**PREVIOUS WEEK:** The Orlando Predators (6-3) defeated the Arizona Rattlers (15-3) at home by a final score of 56-50 on Saturday, July 26th. Orlando won the South Division Championship and is the No. 2 seed in the American Conference playoffs.

The Pittsburgh Power (15-3) defeated the Philadelphia Soul (9-9) at home by a final score of 64-34 on Saturday, July 26th. Pittsburgh finished with the best overall record of all wildcard contenders and is the No. 3 seed in the American Conference playoffs.

**THE SERIES:** This match up marks the second meeting between the two teams this season, as Pittsburgh defeated Orlando in Week 11 by a final score of 62-61. This will be the fourth meeting between Predators Head Coach **ROB KEEFE** and Pittsburgh Head Coach **RON JAMES** (James leads 2-1).

**LAST WEEK:****Predators Close Out Regular Season  
with 56-50 Victory over Arizona**

**ORLANDO, FL** – The Orlando Predators (11-7) made a statement in the team's regular season finale, earning a spectacular 56-50 victory over the defending ArenaBowl Champion Arizona Rattlers (15-3) in front of a sold out crowd of 8,550 at CFE Arena on Saturday evening. The win marks just the second time in the last 11 seasons the Predators have finished the regular season with 11 or more victories.

Trailing 50-48 late in the fourth quarter, QB Bernard Morris dropped back to pass lofted a completion over the middle to WR Larry Brackins. With the reception secured, Brackins eluded defenders and cut back across the field before barreling through defenders on his way to a 30-yard touchdown. Orlando successfully recovered an onside attempt on the ensuing kickoff and proceeded to run out the clock to seal the win.

Morris finished the night throwing for 284 yards and six touchdowns while adding 28 yards and another score on the ground. Brackins hauled in seven passes for 104 yards and three scores, while WR Khalil Paden led all receivers with 137 yards and two touchdowns on five catches.

The offense fired out of the gates with a quick score as WR Khalil Paden beat a defender deep for a 42-yard touchdown reception on the second play from scrimmage. Arizona QB Nick Davila connected with WR Tysson Poots on two first quarter scores, but Orlando managed to build a 21-14 lead at the conclusion of the opening stanza. Bernard Morris carried the ball for a one-yard score and tossed a pass over the middle to Brackins, who secured the catch and raced 24 yards up the middle of the field for the touchdown.

Arizona regained possession to start the second quarter and managed to drive the ball to the goal line before Orlando's defense swiftly halted the series. Facing 1st-&-Goal, Davila attempt to take a shot to the end zone, but had the pass deflected at the line of scrimmage. The loose ball bounced off the nets and newly-acquired Predators DL Meshak Williams came down with the rebound to complete the interception. Morris swiftly converted the turnover into points, as he launched a 41-yard touchdown pass to Khalil Paden. Davila found WR Rod Windsor on a 23-yard score on the following drive, but WR Larry Brackins took another short completion and turned it into a 27-yard touchdown. Arizona managed to score on a two-yard throw at the end of the quarter, give Orlando a 35-28 advantage at the midway point.

The Rattlers tied the game 35-35 at the start of the third quarter, as Davila found WR Kerry Reed from 11 yards out. Orlando would respond by building a two-score lead, beginning with a touchdown reception by WR Kendal Thompkins, who broke through a tackle before sprinting 21 yards to the end zone. Two plays later, DB Tracy Belton picked off a pass attempt by Davila and raced up the right sideline for a 15-yard score to put Orlando ahead, 48-35.

Arizona would rally from that point, posting four unanswered scores to take a 50-48 lead before Brackins put Orlando up for good.

**LAST MEETING:****Predators Drop Last-Moment  
Thriller to Pittsburgh, 62-61**

**ORLANDO, FL** – The Orlando Predators (6-4) dropped a 62-61 decision to the Pittsburgh Power (7-3) in a matchup that came down to the game's final seconds. Despite the narrow loss, Orlando remains in first place in the South Division of the Arena Football League's American Conference.

With the game tied 48-48 midway through the final quarter of play, QB Tommy Grady took to the field with the Pittsburgh offense. On the first snap of the Power drive, Grady's pass attempt bounced off the hands of his receiver and into the arms of Predators DB Tracy Belton. After securing the interception, Belton raced eight yards up the right sideline to the end zone for the score to give Orlando a 55-48 lead.

Pittsburgh managed to tie the game on the ensuing series, as Grady fired a 19-yard completion over the middle to WR Hank Edwards for the touchdown. Needing just one play to answer, WR Greg Carr turned a short completion into a long gain. On the next play from scrimmage, Carr secured a pass over the middle and raced 45 yards to the end zone, outrunning trailing defenders. However, Orlando would only gain a six point advantage following a failed PAT attempt.

With just over a minute remaining in the game, the Power regained possession and proceeded to milk the clock with a nine-play, 48-yard drive. Facing second-and-goal from the four-yard line, Grady connected with Edwards in the end zone from four yards out to tie the game, 61-61. Following the score, Edwards was flagged for unsportsmanlike conduct due to excessive celebration, resulting in a 10-yard penalty and long PAT attempt. However, Power K Julian Rauch managed to boot the deep kick through the uprights to seal the 62-61 defeat.

QB Bernard Morris scored eight total touchdowns on the night, as he threw for 230 yards with five scores and added 41 yards with three more touchdowns on the ground. WR Greg Carr hauled in seven receptions for 113 yards and three touchdowns, while WR Larry Brackins contributed 83 yards and two scores on five catches.



## THE COACHES:

### **Orlando – Rob Keefe, Head Coach (3rd AFL season, 1st w/ORL) 33-19 (.635) Regular Season, 36-20 (.643) Overall**

Defined by his energy, excitement, and overall passion for the game, Rob Keefe is well known for his hands-on approach to coaching. With four championship titles to his credit, Keefe brings a tradition of winning to the Orlando Predators.

Rob Keefe arrives in Orlando after serving as the Defensive Coordinator of the Utah Blaze the past two seasons. He arrived in Utah midway through the 2012 season and engineered a dramatic turnaround on that side of the ball. After allowing an average of 64 points over the first 10 games of the season, Utah allowed just over 51 points per contest under Keefe. In the opening round of the 2012 playoffs, the change in culture was loudly put on display as the Blaze defense surrendered a mere 34 points in a victory over the top-seeded San Antonio Talons.

Keefe began his coaching career in 2009, joining the Spokane Shock as the secondary coach. The Shock boasted the af2's top-ranked scoring defense that season, allowing just 37.6 points per game. Keefe's secondary surrendered the fifth-lowest number of passing yards per game (231.6) and registered the second-highest interception total in the league (34). The season culminated in an ArenaCup Championship title.

Keefe was promoted to Head Coach of the Shock when the organization joined the Arena Football League in 2010. Under Keefe's guidance, Spokane finished with the best record in the AFL (13-3 regular season) while producing the League's fourth-ranked scoring defense (52.7 ppg). Keefe became the youngest coach in AFL history to win a championship, as the Shock defeated the Tampa Bay Storm in ArenaBowl XXIII.

After a standout playing career at Mercyhurst College (Erie, PA), Keefe entered Arena Football in 2004 with the Columbus WarDogs of the af2. He joined the Spokane Shock (then af2) for the club's inaugural season in 2006, helping the franchise secure its first ArenaCup Championship. Keefe ended his two-year tenure with the Shock as the team's career leader in tackles (168) and interceptions (19), twice earning all-af2 accolades as a defensive back.

In 2008, Keefe entered the AFL as a member of the Philadelphia Soul. In his only AFL season as a player, Keefe helped the Soul earn a victory over the San Jose SaberCats in ArenaBowl XXII.

### **Pittsburgh – Ron James (7th AFL Season 1st w/PITT) 57-52 (.523) Regular Season, 58-53 (.522) Overall**

Ron James was named the third head coach in Pittsburgh Power history on March 21, 2014. He joined the team just one game into the Power's 2014 season.

James has compiled a 42-50 record in the regular season during his seven-year head coaching career. Prior to coming to Pittsburgh, James spent the past four years as the head coach of the Utah Blaze where in 2012 he was named the Arena Football League Coach of the Year.

The 29-year coaching veteran got his start in the League as an assistant coach for the Albany Firebirds in 1990. He later joined the staff of the Houston ThunderBears in 1999, serving as the Director of Player Personnel and coaching the offensive and defensive lines.

From 2002-04, James was the assistant head coach for the Las Vegas Gladiators coaching both the offensive and defensive lines and the special teams unit. In 2005, he was promoted to head coach of the Gladiators. That year the team led the AFL in total offense and total defense. With James at the helm, the Gladiators broke 14 team records, including new franchise season-highs for passing yards (4,664) and total yards (4,996).

James began his time with the Utah Blaze in 2007, coaching the offensive and defensive lines. After a dismal 1-6 start in 2010, he was promoted to head coach. It was under his leadership that the Blaze quickly became one of the AFL's elite teams. In 2012, Utah produced the most successful season in franchise history with a 12-6 record.

## STORYLINES:

During the 2012 and 2013 seasons, Orlando Predators Head Coach **ROB KEEFE** served as the Defensive Coordinator of the Utah Blaze under then-Head Coach **RON JAMES**.

Predators **QB JASON BOLTUS** and Power **QB TOMMY GRADY** played together as members of the Utah in 2013. Boltus opened the season as Grady's backup, but started five games on the year.

Several current players on the Pittsburgh Power roster played for Predators Head Coach **ROB KEEFE** and Pittsburgh Head Coach **RON JAMES** during the 2012 or 2013 seasons with the Utah Blaze, including **QB TOMMY GRADY**, **WR SHAUN KAULEINAMOKU**, **WR AARON LESUE**, **DB AL PHILLIPS**, and **OL ANTONIO NARCISSE**.

Several current players on the Pittsburgh Power roster played under former Head Coach **ROB KEEFE** with the Spokane Shock, including **DB VIRGIL GRAY**, **DB SERGIO GILLIAM** and **WR SHAUN KAULEINAMOKU**.

In 2013, current Orlando Predators Offensive Coordinator **SIAHA BURLEY** served as the OC for the Chicago Rush, while current Line Coach **STEVE EDWARDS** served as a starting offensive lineman for the team. The 2013 Chicago Rush roster included current Pittsburgh Power players **DL ANTHONY HOKE**, **WR RODNEY WRIGHT** and **OL COLIN MADISON**.

Orlando Predators **QB BERNARD MORRIS** played for the Pittsburgh Power during the franchise's inaugural season in 2011. Morris completed 216-of-345 pass attempts for 2,428 yards with 55 touchdowns and nine interceptions while adding 312 yards and four scores on 46 rushing attempts. Pittsburgh registered a 9-9 record.

Pittsburgh Power **WR PRECHAE RODRIGUEZ** played for the Orlando Predators in 2013. Rodriguez registered 119 receptions for 1,614 yards with 41 touchdowns while adding two yards and one score on two rushing attempts. Orlando traded Rodriguez to Pittsburgh prior to the start of the 2014 season.

**PREDATORS PLAYERS TO WATCH:**

**QB BERNARD MORRIS** – Despite playing in only nine games, Morris led the AFL with an average of 274.9 yards in total offense and 31.4 rushing yards per game. Defined by his efficiency, Morris also led the League in passing yards per completion (14.0) and passing yards per attempt (9.1) while placing second in passer rating (123.1). Morris threw for 2,191 yards and 47 touchdowns while adding 283 yards and 12 scores on the ground.

**WR GREG CARR** – Greg Carr led rookie receivers in all receiving categories in 2014. He totaled 113 receptions for 1,435 yards and 36 touchdowns, finishing eighth in receptions and receiving yards and seventh in receiving touchdowns.

**WR KHALIL PADEN** – Paden averaged 17.3 yards per reception in 2014 – a mark that ranked first in the AFL this season and sixth in AFL history. In total, the rookie registered 81 receptions for 1,402 yards and 23 touchdowns.

**POWER PLAYERS TO WATCH:**

**QB TOMMY GRADY** – In 2012, Grady earned AFL MVP and Offensive Player of the Year accolades after setting regular season League records with 5,870 passing yards and 142 touchdown passes. Grady threw for 4,717 yards with 115 scores this season.

**WR PRECHAE RODRIGUEZ** – Despite playing in only 10 games, Rodriguez led the AFL in scoring with an average of 19.2 points per game. Rodriguez totaled 85 receptions for 1,138 yards and 32 touchdowns.

**FB VIRGIL GRAY** – Gray played in just 11 games, but led the AFL with an average of 1.00 interceptions per game. He gained 297 yards with two touchdowns on those interceptions while adding 23 pass breakups.
