Junior **Katie Hilbig** registered her third double-double of the season to lead the Air Force women's basketball team in a 52-47 victory over New Mexico.

Hilbig finished with 12 points and a career-high 14 rebounds for Air Force, while sophomore **Cherae Medina** also scored in double figures with 12 points. For the Lobos, Caroline Durbin was the leading scorer with 13 points, while Porche Torrance added 12 points and 14 rebounds.

Air Force struggled early, going without a field goal for over eight minutes to fall into an 11-1 deficit in the first half. However, the Falcons went on a run to tie the game at 12-12 with a three-pointer from Medina. Air Force and New Mexico traded leads for the remainder of the opening half before going into the locker room tied at 25-25.

New Mexico notched the first five points after the break to regain the advantage, but the lead continued to change hands as both teams went on scoring spurts. The Lobos were up by three points, 43-40, with just under five minutes remaining and still had a one-point cushion with 3:07 left on the clock.

After a basket by Medina put Air Force back on top, sophomore **Camille Thompson** converted a three-point play to push the Falcons' margin to four points with 2:21 remaining. Air Force came up with defensive stops down the stretch to hold on to the five-point victory.

Air Force was able to hold New Mexico, the top three-point field goal shooting team in the conference, to just 1-of-11 from beyond the arc. The Falcons also forced 24 turnovers by the Lobos, while grabbing a season-high-tying 15 steals. Meanwhile, Air Force was outrebounded for the game, 44-36, and shot poorly at the charity stripe, missing 13 free throws on the evening.

ANOTHER DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR KATIE...

Junior **Katie Hilbig** registered her third double-double of the year on Wednesday, tallying 12 points and a career-high 14 rebounds to lead Air Force in their first conference win of the year. Hilbig's 14 rebounds were the second-highest single-game total for a Falcon this year, and marked the fourth 10+ rebound performance in her career.

CHERAE'S CAREER DAY...

Sophomore **Cherae Medina** scored a career-best 12 points to help lead Air Force to a 52-47 victory over New Mexico on Wednesday. Medina scored the Falcons' final three points from the free throw line to ice Air Force's first conference victory.

SENIOR NIGHT...

Prior to Wednesday's game versus New Mexico, the Falcons honored the lone member of their senior class, team captain **Jamela Satterfield**. With her performance against the Lobos, Satterfield matched the school record for career games player with 118, while also moving into the top 10 in the Academy's Division I record books for career steals with 102.

ANOTHER NEW LINEUP...

Air Force has been experimenting with its starting lineup all season, with the newest combination unveiled versus New Mexico on Feb. 29. The Falcons have used 16 different starting lineups this season.

FALCONS IN FOUL TROUBLE...

Air Force found itself in foul trouble against UNLV on Feb. 25, helping the Lady Rebels spark their huge second-half run at the free throw line. The Falcons were called for a season-high 27 fouls versus UNLV, as the Lady Rebels attempted 39 free throws, the most by an Air Force opponent this season.

GETTING TO THE CHARITY STRIPE...

The Falcons have done a solid job of getting to the foul line this season, setting a new team record for free throw attempts in a single season (Division I era). Air Force has attempted 632 free throws so far this season, surpassing the previous record of 587 attempts from the foul line.

SHOOTING STRUGGLES...

The biggest factor in Air Force's loss against TCU on Feb. 22 was its poor shooting from the field. The Falcons connected on just 9-of-52 attempts from the field, for their lowest single-game field goal percentage (.173) in program history.

SEASON-LOW SCORING...

Air Force scored a season-low 31 points against TCU on Feb. 22, marking the fourth time this season that the Falcons have scored under 40 points in a game. It was also the lowest scoring output for Air Force since March 2009, when the Falcons scored just 31 points in an 11-point loss to BYU.

KATIE'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE...

Junior **Katie Hilbig** tallied the second double-double of the season and her career on Feb. 18, finishing with 10 points and 10 rebounds against San Diego State. Hilbig is one of four Air Force players to register a double-double this season.

FREE THROW WOES...

The Falcons shot poorly from the free throw line against the Aztecs on Feb. 18, converting just 15-of-26 shots (.577) from the charity stripe. Air Force particularly struggled in the first half, knocking down just 3-of-10 attempts from the foul line.

OUTSHOOTING THE AZTECS...

Air Force managed to outshoot San Diego State from the field on Feb. 18, finishing at 37.5 percent, while holding the Aztecs to 32.1 percent. It marked just the second time in conference play this year that the Falcons have shot better than their opponents—the previous game was also against San Diego State.

WHAT A TURNAROUND...

Although Air Force was unable to come up with a win in its game versus Wyoming on Feb. 15, it was a much different game than the Falcons' previous contest against the Cowgirls. In January, when the two teams met in Laramie, Wyoming handed Air Force a lopsided 98-36 loss, the Falcons' worst defeat of the season. Meanwhile, the rematch was much closer, with Air Force dropping one of its closest games of the conference slate.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL...

One reason the Falcons managed to keep it close against Wyoming on Feb. 15 was their ability to take care of the ball. Air Force committed a season-low 12 turnovers against the Cowgirls, including just five in the opening half. Meanwhile, Wyoming, which had recorded just 10 turnovers in the previous meeting between the two teams, finished the game with 19 turnovers.

In addition, Air Force dished out 15 assists, marking the first time this season that the Falcons have registered more assists than turnovers. Leading the way was junior **Katie Hilbig** with a season-high-tying six assists, while sophomore **Cherae Medina** added five assists.

DYMOND WITH THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE...

Junior **Dymond James** tallied her fourth double-double of the year in the Falcons' game against Wyoming on Feb. 15, registering 13 points and 10 rebounds. James now has 10 double-doubles in her career. In addition, James has recorded 10+ rebounds in 12 career games.

AUSTYN ON OFFENSE...

Junior **Austyn Wilson** has been known for her intensity on the defensive end of the court, and that was evident on Feb. 15 as she recorded a team-high and personal-best three steals against Wyoming. However, Wilson also made her mark on the offensive end, scoring a career-high nine points, including the Falcons' lone three-pointer of the evening.

ALICIA'S OFFENSE...

DYMOND AGAINST THE BRONCOS...

On Feb. 11, junior **Dymond James** had a solid performance against Boise State for the second time this season, finishing with 17 points and seven rebounds. In two games against the Broncos this year, James has averaged 20.5 points and 8.5 rebounds.

CHERAE GIVES A HAND...

Returning to the starting lineup versus Boise State on Feb. 11, sophomore **Cherae Medina** did a strong job of running the Falcons' offense. Medina dished out a career-best six assists, matching the highest single-game assist total for an Air Force player this season.

KATIE RETURNS...

The Falcons' contest against Colorado State on Feb. 4 marked the return of junior forward **Katie Hilbig**, who missed the previous 12 games with a foot injury. In her comeback game against the Rams, Hilbig registered four points, two rebounds, an assist and a steal in just nine minutes of action.

LOW SCORERS...

Air Force registered one of its lowest point totals of the season versus Colorado State on Feb. 4, and that was reflected in the individual scoring totals.

For the first time this season, no Falcon reached double figures in scoring, as sophomore **Megan O'Neil** was the leading scorer with six points. Two other Air Force players registered five points each, while three more pitched in four points apiece.

REBOUNDING HIGHS AND LOWS...

Against Colorado State on Feb. 4, freshman walk-on **Angela Johnson** had a great rebounding performance for the Falcons, grabbing a personal-best and team-high six rebounds.

Meanwhile, as a team, Air Force posted one of its lowest rebounding totals of the season, finishing with 27 boards, matching its previous season low set at Wyoming.

KAMI'S CAREER DAY...

Earning her first career start against New Mexico on Jan. 31 was sophomore **Kami Bohannon**. Bohannon made the most of her time on the court versus the Lobos, registering career highs in both points (9) and rebounds (6) in a career-high 36 minutes of action.

J LEADS THE WAY...

Senior captain **Jamela Satterfield** was the Falcons' leading scorer versus New Mexico on Jan. 31, scoring a career-high-tying 14 points. It marked the first time this season that Satterfield, who notched personal best in free throws made (4) and attempted (5), led the team in scoring.

MEGAN IN THE RECORD BOOKS...

Sophomore **Megan O'Neil** currently ranks in the top 10 in the Falcons' career and single-season blocks lists. She ranks fourth in the Academy's Division I record books for blocks in a career (55) and ninth all-time at the Academy in career blocks. Meanwhile, her 38 blocks this season rank as the second-most in a single season during the Falcons' Division I era and third-most overall.

FALCONS' BLOCK PARTY...

Air Force registered a season-high seven blocks against UNLV on Jan. 28, after entering the game averaging just 2.5 blocks per contest. Leading the way for the Falcons was sophomore **Megan O'Neil**, who recorded a career-high four blocks in the game.

FALCONS PACK THE HOUSE...

The Falcons had a season-high crowd of 2,509 fans against TCU on Jan. 25 during their designated "Pack the House" game. "Pack the House" is a national effort in which conferences and institutions compete to build women's basketball attendance.

Air Force won the 2011 "Pack the House" Challenge for the Mountain West Conference after setting the program's Division I home attendance record in a televised game versus in-state rival Colorado State.

CRASHING THE BOARDS...

Air Force grabbed 45 rebounds against TCU on Jan. 25, its highest rebound total since recording a season-high 54 rebounds against USF on Dec. 3. The Falcons also outrebounded the Horned Frogs, marking just the second time in the past 12 games that Air Force has recorded more rebounds than its opponent.

Leading the way for the Falcons on the boards versus TCU were junior **Dymond James** and sophomore **Michelle Ivey**, who each collected nine rebounds.

ANOTHER DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR DYMOND...

Junior **Dymond James** registered her third double-double of the season against San Diego State on Jan. 21, finishing with a game-high 19 points and 11 rebounds.

CAREER HIGH FOR MEGAN...

After a two-game hiatus, sophomore **Megan O'Neil** returned to the Falcons' lineup with a career-best offensive performance against San Diego State, scoring 18 points. O'Neil's previous career-high scoring output was 14 points earlier this season versus Denver.

SEASON-HIGH SHOOTING...

After averaging 29.0 shooting from the field in its first three conference games of the year, Air Force heated up against San Diego State on Jan. 21, shooting a season-best 51.1 percent.

ALICIA IN THE TOP 10...

With her 11 points against Wyoming on Jan. 18, junior **Alicia Leipprandt** moved into 10th place on the Falcons' Division I career scoring list. She currently ranks ninth on the list with 840 career points.

Additionally, Leipprandt moved into the top-25 list for all-time scorers at the Academy following her performance against San Diego State on Jan. 21, and currently ranks 23rd.

HIGH-SCORING OPPONENT...

For the second time in the past three years, Wyoming scored 98 points against the Falcons on their own home court. The Cowgirls also scored 98 points versus Air Force in 2010.

The Cowgirls shot 63.9 percent from the field versus the Falcons, marking the highest field goal percentage for an Air Force opponent this season.

A SOLID PERFORMANCE FOR ANGELA...

Freshman walk-on **Angela Johnson** gave the Falcons some productive minutes against Wyoming on Jan. 18, scoring the first four points of her career in her fourth appearance this season. Johnson, who saw 13 minutes of action against the Cowgirls, also dished out her first career assist and grabbed a team-high-tying four rebounds.

DYMOND'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE, PART DEUX...

Junior **Dymond James** posted her second double-double of the year versus Boise State on Jan. 14, finishing with a season-high 24 points, along with 10 rebounds. In addition, the Boise State game marked the second 20+ point performance of her career.

MICHELLE'S BIG GAME...

Sophomore **Michelle Ivey** had a breakout offensive performance against Boise State on Jan. 14, scoring a career-best 18 points against the Broncos. Ivey's previous career high in scoring was eight points.

In addition, Ivey shot 77.8 percent from the field (7-of-9), the best single-



game performance for a Falcon this season.

DYMOND RETURNS...

After missing five games due to an ankle injury, junior **Dymond James** returned to the lineup against Colorado State on Jan. 11, finishing with a team-best 14 points, while also recording a career-high five steals. Meanwhile, she posted a season-best 24 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for a double-double against Boise State.

CHERAE'S BACK, TOO...

The Falcons saw the return of another key player in the game versus Colorado State, as sophomore point guard **Cherae Medina** saw action for the first time since Nov. 19. Medina, who missed 11 games due to a knee injury suffered against Texas Southern, scored two points and grabbed three rebounds in nine minutes of action versus the Rams.

MICHELLE CRASHES THE BOARDS...

Sophomore **Michelle Ivey** was the Falcons' leading rebounder versus Colorado State, grabbing a personal-best eight boards against the Rams. Ivey also played a career-high 29 minutes while making the first start of her career.

JAMELA ON D...

Senior captain **Jamela Satterfield** was a solid defensive presence for the Falcons against Longwood, grabbing 11 of her career-high 12 rebounds on the defensive end.

In addition, Satterfield registered a personal-best two blocks while grabbing a career-high-tying six steals against the Lancers.

BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN...

With its win over North Dakota on Jan. 5, Air Force snapped a five-game losing streak that dated back to the first weekend of December.

MEGAN IN THE MIDDLE...

Sophomore **Megan O'Neil** had one of her best all-around games of the season against North Dakota on Jan. 5, recording 13 points and a team-best seven rebounds. In addition, O'Neil notched two blocked shots, a steal and a career-high two assists in 28 minutes of action against UND.

JAMELA IN DOUBLE DIGITS...

Senior captain **Jamela Satterfield** registered her first double-digit scoring output of the season against North Dakota, finishing the game with 10 points.

HOME SWEET HOME...

After playing nine of their first 13 games of the season on the road, the Falcons returned home for their final two non-conference contests. Air Force played a total of five home games in the month of January, after having just four home contests in the first two months of action.

JAMELA'S THE LEADER...

Senior captain **Jamela Satterfield** had one of her best games of the season versus Alabama, finishing with eight points and a team-best nine rebounds. Her eight points were then a season high, while she matched a career-best mark with nine rebounds.

FROM DOWNTOWN...

Air Force knocked down a season-high five three-pointers against Alabama on Dec. 30, all in the second half. Leading the way for the Falcons was freshman **Jimi Blagowsky**, who hit both of her three-point attempts in the game.

In addition, Air Force scored more three-point field goals (5) than two-point field goals (3) in the second period versus the Crimson Tide.

ROAD WARRIORS...

In the first two months of the Falcons' brutal non-conference schedule, the team played in a total of seven states (Tennessee, Colorado, Texas, Maryland, Minnesota, California and Alabama) and four time zones. In addition, nine of Air Force's first 13 games were on the road.

KAMI STEPS UP...

Sophomore **Kami Bohannon** posted career-best marks in the Falcons' non-conference games in California, scoring a personal-best eight points in each contest. Bohannon also grabbed a career-high five rebounds versus San Jose State, while dishing out a career-high three assists against Pacific.

DOUBLE-DIGITS FOR DANIELLE...

Junior **Danielle Sorrera** led Air Force with 11 points against San Jose State, marking the first double-digit scoring output of her career. Sorrera also had a career-best four assists and three steals, leading the Falcons in both categories in the game.

SEASON-HIGH STEALS...

Air Force was able to grab a season-best 15 steals against San Jose State, while also forcing 34 turnovers by the Spartans. The 34 turnovers by San Jose State were the most for an Air Force opponent this season.

CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE BENCH...

While the Falcons struggled offensively against Minnesota on Dec. 7, Air Force did get some contributions from off the bench. Sophomore **Michelle Ivey** scored a career-high-tying eight points in just 16 minutes of action, shooting 3-of-3 from the field and 2-of-2 from the foul line. Meanwhile, junior **Austyn Wilson** added five points, four rebounds and a career-best two assists for the Falcons.

GETTING TO 500...

This season, two Air Force players have passed the 500-point plateau for their respective careers. With her 17 points against Lipscomb in the Falcons' season opener, junior **Alicia Leipprandt**, who now has 840 career points, became just the 14th player in the Falcons' Division I era to reach 500 points in a career.

Meanwhile, classmate **Dymond James** was the 15th Division I player for the Falcons to hit the 500-point mark, scoring 14 points in Air Force's game versus Denver to reach 504 career points. She now sits at 756 points for her career.

ANOTHER 30 FOR ALICIA...

Junior **Alicia Leipprandt** registered a career-best 32 points against USF on Dec. 3, marking her second 30+ point game of the season and her career.

Earlier this year, Leipprandt scored 30 points in a win over Texas State,



becoming just the fourth Air Force player at the Division I level to reach at least 30 points in a game.

Megan Thiedeman and Latoya Howell share the Falcons' Division I record of 38 points in a game, while Howell and Raimee Beck each scored 30 points in a game as well.

TOO MANY TURNOVERS...

The Falcons were extremely turnover-prone in their two games during the Air Force Classic, committing a combined 65 turnovers against Jackson State and USF. After recording a then-season-high 29 turnovers against Jackson State, the Falcons had 36 turnovers versus USF.

Air Force's 36 turnovers against the Bulls were the most for the Falcons since committing 38 turnovers in a 2008 loss to San Diego State.

KATIE ON THE ASSIST...

A day after leading the Falcons in points and rebounds against Jackson State, junior **Katie Hilbig** paced Air Force in assists versus USF. Hilbig dished out a season-best six assists against the Bulls, the highest total for a Falcon this season.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES ALL-AROUND...

Three different Falcons notched double-doubles during the Air Force Classic, including two players who notched the first double-doubles of their respective careers.

Against Jackson State, junior **Katie Hilbig** registered the first double-double of her career, finishing with 16 points and a career-high 11 rebounds. Junior **Alicia Leipprandt** tallied her second double-double of the year with a career-high 32 points and 10 rebounds against USF, while sophomore **Megan O'Neil** posted her first career double-double with 13 points and a personal-best 11 rebounds versus the Bulls.

CRASHING THE BOARDS...

The Falcons dominated the boards in the Air Force Classic, recording a combined 32 more rebounds than their opponents. Air Force outrebounded Jackson State, 47-35, while holding a 54-33 advantage against USF. Air Force's 54 rebounds against the Bulls were a season high, while USF's 33 rebounds were a season low for the Falcons' opponents.

FALCONS AT THE CHARITY STRIPE...

Air Force shot a season-best 87.5 percent from the free throw line against Jackson State on Dec. 2, knocking down 28-of-32 foul shots. The Falcons' 28 made free throws were also a season high.

AIR FORCE CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM...

Junior **Alicia Leipprandt** was named to the Air Force Classic all-tournament team after averaging 24.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in two games for the Falcons.

SHOOTING WOES...

Air Force struggled with its shooting from the field against Northern Colorado, hitting just over 24 percent (15-of-62) of its shots. The Falcons missed their first 10 field goals of the game to fall in a large hole against the Bears.

THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE CLUB...

Junior **Alicia Leipprandt** became the second Air Force player to register a double-double this season with her career-high 30 points and 12 rebounds versus Texas State. It marked the first double-double of Leipprandt's career.

WINNING ON THE ROAD...

With their win against Texas State, the Falcons captured their third road victory of the season. Air Force's three road wins are tied for the second-highest road win total in the Falcons' Division I history.

DANIELLE IN ACTION...

With starting point guard **Cherae Medina** leaving the game early against Texas Southern on Nov. 19, junior **Danielle Sorrera** made her way onto the court, making just her fifth career appearance. Sorrera played 29 minutes versus the Tigers after seeing just 13 combined minutes of action in her four previous career games.

Sorrera finished the Texas Southern game with two rebounds, two assists and a steal, all career-high marks. In her first career start against Texas State, Sorrera's numbers improved even more, playing 30 minutes and recording three rebounds, three assists and two steals against the Bobcats.

DYMOND'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE...

Junior **Dymond James** recorded her first double-double of the season versus Denver, finishing with 14 points and a career-high-tying 15 rebounds.

MEGAN'S CAREER DAY...

Sophomore **Megan O'Neil**, a native of Aurora, Colo., had one of the best games of her career against her hometown team, Denver.

O'Neil scored a career-high 14 points against the Pioneers, knocking down 5-of-10 shots from the field and 4-of-5 from the free throw line. O'Neil also added four rebounds and two blocks in the game.

TEN FOR ALICIA...

Junior **Alicia Leipprandt** was one of the top rebounders for the Falcons against Denver, pulling down a then-career-high 10 boards.

Leipprandt, whose previous career-best rebound total was six, became the third Air Force player to reach 10 rebounds in a game this season.

PROTECTING THE BALL...

One of Air Force's biggest problems in its loss to UT Martin on Nov. 13 was its inability to hold on to the ball. The Falcons committed 27 turnovers in the contest, matching its season high from 2010-11.

THE STREAK ENDS...

With their win over Lipscomb in the season-opener on Nov. 11, the Falcons broke a 43-game road losing streak that spanned more than three seasons. Air Force's previous road win came on Jan. 23, 2008, versus Colorado State.

A POSITIVE BEGINNING...

For the second straight season, Air Force began the year with a victory. Prior to defeating Lipscomb in their first game of 2010, the Falcons had not won a season opener since 2005.

After averaging just 4.0 minutes in four games during her freshman campaign, Medina played a team-high 37 minutes against Lipscomb in the season-opener. She also recorded a career-best 10 points, seven rebounds and three assists, while hitting the first field goals and first three-pointer of her career.

UP NEXT...

The winner of Wednesday's game between Air Force and San Diego State will move on to Friday's semi-finals, taking on either fourth-seed TCU or fifth-seed Wyoming in the 12:00 p.m. (PT) contest.

**HEAD COACH • SECOND SEASON
(EDINBORO '94)**

Andrea Williams enters her second season as the head coach of the Air Force women's basketball program. Upon her arrival during the summer of 2010, Williams was tasked with turning around a program that had won just seven games in the previous

two seasons combined.

In just one year leading the Falcons, Williams has already helped the program make great strides. Air Force finished the 2010-11 season with a 9-22 overall record, surpassing the team's win total from the previous two seasons combined. In addition, the Falcons posted three regular-season Mountain West Conference victories, marking the team's first conference wins since 2008.

With its win over San Diego State in mid-January, Air Force was able to snap a 40-game losing streak in the Mountain West Conference. Just 10 days later, the Falcons knocked off league-leading TCU, defeating the Horned Frogs for the first time in 23 years. Air Force reached its third conference win, just one shy of a school record, with a home victory over UNLV in its highest-scoring conference game ever.

In addition, the Falcons won just their second Mountain West Conference tournament game in program history, defeating Colorado State, 66-63. It marked the first time during the MWC Championship that the ninth seed had posted a win over the fourth-seeded team.

Under Williams' leadership, Air Force broke numerous program single-season records in the Division I era, including points scored, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and assists. The Falcons won the Mountain West Conference's "Pack the House Challenge," setting a new home attendance record as 2,907 fans watched the Colorado State game on Jan. 25.

Williams arrived at the Academy from the University of South Florida, where she served as an assistant coach for two seasons (2008-10). While at USF, Williams helped lead the Bulls to a pair of WNIT appearances, including a WNIT championship during the 2008-09 campaign. The Bulls finished that year with a 27-10 overall record, including an amazing 19-2 mark in non-conference competition. In addition, USF posted an 8-8 ledger in the ultra-competitive Big East Conference before falling to national champion Connecticut in the quarterfinals of the league tournament.

Meanwhile, the Bulls returned to the postseason in 2010, earning a trip to the WNIT Tournament before ending the year with a 15-16 overall record, which included a win over nationally ranked conference rival Syracuse.

A native of Fort Wayne, Ind., Williams brings a wealth of experience at all levels of the college game. Prior to joining the Bulls, she spent four seasons (2004-08) as an assistant at Jacksonville University, where she helped turn the Dolphins into a power in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Before her arrival at JU, the Dolphins had never recorded a winning season. In addition, the most wins since the program began competition during the 1999-2000 season was 13. However, during Williams' final two seasons at

Jacksonville, the Dolphins recorded a cumulative record of 44-17 and a 25-7 slate in Atlantic Sun competition, while notching a school-record 23 wins in 2007-08.

Williams is also no stranger to the rigors of coaching at a service academy, as she spent two seasons (2002-04) as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the United States Naval Academy. While at Navy, Williams helped the Midshipmen compile 29 wins over the two-year period.

In addition to her coaching responsibilities, Williams was in charge of coordinating Navy's national recruiting efforts, which resulted in an All-Patriot League first-team selection and a Patriot League All-Rookie selection, among others.

Williams also spent three seasons (1999-02) as an assistant coach at the University of Tampa. During her time there, the Spartans enjoyed three consecutive winning seasons, boasting a 55-31 ledger during that span. During the 1999-2000 season, Tampa compiled a 20-10 record, earning the Sunshine State Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Division II Tournament.

Before heading to Tampa, Williams served as the head basketball coach at Waynesburg State (Pa.) for two years (1997-99). During that time, she recruited NCAA leader Christina Nicol, who ranked third in the nation in blocked shots and 25th in scoring en route to Presidents' Athletic Conference accolades. Williams also served as the head coach for cross country and softball at Waynesburg State and was a member of the ECAC South Selection Committee for NCAA Division III.

Williams began her collegiate basketball coaching career at Division II Edinboro University (Pa.) as an assistant from 1995-97. The Fighting Scots won the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference West title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Elite Eight during her second and final season with the program. During that year, she coached the NCAA's rebounding leader (Heather Gates) and recruited the nation's eventual No. 2 scorer (Jessica Rowe).

Williams played two seasons of basketball at Vincennes University (Ind.), followed by two seasons of basketball and one season of softball at Edinboro. She helped lead Edinboro to a pair of NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and captained the squad in her senior season (1993-94).

A 1994 graduate of Edinboro University, Williams earned her bachelor's degree in physical education with a minor in health fitness. She is currently working towards her master's in education. She was also a member of the first graduation class at the Women's Coaches Academy in Bryn Mawr, Pa., in 2004 and is currently a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Black Coaches Association (BCA). In the summer of 2006, Williams was one of 11 female college coaches accepted into the Achieving Coaching Excellence Program by the BCA.
