The Air Force women's gymnastics team closes out the regular season on Saturday, March 17, when it travels to Seattle to face Mountain Pacific Sports Federation foe Seattle Pacific. The meet is slated to begin at 2:00 p.m. (PT) inside Brougham Pavilion and tickets are \$7 for adults (\$4 for youth/seniors). Live stats will be available via SPUFalcons.com, while the meet will be streamed live on the SPU YouTube page.

OPPONENT QUICK HITS

Seattle Pacific is ranked fifth in the conference – and 65th in the nation – with a Regional Qualifying Score of 191.665. Darian Burns leads the Falcons with in the MPSF standings with a top-10 ranking on the vault (ninth, 9.730) and a No. 11 listing on the floor exercise (9.765). Seattle Pacific registered its third-highest score of the season last weekend, as it tallied a 192.700 to finish third at Washington's triangular meet.

YOU LOOK FAMILIAR

Air Force is 2-0 against Seattle Pacific so far this season, having faced the opposing Falcons at home and at a neutral site. Air Force earned a 194.275-189.250 victory at the Academy on Feb. 10, before finishing ahead of Seattle Pacific (194.500-192.225) at the San Jose State Quadrangular on March 4.

AIR FORCE IN THE RANKINGS

With a Regional Qualifying Score of 194.100, Air Force is ranked No. 54 in the national rankings – and No. 3 in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation. The Falcons are currently ranked second in the conference on the balance beam (48.670), while holding a No. 3 ranking on the uneven bars (48.670). Individually, Anna Salamone is ranked first on the uneven bars (9.840) and fifth on the vault (9.780), while Analise Howard holds top-10 rankings on the uneven bars (fifth, 9.790) and balance beam (sixth, 9.780). Emily Luers is also listed among the league's top 10 on the balance beam (seventh, 9.775), while Tyler Davis and Casey Bell are ranked sixth (9.825) and eighth (9.780), respectively, on the floor exercise.

FALCONS BREAK 194 FOR FOURTH-STRAIGHT MEET

Air Force matched its third-highest total of the season (194.275) at the Arizona Quadrangular on March 9. It is the fourth-straight meet where Air Force has surpassed the 194-point mark – and the fourth-straight meet where the Falcons have impacted the Top-10 list of scores during Doug Day's coaching tenure.

SALAMONE CLAIMS THIRD MPSF SPECIALIST AWARD OF THE YEAR

Backed by two first-place finishes, two career-best marks and the program's first 9.900 on the uneven bars in 15 years, Anna Salamone was named the MPSF Specialist of the Week on March 6. It is the third time this season – and the fourth of her career – that Salamone has been honored by the conference.

FAST FACT

With three Specialist of the Week awards this year and a Freshman of the Week honor in 2017, Anna Salamone has been honored by the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation four times in a career – a total that is tied for the second-most individual awards in Academy history.

MORE ON SALAMONE'S BIG WEEKEND

Anna Salamone equaled the second-highest uneven bars score in Academy history at the San Jose State Quad on March 4, as she garnered a 9.900 to win the 24-gymnast event – and pace the Falcons to a one-two finish on that apparatus. The first Falcon to account for a 9.900 on the uneven bars since 2003, also posted a career-best 9.850 to win the vault during the March 2 dual meet at UC Davis.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'

Air Force broke the 194-point mark during both meets on March 2-4, including a season-high team score 194.500 – the fourth-highest total of Doug Day's 12-year coaching tenure – at the SJSU Quadrangular.

HOWARD NABS SECOND WEEKLY HONOR

After leading the team with a pair of 9.850 scores at the Air Force Triangular, Analise Howard was named the MPSF Specialist of the Week on Feb. 27 – marking the second time in three weeks that she has been honored by the conference office. With her second award of the season, Howard became the third Air Force gymnast to garner multiple awards from the MPSF this season.

FALCONS NET TOP-FIVE SCORE

Air Force recorded a season-best 194.475 at the Air Force Triangular on Feb. 24 – the fifth-highest total of Doug Day's 12-year tenure at the Academy. It is the sixth time in seven meets that the Falcons have impacted Day's top-40 team total list.

DAVIS COLLECTS A PAIR OF WEEKLY AWARDS

After scoring a career-best 9.900 to win the floor exercise during the Falcons meet against UC Davis on Feb 17, Tyler Davis was named the MPSF Freshman of the Week and the Air Force Cadet-Athlete of the Week on Feb. 20. Davis, who also earned the league's top freshman award following the season opener, became the second Air Force gymnast to garner multiple awards from the MPSF this season.

THE MORE YOU KNOW...

The 9.900 that Tyler Davis recorded on the floor exercise during the Falcons' Feb. 17 meet is tied for the third-highest floor score in Academy history. It is the first score of at least 9.900 on that event in more than 13 years – and just the second 9.900-or-higher score on any event since 2004. Davis, who improved her score by 0.050, paced Air Force to a season-best team score of 48.975 on the floor exercise.

HOWARD NABS WEEKLY CONFERENCE HONOR

Following a conference-leading 9.875 on the beam on Feb. 10, Analise Howard was named the MPSF Specialist of the Week on Feb. 13. The junior, who also earned the league's weekly specialist award last season, improved her beam score by 0.100 points to win the event and lead the Falcons' to a season-high team score of 48.900. Howard also matched her season-high of 9.750 on the uneven bars to help Air Force to its second-highest event total in Academy history (49.000).

FALCONS SHINE IN WIN OVER SEATTLE PACIFIC

Air Force registered the sixth-highest score of Doug Day's tenure (193.275) and captured all 12 podium spots during a home victory over Seattle Pacific (189.250) on Feb. 10. Mariana Murphy and Anna Salamone recorded matching 9.850s to win the uneven bars and pace Air Force to the second-highest event score in program history (49.000), while Salamone/Lauren Miller (vault: 9.700), Analise Howard (beam: 9.875) and Casey Bell (floor: 9.800) rounded out the list of event winners.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Falcons accounted for two new program records on Feb. 6, as Emily Luers became the fifth different Academy gymnast to earn a weekly honor from the MPSF this season and the Falcons nabbed their sixth conference award.

LUERS CAPTURES MPSF SPECIALIST AWARD

Emily Luers was named the MPSF Specialist of the Week on Feb. 6 – three days after scoring a career-best 9.800 on the beam to finish second out of 18 conference gymnasts at the Seawolf Invitational. The junior, who added 0.050 to her previous best, paced the Falcons to a season-high score of 48.575 on that event.

FALCONS WIN SEAWOLF INVITATIONAL

Recording a 193.100 – its second-highest total of the season, Air Force won the team title at the Seawolf Invitational on Feb. 3. The Falcons opened conference action with a perfect 2-0 mark as they edged Sacramento State (193.000) and defeated Alaska (190.125) for the triangular team title. Anna Salamone picked up an event title on the vault (9.775) to lead the Falcons in the individual standings.

SALAMONE NABS SECOND MPSF AWARD OF THE SEASON

For the second time in three weeks, Anna Salamone was named the MPSF Specialist of the Week. The sophomore captured the Jan. 30 award after posting a career-best score of 9.875 to share the uneven bars title and post the Falcons' top finish on the vault (9.725, seventh) at 22nd-ranked BYU on Jan. 26.

SALAMONE CAPTURES CONFERENCE HONOR

Anna Salamone was named the MPSF Specialist of the Week on Jan. 16 after leading the Falcons during the squad's meet at eighth-ranked Denver. The sophomore posted a career-best 9.825 to tie for third on the uneven bars and matched her career-high of 9.775 to tie for the team lead on the vault (sixth).

TRIO SWEEPS SEASON'S FIRST MPSF AWARDS

Mariana Murphy (Gymnast of the Week), Tyler Davis (Freshman of the Week) and Jessica Kirkpatrick (Specialist of the Week) were honored by the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation on Jan. 9, after strong performances in their season-opener with UW-La Crosse. All three captured event titles in the meet - Murphy won the balance beam (9.775) and all-around (38.675), while Davis and Kirkpatrick finished first on the vault (9.750) and uneven bars (9.775), respectively, in their debuts.

FALCONS NET HIGHEST SEASON-OPENING SCORE

Air Force opened the 2018 campaign with a team score of 193.425 – the highest season-opening score of Doug Day's coaching tenure at the Academy. That score improved his previous best season-opening score by more than two points – easily bettering the 191.025 that the 2013 squad scored in their first meet of the year.

CHECKING THE CALENDAR

The Falcons will host five meets inside Cadet West Gym this year, including the MPSF Championships on March 24. The Falcons open the season against UW-La Crosse on Jan. 6, before spending three-straight weekends at home in February (Seattle Pacific on Feb. 10, UC Davis on Feb. 17, New Hampshire/Temple on Feb. 24). Air Force will also visit Denver (Jan. 14), BYU (Jan. 26), Alaska (Feb. 3), UC Davis (Mar. 2), San Jose State (Mar. 4), Arizona (March 9) and Seattle Pacific (Mar. 17), before heading to Texas for the USAG Collegiate Nationals on April 13-15.
