The Air Force volleyball team closes out the 2011 season this week with a pair of non-conference road contests in California. The Falcons will face 18th-ranked Pepperdine at Firestone Fieldhouse in Malibu on Tuesday, Nov. 22, before traveling to Northridge on Friday, Nov. 25, to face Cal State Northridge at The Matadome. Tuesday's match will take place at 7 p.m. (PST), while Friday's contest is scheduled for noon.

It is the regular season finale for Air Force, Pepperdine and Cal State Northridge.

### SCOUTING THE WAVES

Pepperdine is ranked 18th in the Nov. 14 AVCA Coaches Poll and took two victories this past weekend, including a sweep of No. 20 San Diego. The Waves are 21-6 overall on the year, while claiming the West Coast Conference title with a 15-1 record. Six players have at least 100 kills for Pepperdine, with four collecting over 200, two over 300 and one over 400.

### SCOUTING THE MATADORES

Cal State Northridge is 15-13 overall and finished Big West action in third place with a 9-7 mark. The Matadores split the past weekend, falling to UC-Santa Barbara and defeating Cal Poly. Five CSUN players have amassed over 100 kills, with three over 200 and one over 300.

### SERIES HISTORY

Air Force has never faced Pepperdine. The Falcons hold a 1-2 Division II record against Cal State Northridge, but haven't faced the Matadors since 1989.

### TOURNAMENT TALK

Air Force dropped a 3-0 decision to eventual tournament champion Colorado State during the quarterfinal round of the Mountain West Tournament on Nov. 18. Cami Richan paced the Falcons with eight kills, while Victoria Foster added six.

### CAN I LEND A HAND?

With 11 assists in the conference quarterfinal on Nov. 18, Hillary Keltner crossed the 500-assist mark for the Falcons this season. The freshman has led the team in assists during 24 matches, accumulating 508 helpers to date.

### THANK YOU FANS!

Air Force averaged 608 fans during the 2011 season, marking the third-best average in Air Force Division I history. The Falcons totaled 6,683 fans during their 11-match home schedule, which is the second-highest attendance total in program history, trailing only Matt McShane's inaugural season in (7,045 fans).

### HOLT MAKES AN IMPACT

Connecting on seven of 14 swings, without committing a single error, Kristen Holt hit a match-best .500 against San Diego State on Nov. 12. The freshman, one of three Falcons to hit above .200, was the only player on either side of the ball to break even, while attempting at least 10 hits.

### JUST DIGGING AROUND

With her second dig against UNLV, Maiya Perich became the program's Division I leader in single-season digs with 356. Perich broke Tracy Wilkerson's 1999 record of 355, while becoming the first Falcon to set a single-season standard for the program since 2003.

### CAMI'S BIG NIGHT

Cami Richan had a strong night against UNLV on Nov. 10, collecting 14 kills, two aces, seven digs and three solo blocks. Her kills and blocks were team highs, while she matched Emma Dridge for the team high in aces. Her three solo stops marked the best single-block performance of the season.

### FALCONS TAKE FIRST MW SET

With a thrilling 28-26 win over UNLV in the third set of the Nov. 10 match, Air Force snapped a 50-set losing streak. The win is the Falcons' first since defeating South Carolina Upstate 3-1 on Sept. 10.

### MORE NEWS ON THE WIN

The third set win marked just the second time since 2005 that Air Force has taken a set from the Rebels. In fact, it is just the sixth set win in the last decade.

### MIGHTY MAIYA

Maiya Perich became just the fifth Falcon in Division I history to account for over 800 digs in a career, as she recorded her 802nd against Boise State on Nov. 4. Perich, only a junior, has played libero in every match this season after splitting time at the position during her first two seasons.

### ACES WILD

The Falcons tallied seven service aces at Boise State on Nov. 4 for the squad's best single-match performance since early September. Josalynn Wise and Ayesha Hein earned multiple aces against the Broncos, accounting for totals of three and two, respectively. Hillary Keltner and Emma Dridge rounded out the aces with one apiece. The seven-ace output gave the Falcons' 101 aces for the season.

### BLOCK PARTY

The Falcons posted their best blocking total of the season on Oct. 29, collecting two solo blocks and 10 assisted stops at New Mexico. Ayesha Hein paced the Falcons with a season-best matching five blocks (one solo, four assisted), while Claire Bieber (one solo, one assisted) and Lizzy Carpenter (two assisted) each added two. Cami Richan, Kristen Holt and Victoria Foster rounded out the blockers with one each (all assisted).

### TWO FOR TWO (HUNDRED)

Ayesha Hein and Hillary Keltner are currently hitting at least .200 for the Falcons. With 182 kills on 426 attempts, and just 63 errors, Hein currently leads the squad with a .279 hitting percentage, while Keltner moved up to .200 this week following 23 kills on 85 swings with 15 errors.

### PACK THE HOUSE

Air Force has recorded over 1000 fans in attendance during two of its last three matches. A season-high crowd of 1022 fans crowded into East Gym for the Falcons' match with Colorado State – just two matches after 1001 fans saw the Falcons take on Boise State in a televised contest. The 1022 fans is the sixth largest crowd in Division I history and the fourth biggest ever at East Gym. The 2011 team has produced four of the top 11 attendance totals since 1996.

### OH, WHAT A NIGHT!

Cami Richan put down a match-leading 17 kills against Wyoming – matching her career-best output that was first set during a five-set match at Denver on Sept. 1. Accounting for just seven errors on 45 swings, Richan accounted for a .222 hitting percentage – her fourth-highest attacking average of the season. The 17 kills are just two off of the team's best single-match performance (19) of the season.

### WYOMING HIGHS

Against Wyoming on Oct. 20, Air Force recorded 43 kills – its best single-match performance since Sept. 10 – while the combined hitting percentage of .197 (43k-20e-117a) was the Falcons' best since Sept. 16. In addition, Hillary Keltner (20) and Josalynn Wise (17) combined for 37 of the team's 42 helpers – marking the squad's best total since Sept. 10.

**AN OFFENSIVE SURGE**

Maiya Perich, the Falcons' libero, collected her third kill of the season – and second in as many matches – against Wyoming on Oct. 20. The junior defensive specialist also recorded a kill in Air Force's matches against Seattle and at UNLV.

**HIT ME WITH YOUR BEST SHOT**

Hitting at a .385 clip against San Diego State (5k-0e-13a) on Oct. 13, Ayesha Hein recorded a hitting percentage of over .300 for the 12th time in 20 matches this season. Holding a season average of .281 (171k-59e-399a), Hein has hit over .400 in five matches and over .500 in three.

**ALL HANDS IN**

With the exception of the two back row players, every member has gotten a hand on at least one block. The Falcons, who have 10 solo stops and 124 assisted blocks in 65 sets, are led by Ayesha Hein's 42 total blocks (five solo, 37 assisted) and Kristen Holt's 27 total stops (three solo, 24 assisted).

**CAN YOU DIG IT?**

With 287 digs in the first 65 matches of the season, Maiya Perich has blasted past her previous season-best (230 digs in 103 sets during the 2010 season).

**COME ONE, COME ALL**

The gym was jumping on Oct. 8, as 1001 fans packed into Falcon Court at East Gym for the Falcons' match with Boise State. That total is the best of the season for Air Force, as well as the sixth-highest total in the program's Division I history. In the first seven matches of the season, Air Force has recorded three of the top 10 attendance totals in Division I history.

**NOW SERVING...**

Cami Richan collected her 10th service ace of the season against TCU on Oct. 1. She became the fifth Falcon to tally at least 10 service aces on the year, joining Josalynn Wise (13), Ayesha Hein (13), Maiya Perich (12) and Emma Dridge (12).

**MAKING A CONNECTION**

Highlighted by three Falcons posting hitting percentages of at least .200, the Falcons recorded their best single-match hitting average of the conference season against TCU. Bolstered by Ayesha Hein's .333 (7k-3e-12a), Victoria Foster's .243 (16k-7e-37a) and Cami Richan's .200 (12k-4e-40a), Air Force combined for a .179 hitting tally (42k-21e-117a).

**GOING FOR TWO**

Against New Mexico on Sept. 29, Josalynn Wise and Megan Clary became the first Falcons since conference play opened to tally multiple aces in a match, as they both recorded two aces during the match.

**THE SWING SET**

Cami Richan hit a season-best .345 against Wyoming on Sept. 24. The sophomore accounted for 10 kills on 29 swings, while committing no errors. It is tied for the sixth-best hitting performance of the season ... and the only in the top 10 without an attacking error.

**HEIN NAMED TO ALL-TOURNEY TEAM**

For the fourth straight week, Ayesha Hein was named to an all-tourney team, claiming honors at the Aggie Invitational. Over three matches, Hein recorded 27 kills and a .279 hitting percentage. She also added three digs and six total blocks, including one solo stop. She posted double-figures in kills during both the Seattle (11) and Hofstra (10) matches, while hitting a match-best .450 (10k-1e-20a) against Hofstra.

**FALCONS HIT AT A SEASON-BEST .302 CLIP**

Air force hit a season-best .302 on Sept. 16, connecting on 42 of 96 attempts and committing just 13 errors. Kristen Holt paced the Falcons with a season-best .600 hitting percentage, accounting for six kills on 10 attempts and no errors. Megan Clary (.333, 5k-1e-12a) and Ayesha Hein (.318, 11k-4e-22a) each hit over .300 on the day. Both defensive specialists – Emma Dridge and Maiya Perich – went a perfect one-for-one, recording their first kills of the season.

**MORE ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS**

Ayesha Hein was named to the all-tournament team of the Falcon Invitational – marking the third straight week that the freshman has earned all-tourney honors. She paced the Falcons in kills against SC Upstate (19) and Northern Arizona (10), while hitting a team-leading .571 (19K-3e-28a) against the Spartans and a .533 (9k-1e-15a) against Utah Valley. She also added three service aces, six digs and seven total blocks.

**COMING TOGETHER**

Against SC Upstate, the Falcons hit a season-best .293, connecting on 61 of 140 attempts with 20 errors. Highlighting the outing was a .423 performance in the second set (16k-5e-26a), while Air Force hit over .300 in all three of its winning sets (.378 in the first, .306 in the fourth).

**MORE AWARDS FOR THE FALCONS**

Maiya Perich was voted as the Best Libero of the Denver Invitational by the tournament coaches and Ayesha Hein was also selected to the all-tournament team. It is the second straight week that the pair has earned all-tournament honors. In addition, Perich was selected as the USAFA Athlete of the Week.

**MEET THE ALL-TOURNEY FALCONS**

Maiya Perich dug 70 balls over the weekend, led all players in digs during all three Air Force contests and successfully converted 104 of 110 serves. Ayesha Hein recorded 37 kills and eight total blocks over the three-match weekend, highlighted by a hitting clip of .500 (15k-1e-28a) in the Falcons' win over Bryant.

**EQUAL MEASURES**

Cami Richan and Ayesha Hein combined for 30 kills as Air Force defeated Bryant in four sets (Sept. 2). Hein hit a team-best .500 during the match, connecting on 15 of 28 attempts, while committing just one error.

**CAN YOU DIG IT?**

Maiya Perich set a new Air Force Division I single-match record on Sept. 1, as she accounted for 36 digs in the Falcons' 3-2 loss to Denver. Perich, who easily broke the program's old record of 29, was one of three Falcons to tally double-digit dig totals as the squad combined for a season-best 80 total digs.

**GOOD COMPANY**

As the Division I single-match record-holder, Maiya Perich is in good company. Current assistant coach Louella Maxwell holds the program's all-time and Division II record with 45 digs in a match in 1993.

**COLLECTING A WIN**

On Aug. 30, Air Force collected its first set win over Northern Colorado (25-21) since 2004.

**IT'S OFFICIAL...**

Air Force entered the season as one of the youngest teams in the country, as 92.3% of its roster was made up of freshmen and sophomores. The Falcons and Buffalo were the only two programs in the nation to feature a roster with at least 83% of its team in either their first or second-year of competition.

**TAKING HOME THE HARDWARE**

Ayesha Hein and Maiya Perich were named to the all-tournament team of the Kristen Dickmann Invitational. Perich posted a team-leading 26 digs, while adding a pair of service aces. Hein had a stellar debut weekend for the Blue and Silver, accounting for a team-leading 26 kills, .333 hitting percentage, seven service aces and five total blocks. Hein was also selected as the Academy's Athlete of the Week.

**STAT FACT**

In three matches, the Falcons accounted for 25 aces. That was one-fourth of the total number of aces that Air Force recorded all of last year (104).

**DID YOU KNOW?**

Air Force is now 9-1 all-time against Navy.

**OPENING WEEKEND RECAP**

The Falcons went 1-2 to open the 2011 season, falling to Bowling Green (0-3) and St. John's (0-3), before sweeping Navy in straight sets.

**LONE STAR STATE OF MIND**

Over half of the Falcons' 13-player roster hails from the state of Texas. Casey Boyle (Dallas), Lizzy Carpenter (Murphy), Megan Clary (Sunnyvale), Emma Dridge (Allen), Victoria Foster (El Paso), Maiya Perich (Houston) and Josalynn Wise (Amarillo) all call Texas home.

**LEADING THE WAY**

Junior Maiya Perich and sophomore Claire Bieber were selected as co-captains of the 2011 squad. It is the first time since 2008 that two teammates have shared the captaincy duties.
