Looking Ahead to 2011-12

UAB is looking to build on last season's strong finish that saw the Blazers win four straight postseason games to claim the Women's Basketball Invitational championship. UAB closed the 2010-11 campaign with a 20-15 record, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2000-01. The Blazers won 11 of their final 15 games a season ago.

WBI CHAMPIONS

UAB was selected to compete in the 2011 Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) and rattled off four consecutive postseason wins to claim the tournament title. The Blazers went on the road for the first three rounds, posting wins at Central Arkansas (58-54), at Elon (59-50) and at Manhattan (62-43) before returning home to defeat Cal State Bakersfield (68-60) in the tournament's championship game. Guard Amber Jones, who averaged 17.5 points over the four games, was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

A LOT COMING BACK

The Blazers' 2011-12 roster is marked by a high level of continuity from last year. UAB returns 10 players, including nine letterwinners, and adds just two newcomers. Five of those returning players started at least 14 games last season,

led by center Meagan Brown with 35 starts and guard Khalilah Watson with 31.

JONES LOOKING FOR MORE

Amber Jones is the leading returning scorer for UAB after averaging 12.5 points per game last year as a sophomore. Jones developed into the Blazers' top scorer down the stretch in 2010-11, raising her average to 15.3 points per game over the final 13 contests. The guard was even more productive over the final six games, averaging 17.5 points and shooting 42 percent from the three-point line. She finished the season with 27 double-digit scoring performances and topped the Blazers in scoring in 13 games.

FROSH SENSATION NOW SOPH

The Blazers also welcome back 2010-11 C-USA All-Freshman Team selection Karisma Chapman. The forward didn't score 10 points in a game until late January last season but then closed the year with 10 double-digit scoring performances in the last 17 games. She averaged 10.8 points per game over that stretch and closed the year with an average of 8.0 points to go along with a pair of double-doubles.

DOMINATING DEFENSE

UAB is coming off one of the best defensive seasons in Conference USA history. In fact, the Blazers' 55.3 points allowed per game last season set a school record and broke the league record by a full point. UAB's 56.1 points allowed in Conference USA games also set a league record. The Blazers finished the season ranked 25th in the nation in scoring defense.

SPEAKING OF DEFENSE

UAB held its opponents to 50 points or fewer 13 times last season and won 12 of those contests. UAB also was 18-7 when holding its opponents to fewer than 60 points. The Blazers held Tulsa to 36 points on Feb. 10, marking the lowest output for a UAB opponent since South Alabama scored just 31 points, the fewest for an opponent in program history, on Nov. 24, 1996.

BLOCK PARTY

Another reason for UAB's defensive success was its ability to alter shots in the paint. The Blazers' averaged 3.3 blocked shots per game last season, the second-most in school history, and came up just shy of the school record of 3.4 set in the 1998-99 season. Meagan Brown led the team with 49 total blocks, while Karisma Chapman added 23. UAB posted a school-record 11 blocked shots against Tulsa on Feb. 10.

FORCING TURNOVERS

The Blazers forced their opponents into double-digit turnovers in all 35 games last season and have accomplished that feat in 123 consecutive games entering the 2011-12 campaign. The last time a UAB opponent turned the ball over fewer than 10 times was Hartford (8) on Nov. 23, 2007. The 30 turnovers UAB forced against Marshall last season on Jan. 30 were the most in C-USA last year and the most by a UAB team since the 1994 season. The Blazers forced 115 more turnovers than they committed (644-529) in 2010-11.

100 WINS UNDER HER BELT

Head coach Audra Smith earned her 100th career victory with UAB's 62-43 win over Manhattan in the semifinals of the WBI last year on March 24. With the win, Smith joined Jeannie Milling as the only other UAB women's basketball head coach to reach the milestone. Milling spent 17 seasons at the helm of the Blazers and compiled a 265-230 record. Smith took over for Milling in 2004 and has spent her entire head coaching career (seven seasons) with the Blazers. She added another win in the WBI championship game and enters the 2011-12 season with 101 career victories.

REPLACING PETEY

The Blazers will have to find a way to replace the scoring and outside shooting of departed senior Amanda Peterson, who finished her career with 319 three-pointers, the most by any woman or man in UAB history. Peterson, who averaged 10.8 points per game last year, set a school and league record with 103 3-pointers in her senior campaign.

TOPS IN TRIPLES

Led by Amanda Peterson's success from beyond the arc last season, it's no surprise UAB topped C-USA in 3-pointers per game. The Blazers averaged a league-leading 6.2 treys per contest, knocking down a total of 216 for the season, the second-most in UAB history and just three shy of the 2006-07 school-record total of 219. The Blazers matched a single-game school record with 14 treys against Manhattan on March 24 in the WBI semifinals.

BLAZERS ADD PAIR OF JUCO TRANSFERS

Both of UAB's newcomers this year come from the junior college ranks. Guard Kelsie Weynand joins the Blazers after an all-region sophomore season at St. Petersburg (Fla.) College, where she averaged 13.4 points per game last year. She played her freshman season two years ago at Columbus State in Georgia. Forward Michaelea Kleist comes to UAB from Volunteer State (Tenn.) Community College, where she averaged 11.4 points and 6.9 rebounds per game last year. Kleist began her collegiate career at Eastern Kentucky in 2009-10.

SHAW READY FOR FIRST SEASON IN UAB UNIFORM

After sitting out the 2010-11 season, Alabama transfer Joceyln Shaw is ready to suit up for the Blazers for the first time. The former 5A Alabama MVP for LeFlore High School in Mobile, Ala., played her freshman season for the Crimson Tide in 2009-10 and will be a sophomore this year.

BLAZERS TO OPEN CAMPAIGN IN PRESEASON WNIT

UAB will play in the Preseason WNIT for the second time ever and the first time since the 1999-2000 season. The Blazers drew a road game Nov. 11 at Chattanooga for their opener in the event.

Audra Smith

Head Coach • Eighth Season • Virginia, 1992

In her seven seasons at the helm of the UAB women's basketball program, Audra Smith has turned the Blazers into one of the top squads in Conference USA, while continuing to increase their national recognition.

Smith's past two years have been marked by strong finishes, including a Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) title in 2010-11 and a run to the Conference USA Championship finals in 2009-10.

Coaching the 2010-11 squad to a 20-15 record, Smith posted the program's first 20-win season in a decade. The Blazers won 11 of their final 15 games, including all four of their contests in the season-ending WBI.

Making its second postseason tournament appearance under Smith, who also guided the program to a WNIT berth in 2006-07, UAB won its first three WBI contests on the road before coming home to defeat Cal State Bakersfield in the title game.

Smith's sharp-shooting guard Amanda Peterson became the all-time leading three-point shooter in the history of UAB basketball, men's or women's, capping her career with 319 treys, including a Conference USA single-season record 103 as a senior in 2010-11.

The 2009-10 campaign produced a historic run at the C-USA Championship, as UAB became the first No. 6 seed to reach the title game. It marked just the second time in history and first time since 2000 the Blazers reached the championship game.

Smith's 2009-10 squad also featured some outstanding talent, as guard Jala Harris became the first C-USA player in history to earn Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year honors in the same season. Harris was the third Blazer to earn the league's sixth player award during Smith's tenure and first to earn the freshman accolade.

In 2007-08, UAB garnered its second consecutive top-three finish in C-USA by placing third with an overall record of 14-16 and a league mark of 10-6.

Also making notable highlights in 2007-08 was senior guard/forward Diamond Rogers. Rogers was a first-team all-conference honoree and was also a State Farm Coaches' All-America regional finalist.

The 2006-07 campaign served as the Blazers' breakout season under Smith. The team posted an overall record of 19-13, including a second-place 12-4 mark in Conference USA. Not only did UAB record its best overall record in six seasons, but the Blazers' 12 league wins were the most in school history since joining Conference USA in 1995.

That year, UAB was selected to play in the postseason WNIT, its first postseason appearance in six years. The Blazers earned a victory over Davidson in the first round before falling to Auburn in round two.

Not only did UAB experience team success in '06-07, it also had multiple individuals recognized within the conference and nationally for their talent and success. The Blazers had a trio honored by C-USA, including Carmen Guzman as the league's Player of the Year.

Guzman, who was developed and polished under Smith and her staff, continued to rack up multiple conference and national honors, finishing her career as one of the finest players to ever wear a Blazers' uniform. Guzman became just the second Blazer in school history to earn the C-USA Player of the Year award, while also being named a Kodak/WBCA All-America finalist and being invited to the WNBA Pre-Draft Camp.

Smith's second season (2005-06) ended with the Blazers producing an overall record of 14-14, a 7-9 re-

cord in C-USA play and a pair of all-conference selections. The squad's overall record was the first time UAB posted a .500-plus mark since the 2000-01 season.

In 2004-05, UAB recorded a 7-21 overall mark in Smith's first season, as no Blazer player started every game and only three played in all 28 contests. Seven Blazers missed a total of 106 games for various reasons, with three different players missing at least 20 games of the season. UAB did participate in its second-consecutive Conference USA Tournament and won the Blazer Invitational during the season. Additionally, the Blazers took second at the Coors Rocky Mountain Invitational hosted by Colorado State University.

Smith was named the fifth head women's basketball coach for UAB on April 7, 2004. The job is Smith's first collegiate head coaching position after she spent 14 years under Debbie Ryan at Virginia as a player and assistant coach. Smith was associated with the UVa women's basketball program for 10 years as a coach and four as a player.

"I am so excited," Smith said upon her hiring. "I could tell when I came here that the administration is very serious about the success of the women's basketball program. That was apparent. The program at UAB has experienced success in the past and my goal is to get back to that level and beyond."

In coming to UAB, Smith returned to a region familiar to her. Smith grew up in Milledgeville, Ga., and went on to become an outstanding prep basketball player at Baldwin High School from 1986-88.

After finishing her playing career at Virginia in 1992, Smith joined the Cavaliers' coaching staff in 1994 as the restricted earnings coach. After two years, she was elevated to a full-time position where she assisted with player development of the guards and worked extensively in recruiting and scouting. In May of 2000, she was promoted to recruiting coordinator and helped Virginia attract four recruiting classes rated among the nation's top 20.

Virginia won six straight Atlantic Coast Conference championships from 1991-96, as well as three ACC tournament championships ('90, '92, '93). As a coach with the Cavaliers, Smith helped Virginia to nine consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (1995-2003), four NCAA Sweet 16 appearances (1995-97, 2000); two NCAA Elite Eight appearances (1995-96); and three ACC regular season titles (1995-96, 2000). Seventeen Cavalier players were named to the ACC Academic Honor Roll a total of 28 times.

After graduating from Virginia in 1992 with a degree in sociology, she worked as a child and adolescent counselor and as a social worker with the Department of Family and Children Services in Milledgeville. From there she returned to begin her coaching career in Charlottesville.

As a player at Virginia, Smith was a member of the Cavaliers team that competed in three consecutive Final Fours (1990, 1991 and 1992). Virginia reached the championship game in 1991, falling 70-67 in overtime to Tennessee. She was a four-year letterwinner.

At Baldwin High, she was named honorable mention All-America by Street and Smith's and was named Miss Georgia Basketball in 1988. She led Baldwin to three consecutive Georgia AAAA state championships (1986, 1987 and 1988) and was named the MVP of the state tournament as a junior in 1987.

Smith, 41, is married to former Virginia basketball player Anthony Oliver and has a son, A.J. (12) and a daughter, Adria (11). She has been a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association since 1994 and the Black Coaches Association since 2002.
