## How to Enroll

Mail completed application and deposit of \$200 for Residential and Commuter Camps (\$50 for Days Camps), or you may send the entire camp fee at once. The balance is due by May 1. If applying after May 1, send full payment. **You may also register online by going to WWW.UABSOCERCAMP.COM.** There is a \$15 fee added when registering online. Those who cannot attend camp for medical or other reasons will be refunded all but a \$50 handling fee for Day Camp or \$100 handling fee for residential/commuter camp. **To receive a refund** the camp office must be notified at least 72 hours before registration on Sunday. **Enrollment is limited, so please apply early.** **Team Camp** -Please see the website for information about how to enroll and for a Team Reservation Form.

## Camp Ball

Each camper must have a soccer ball at camp. Bring your own ball or purchase a hand-stitched ball from the camp for \$25 paid in advance. Please mark the appropriate box on the application.

## Camp Insurance
