

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

How to Enroll

Mail completed application and deposit of \$200 for premier and advanced camps (\$50 for days camps), or may send the entire camp fee at once. The balance is due by May 1, 2008. If applying after May 1, 2008, send full payment. **You may also register online by going to www.uabsoccercamp.com.** There is a \$15 fee added when registering online. Those who cannot attend camp for medical or other reasons will be refunded all but a \$50 handling fee for day camp or \$100 handling fee for residential/commuter camp. **To receive a refund** the camp office must be notified at least 72 hours before registration on Sunday. **Enrollment is limited and applications will be accepted on a "First Come, First Served" basis, so apply early.**

Camp Ball

Each camper must have a soccer ball at camp. Bring your own ball or purchase a hand-stitched ball from the camp for \$25 paid in advance. Please mark the appropriate box on the application.

Camp Insurance

The Mike Getman Soccer Camp carries secondary medical insurance. Parents are expected to provide primary medical insurance for their child.

Roommates for Residential Campers

Residential campers will be housed in 2 bedroom, 2 bathroom suites, with 2 beds in each bedroom. You may specify in your request, one roommate and up to two suitemates.

Check In / Check out for Premier and Advanced Camps

Camp registration is between 1:00 and 2:30 pm on Sunday, with the first training session at 3:30 pm. Camp ends on Thursday following the closing ceremonies at approximately 12:00 pm.
