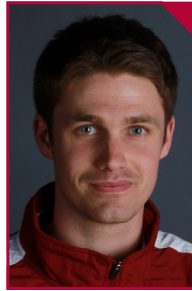

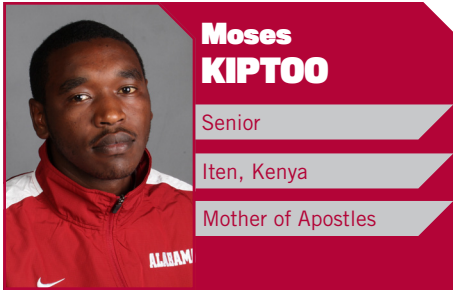

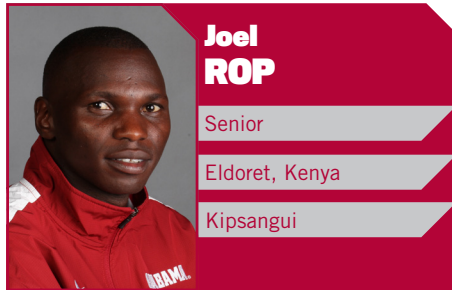

"The women ran a good team race with all five finishing within a few seconds of each other," UA head coach Dan Waters said. "It was a nice solid, technical race where they ran well as a unit. This gives us a good spot to move forward from."

The University of Alabama men's and women's cross country teams showed considerable improvement in their second race of the season as the women won the Commodore Classic while the men finished second at Nashville's Percy Ward Park.

The women's team won by virtue of five top-20 finishes to edge Lipscomb on the 5-kilometer course. Katlyn Will led the Crimson Tide again with a season-best time of 18:09.10 to finish fourth overall. Andrea Torske followed in eighth at 18:20.30 while Leigh Gilmore came in 10th with a 18:21.50 finish. Both shaved approximately 10 seconds off their season opening times.

"Today was a total team effort in that we ran as a pack through the field really well," UA head coach Dan Waters said of his victorious women's team. "They started conservatively, which the coaches asked them to do, and then picked off the last couple of teams in the final mile to finish very strong. I'm extremely pleased with the great, tactical cross country running we displayed as a team."

The Tide's scoring on the women's side was rounded out by Sarah Gilmore (18:29.80) and Kelsey Johnson (18:35.50) in 13th and 15th, respectively. Three of UA's reserves, Claire Turner, Palee Myrex and Aubrielle Wright, all showed improvement with the trio recording personal bests.

The men's team finished just 10 points behind Cincinnati to take second-place in the 8-kilometer race with a pair of UA runners finishing in the top 10.

Carison Kemei again led the Tide with a second-place finish in 24:35.90 to best his season-opening time by two seconds. In his second race of the season, Joel Rop showed considerable improvement to finish ninth with a time of 25:32.30.

"This was a much better performance for the men," Waters said. "The goals for the meet were reached in terms of establishing consistency and we definitely had great improvements from the first race. I can't say enough about Carison and the fitness he's shown. Plus everyone else is coming along nicely."

The Tide's British newcomers, Gary Bradbury and Oliver Blake finished 21st and 26th with times of 26:00.10 and 26:19.50, respectively. Austin Duckworth was the final finisher came across the line in 30th with a time of 26:23.40.

"Both teams accomplished what we wanted to in terms of establishing a consistency of effort," Waters said. "Now it's back to training and building momentum going into our next meet at Louisville."

The University of Alabama men's and women's cross country teams continued their season with strong individual performances at the Greater Louisville Classic on Saturday morning with 11 season bests posted between the two teams.

The women's team finished sixth overall in the 30-team field with four of all five of its scorers running season bests and two runners notching career bests. The men's team came in 19th in its 29-team race but only ran five runners as two of its top runners, Carison Kemei and Oliver Blake, were held out of the race with nagging injuries to allow them recover.

The Crimson Tide women's team was paced by Leigh Gilmore's season best finish of 17:45.74 on the 5-kilometer course at E.P. Tom Sawyer Park to finish 33rd. Katlyn Will and Andrea Torske followed in 44th and 48th with season best times of 17:54.82 and 18:02.40, respectively.

"We had some good performances from the women's team but made a few tactical errors early in the race," UA head coach Dan Waters said. "With the size of the field it was hard to recover from those, but the team did a good job of fighting back through it to finish sixth. We learned a lot from this race that we can improve on in the coming weeks."

Sarah Gilmore and Kelsey Johnson were the final two scorers for UA, coming in 54th and 70th out of the 262 runners in the huge field. Gilmore posted a personal best of 18:05.50 while Johnson crossed 18:13.37.

Without the benefit of two of its top runners, the men's team had difficulties scoring, but all five of its competitors posted season bests and four of the five ran the fastest 8-kilometer time of their careers.

"There were some good performances overall that aren't indicated in the team results," Waters said of his men's team. "Nathan Corder, Austin Duckworth, Gary Bradbury and Matt Joyner all did awesome jobs with PRs. They did a good job of competing and put themselves in good tactical position and I'm very pleased with that."

Joel Rop was the men's top finisher in 37th with a season-best time of 24:50.60 followed by Gary Bradbury in 46th at 24:55.86. Duckworth, Corder and Joyner followed with their personal bests finishing an 117th, 131st, and 153rd, respectively.

"Our point total will get drastically better when we add two of our top guys back into the fold at the Crimson Classic," Waters said. "This race was definitely a good experience and I think we all learned a lot that we can take heading into our next competition."

Purdue took top honors in the men's race while Louisville's Tyler Byrne won the race in 23:47.12. Michigan won the women's race, followed by Ferris State, Mississippi, Purdue and South Florida. Eastern Kentucky's Lydia Kosgei had the top 5-kilometer time at 16:51.12.

The University of Alabama women's cross country team defended its home course and won Crimson Classic while the men finished fifth behind individual champion Carison Kemei at the Harry Pritchett Running Course Saturday morning.

"It was great to see the women come out and win at home," UA head coach Dan Waters said. "We can hopefully build off of that and improve in a few areas heading into the SEC Championships. On the men's side, we're not deep enough right now to score well if someone has an off day, but Carison Kemei, Joel Rop and Gary Bradbury all competed well for us."

The women's team secured first place with five top-25 finishes to beat Mississippi by three points on the 5-kilometer course. Leigh Gilmore led the way for the Crimson Tide with a time of 17:51.95 to finish ninth overall. "This is huge for us to run this well as a team," Gilmore added. "If we can keep this confidence going into the SEC meet, then I think we can have a good finish at SECs and run with the top teams in the league."

The men's squad finished fifth overall in the 21-team field with only six Alabama runners competing in the 8-kilometer race. Georgia Tech took home first place in the men's race with two of their runners placing in the top 10.

Carison Kemei returned to action in a big way as he finished first overall in the men's race with a time of 24:49.25. Joel Rop was not too far behind as he came in seventh overall with a time of 25:21.47. Gary Bradbury, Nathan Corder and freshman Matt Joyner followed Rop by placing 13th, 49th and 72nd overall, respectively. Oliver Blake was held out of his second straight race due to injury.

"My race today was good after missing two weeks with injury," Kemei said. This race was my trial to see where I was at. My aim to do well and help my teammates along. The last mile I was trying to push and see how my body responded after not competing so it was good to see I could finish that strongly."

Harry Pritchett Running Course

The University of Alabama men's and women's cross country teams ended their 2011 season at the NCAA South Region Championships Saturday morning at Harry Pritchett Running Course Saturday in Tuscaloosa, Ala.

The women's team finished sixth overall in the 6-kilometer race with Leigh Gilmore leading the way for the Tide with a 32nd place finish in 21:39.2. Andrea Torske and Sarah Gilmore followed in the 39th and 50th position with times of 21:50.5 and 22:02.0, respectively. Kelsey Johnson and Katlyn Will were the final two scorers for the women's squad.

"For the women, they fixed their tactical errors from the SEC meet so the results were much better," UA head coach Dan Waters said. "We are very happy with the way they competed and this is all part of a long process of getting better going forward."

The Alabama men secured an 18th place finish in the 10-kilometer race as senior Joel Rop led the way for the Crimson Tide with a time of 32:09.4 to finish 28th overall. Senior Gary Bradbury followed Rop in 76th place at 33:29.3 while Nathan Corder ended up right behind him with a time of 33:43.6. Matt Joyner (34:24.8) and Austin Duckworth (34:24.7) rounded out the men's scoring by coming 114th and 125th, respectively.

"The men's team has struggled with injuries most of the year and the guys that ran out there today ran a tough, hard race," Waters said. "I'm very proud of what they did. Joel Rop was our lead finisher and it was his last race in an Alabama uniform. I'm proud of that, his commitment to the program and what he's done for us."

In the overall team results, Florida State finished in first place with Florida following in a close second on the men's side to advance both teams to the NCAA Championships in Terre Haute, Ind. The top two women's teams that automatically qualified for the NCAA Championships were Florida State and Vanderbilt.

Florida State also claimed both individual titles as David Forrester won the men's race in 30:43.3 while Amanda Winslow finished in 20:33.4 to win the women's race. The Seminoles finished 1-2-3 in the women's race and had three in the top five of the men's field.
