Chris Gobrecht enters her third season as women's basketball coach at the Air Force Academy in 2017-18. With a track record of 36 years of head coaching experience, Gobrecht has been entrusted by Air Force Director of Athletics Jim Knowlton to lay the foundation and build the program to reach new heights.

Gobrecht was hired April 14, 2015 and is the first hire of Air Force Director of Athletics Jim Knowlton. Gobrecht comes to the Academy from Yale, where she served as head coach from 2005-15.

A proven winner and program builder, Gobrecht has coached at programs in the Pac-12 and Atlantic Coast Conference. During her 10 seasons at Yale she restored the program's status as one of the premier women's basketball programs in the Ivy League. Gobrecht has 35 years of head coaching experience, all at the Division I level, and has a career record of 543-502 which ranks among the nation's top 30 active coaches. Gobrecht is the winningest coach all-time for two schools, Washington and Yale.

Through the first two seasons, Gobrecht has laid the groundwork towards building the program towards new heights. Last season in 2016-17, Air Force doubled its win total from the previous season. The Falcons improved in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots and free throw percentage. Freshman Mariah Forde led the Mountain West freshmen in scoring, averaging 11.0 points per game.

In her first season at Air Force, Gobrecht took over a young and inexperienced team that featured two returning freshmen starters from the previous season.

At Yale, Gobrecht built the program up to become an annual contender for the Ivy League championship over her last six seasons. She coached the Bulldogs to 56 wins from 2012-14 which tied for the second-most wins in a four-year stretch and most since the class of 1980 won 57 games. Under Gobrecht's leadership, Yale has also recorded the top two marks for most Ivy League wins in a four-year span with 34 Ivy victories set by the Class of 2013 and 33 wins set by the Class of 2014.

During her tenure at Yale, Gobrecht coached 27 players that earned Ivy League postseason awards, including two Ivy League Rookies of the Year, five All-Ivy first team honorees, three All-Ivy second team honorees, six All-Ivy honorable mention players, five All-Ivy rookie team players and seven Ivy League academic team honorees. Prior to Gobrecht's arrival at the school, a Bulldog player had not earned All-Ivy League first team accolades since the 1997-98. Gobrecht has also coached two players who competed on the international level.

Yale posted its sixth straight top-four finish in the Ivy League standings in 2014-15 with a 7-7 mark in Ivy play, while posting an overall mark of 13-15. Gobrecht became just the second coach in program history to record 100 victories at Yale with a victory

at Columbia on Jan. 31, 2014. She was 117-162 (.419) in her 10 seasons at the school.

The Bulldogs enjoyed their most successful season under Gobrecht's leadership in 2011-12, finishing with a 16-12 record and an 8-6 mark in Ivy League play in a season that included Yale's first-ever meeting with the nation's top-ranked team (No. 1 Baylor, Nov. 22, 2011). It was their winningest season since a 16-10 finish in 1993-94 and the third straight season with at least eight Ivy League victories. The season included several milestones, including Gobrecht's 500th career victory which happened on Feb. 10, 2012, against Cornell.

In 2010-11, Gobrecht guided the Bulldogs to their first-ever appearance in the Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT). The Bulldogs finished with a 14-15 overall record, which, until 2011-12, was Yale's highest win total since the 2001-02 season (14-13). Gobrecht coached the Bulldogs to the biggest win in program history, a 91-85 win over then-No. 14 Florida State. It was Yale's first win over a nationally ranked opponent in the program's 38-year history. She followed that historic victory by guiding the Bulldogs to a 10-4 finish in Ivy League play, which matched the most wins for Yale in League play (10-4, 1988-89). The 2010-11 Ivy League season included Yale's first sweep of Harvard since the 1993-94 season, which helped the Bulldogs finish in second place in the Ivy League standings for the first time since 1988-89, clinching the Ivy League's automatic berth in the WNIT.

After posting a 3-24 mark in her first season with the Bulldogs, Gobrecht led the team to 12 wins in the 2006-07. The nine-win improvement was one of the best in Division I that season. The 2006-07 season was highlighted by a six-game winning streak and a 15-point victory over a Marist squad that would reach the Regional Semifinals (Sweet 16) of the NCAA Tournament. Yale was also the only Ivy League team to defeat league champion Harvard.

Though the 2008-09 team was hampered by a multitude of injuries, Gobrecht led her team to an 11-17 record and a landmark victory over North Carolina State, Yale's first win over an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent. Gobrecht also reached a milestone 450th career coaching win last season.

Prior to coaching at Yale, Gobrecht was the head coach at her alma mater, Southern California, where she posted a 93-108 record in seven seasons. She became the 33rd active coach to reach the 400-win mark during her time with the Women of Troy. She reached the milestone with a victory over Pepperdine on Dec. 4, 2002. Gobrecht took over a struggling Florida State program in 1996 for year, leading the school to a 5-22 record before going to USC.

Gobrecht coached the University of Washington from 1986-96. In 11 seasons at Washington, her teams went to the NCAA Tournament on nine occasions. The Huskies reached the NCAA

Regional Semifinals four times during her tenure, and advanced to the Regional Finals (Elite Eight) in 1990. She won at least 16 games every year at Washington, including eight 20-win campaigns (six consecutive), and is the Huskies' all-time winningest coach with a 243-89 record. Washington won three conference championships and finished second four times during her tenure. A two-time Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Gobrecht led Washington to a school-record 28 wins and a number-three national ranking in 1989-90. The Huskies were the only team to beat eventual NCAA Champion Stanford that season.

Gobrecht began her Division I coaching career with a struggling Cal State Fullerton program in 1979-80. She coached the Titans for six seasons, posting an 84-92 record. She led Cal State Fullerton to an 18-12 record in her third season on the job. In the 1984-85 season, Gobrecht's last with Cal State Fullerton, the Titans posted a 19-11 record and made their first appearance in the WNIT, making her a finalist for national Coach of the Year honors.

She served as an assistant for a USA Basketball select team that played in Czechoslovakia and Italy in 1990. In addition, six of Gobrecht's former players have played professionally in the WNBA and ABL.

Her coaching career began in 1978 at Santa Fe Springs (Calif.) High School, where her team went 20-4 and made the CIF AAA playoffs. The next year, Gobrecht led Pasadena City College to a 25-5 record, a conference championship and second place in the state junior college tournament.

A Toledo, Ohio, native and a graduate of Huntington Beach (Calif.) High School, Gobrecht earned a bachelor's degree in public affairs from USC in 1977. Then known by her maiden name of Chris Geiger, she was a three-year starter for the Women of Troy from 1974-76 and also played two seasons of volleyball at USC. Last Year

Air Force a 46-40 contest to Utah State in opening round action the 2017 Mountain West Women's Basketball Championship Tournament Monday night at the Thomas & Mack Center in Las Vegas, Nevada.

The game was a hard-fought, back-and-forth battle that came down to the final minute of play. Trailing for most of the game, the Falcons managed to take a lead early in the fourth quarter and tie the game twice, including a 36-36 tie with 3:36 to go.

It was a two point game with 1:10 to play, but the Falcons could manage just one bucket, while Utah State closed with 6-2 run to pull away.

Mariah Forde led Air Force with 14 points. The freshman, who was named to the MW All-Freshman Team earlier in the day, finished the season with 320 points, the second-most ever by an Air Force freshman. Forde hit three three's and went 5-of-6 from the free throw line.

Porter finished with eight points and led the team with 10 rebounds, four assists and three steals. Porter, a junior guard, caps the season as Air Force's Div. I era leader in career assists and steals.

Freshman Kailin Davis and junior Erika Chapman added five points. Junior Dee Bennett added four points, nine rebounds and a team-best two blocked shots. Sophomore Venessannah Itugbu had four points, six rebounds and three steals.

"I thought both teams dug their heels in defensively and made it extremely difficult for one another," Gobrecht said. "The difference in the game--and she was the difference in the game every time we played them--was Antonia (Robinson). The rebound and put-back she had was huge (for Utah State)."

Gobrecht added that although the season is over, she was proud of the team's effort and excited for the future of the program.

"I'm very proud of how my team played," Gobrecht said. "The thing I admire the most about them is their toughness. We lost a lot of key players due to injury, but this team responded and did what they needed to do to compete. We just kept scrapping and clawing and trying to find ways to get it done. The steps we took this year are significant and we have a lot to look forward to in the future."

UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY FACT SHEET

Nominations

Nominations to the academy may be obtained through a congressional sponsor or by meeting eligibility criteria in other categories of competition established by law.

Freshmen

- All new cadets begin with six weeks of basic cadet training (BCT) in their first summer prior to classes.

Summer Training

- Summer training for cadets is divided into three, three-week training periods. There are a variety of programs available, and each cadet is required to complete two training periods each summer with leave during the other period.

- Combat survival training (CST) is a required three-week program during cadets' second summer. For other second-summer training periods, cadets have options such as working with young airmen in an operational unit at an Air Force installation, airborne parachute training, soaring or basic free-fall parachute training.

- During their last two summers, all cadets are offered leadership training as supervisors or instructors in summer programs, such as basic cadet training, survival training, freefall parachuting and soaring.

Graduation

- Each cadet graduates with a bachelor of science degree and a commission as a second lieutenant in the Air Force.

History

In 1948 a board of leading civilian and military educators was appointed to plan the curriculum for an academy that would meet the needs of the newly established Air Force. The board determined that Air Force requirements could not be met by expanding the other service academies and recommended an Air Force academy be established without delay.

In 1949, then Secretary of the Air Force W. Stuart Symington appointed a commission to assist in selecting a site and on April 1, 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower authorized creation of the United States Air Force Academy. After considering 580 sites in 45 states, the commission narrowed the choice to three locations. The summer of 1954, Secretary of the Air Force Harold Talbott selected a site near Colorado Springs, Colo. Colorado contributed \$1 million toward purchase of the property.

In July 1955, the first academy class entered interim facilities at Lowry Air Force Base, Denver, while construction began. It was sufficiently completed for occupancy by the cadet wing in late August 1958. Initial construction cost was \$142 million.

Women entered the academy on June 28, 1976, as members of the class of 1980.



The Honor Code

"We Will Not Lie, Steal Or Cheat, Nor Tolerate Among Us Anyone Who Does"

The Air Force Academy Honor Code was formally adopted in 1956 by the first graduating class, the Class of 1959. It was then, and continues to be today, a minimum standard of conduct which cadets expect of themselves and their fellow cadets.

Cadet Pay

U.S. Air Force Academy cadets earn \$846 a month in basic pay that covers the costs of uniforms, books and supplies, with a modest amount left for personal spending and a savings account.

Air Force Heads to 2018 MW Championship

Air Force women's basketball heads to the 2018 Mountain West Basketball Championships, held March 5-9, at the Thomas & Mack Center in Las Vegas, Nevada. Air Force, playing as the 8-seed, opens play against 9-seed Utah State on Monday, March 5. Free internet video streaming, live audio and stats will be available for every Air Force game.

Last Time Out

Air Force women's basketball hung on to a hard fought 66-60 road win at San José State in Mountain West action Friday night at The SJSU Events Center. The win set a program record for most Mountain West wins in a season for the Falcons and secured an eighth-seed at the upcoming Mountain West Basketball Championship Tournament.

Freshmen Kaelin Immel and Emily Conroe combined for 40 points, including 19 of the teams' 25 points. Immel scored 21 points and set a new program freshman scoring record with 429 points so far this season. Conroe added 19 points, with seven coming in the fourth quarter.

The record-setting night continued with senior Cortney Porter, who scored 11 points and dished out seven assists. Porter set the Air Force Div. I era record with 123 assists on the season.

Air Force controlled the game from the outset, taking the lead two minutes into the game and trailing just three time midway through the third quarter. The Falcons led 20-13 after the first quarter before the Spartans tied it up at 28-28 at halftime.

Air Force went up by as many as six in the third quarter, before SJSU came back to take the lead. The Falcons took back the lead for good on a pair of free throws by Porter, going up 41-40 with 2:55 to play in the third.

The Falcons went up by six early in the fourth, before another Spartan rally cut the lead to one with 6:45 to play. Air Force out-scored SJSU 17-10 the rest of the way to hold on to its second conference road win of the season.

The Falcons cap the regular season with a 5-24 record and 5-13 mark in Mountain West play. The five conference wins are the most in the MW era.

"We've continued to grow as a team all season and I'm very proud of the way we've played at the end of this season," Air Force head coach Chris Gobrecht said. "I'm especially happy for our senior class, who has helped lay the foundation for the success we envision in the future.

"We got big bench play from Kennedy Beale and Jenn Urbaniak and Emily Conroe and Kaelin Immel carried us offensively," Gobrecht added. "Cortney Porter controlled the tempo for us all game and that was important against a team that wants to run like San Jose State. We got to a couple offensive rebounds late and that helped us seal the game."

Falcons Playing Best Basketball Late

After an 0-17 start, Air Force is 5-7 in its last 12 games. Air Force is allowing 12 fewer points and closed the rebounding differential by close to 10 rebounds per game.

Jan. 24 Utah State Recap

Air Force women's basketball defeated Utah State, 57-50, in Mountain West action Wednesday night at Clune Arena. The Falcons captured their first victory of the season, aided by 16 points from Kaelin Immel and 14 by Cortney Porter.

Air Force started slow, trailing 8-7 after the first quarter. A layup from Porter put the Falcons ahead 11-10 with 8:50 to play in the second quarter. Air Force did not trail from that point in the game.

The Falcons led by as many as 13 in the fourth quarter, before Utah State scored a few buckets late. Air Force led by at least six points the entire second half.

The Falcons dominated the boards, with a 42-28 advantage. Air Force was even better on offensive rebounds, holding a 19-8 advantage. Air Force also played staunch defense, forcing 20 turnovers. The Falcons also scrapped their way to a 25-6 advantage in second-chance points.

Immel led all scorers with 16 points, shooting 6 of 11 from the field. Porter just missed out on a double-double with 14 points and nine rebounds. The senior also had four assists and four steals.

Senior Dee Bennett had nine rebounds and junior Venessanna Itugbu had seven points and seven rebounds. Itugbu provided Air Force with determined defense all night, also leading the team with two blocked shots. Senior Erika Chapman added seven points off the bench.

Feb. 24 Utah State Recap

Air Force women's basketball dropped a 57-55 contest at Utah State Saturday afternoon in Mountain West action at Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. Eliza West scored the game-winning bucket with 1.2 seconds left in regulation to lift Utah State to the win.

Air Force rallied back from a 16-point deficit to tie the game up at 55-55 with 6.9 seconds left. Freshman Kailin Immel, who was fouled on a three-point attempt, made all three free throws to tie the game.

On the ensuing possession, West drove in for the bucket to take the lead.

The Falcons had one last shot for the tie or win and got the ball into Immel. Her feet got caught up with a Utah State player and she was forced to throw up a missed off-balance shot. No foul was called and the game ended.

Air Force had a sluggish first-half, trailing 35-21 at the break. Utah State made the first bucket of the second half to go up by 16. Air Force began its comeback by whittling Utah State's lead down to six at the end of the third quarter at 43-37.

After the Falcons pulled to within three with a three from Conroe to start the fourth quarter, the Aggies pushed the lead back up to 10 points at 53-43 with six minutes to play. Air Force locked it down defensively the rest of the game, allowing two free throws and one field goal to Utah State the rest of the game, finishing on a 12-4 run over the final six minutes.

Air Force out-scored Utah State 20-9 in the second quarter to jump ahead 27-17 at halftime. The Falcons extended its lead to 11 after three quarters at 44-33.

Rachel Brewster and Victoria Price combined for 14 points each for Utah State. Hailey Bassett added 10 points.

"We've been doing so many great things (all season) and its nice to get over the hump," Air Force head coach Chris Gobrecht said. "The big difference-maker for us was our offensive rebounding. That was just a back-breaker in that we just kept coming up with those offensive boards. I'm just so happy for the team. We play really good defense, and as long as we play defense like that, we're going to be in every game."

Air Force wore pink uniforms as part of its Pink Game in honor of Breast Cancer awareness.

The one field goal was the game-winner unfortunately.

Freshman Emily Conroe scored a game-high 23 points to lead the Falcons. Conroe was 8 of 13 from the field and 5 of 8 from three-point range. Immel scored 13 of her 15 points in the second half, adding four assists. Senior Erika Chapman was the third Falcon in double-figures, scoring 11 points and grabbing five rebounds.

Senior Cortney Porter, who grew up down the road in Ogden, Utah, played in front of a large contingent of family and friends. Porter led the Falcons with five assists, adding four points and four rebounds.

Olivia West led Utah State with 15 points. Eliza West followed with 14. Shannon Dufficy had 12 rebounds.
